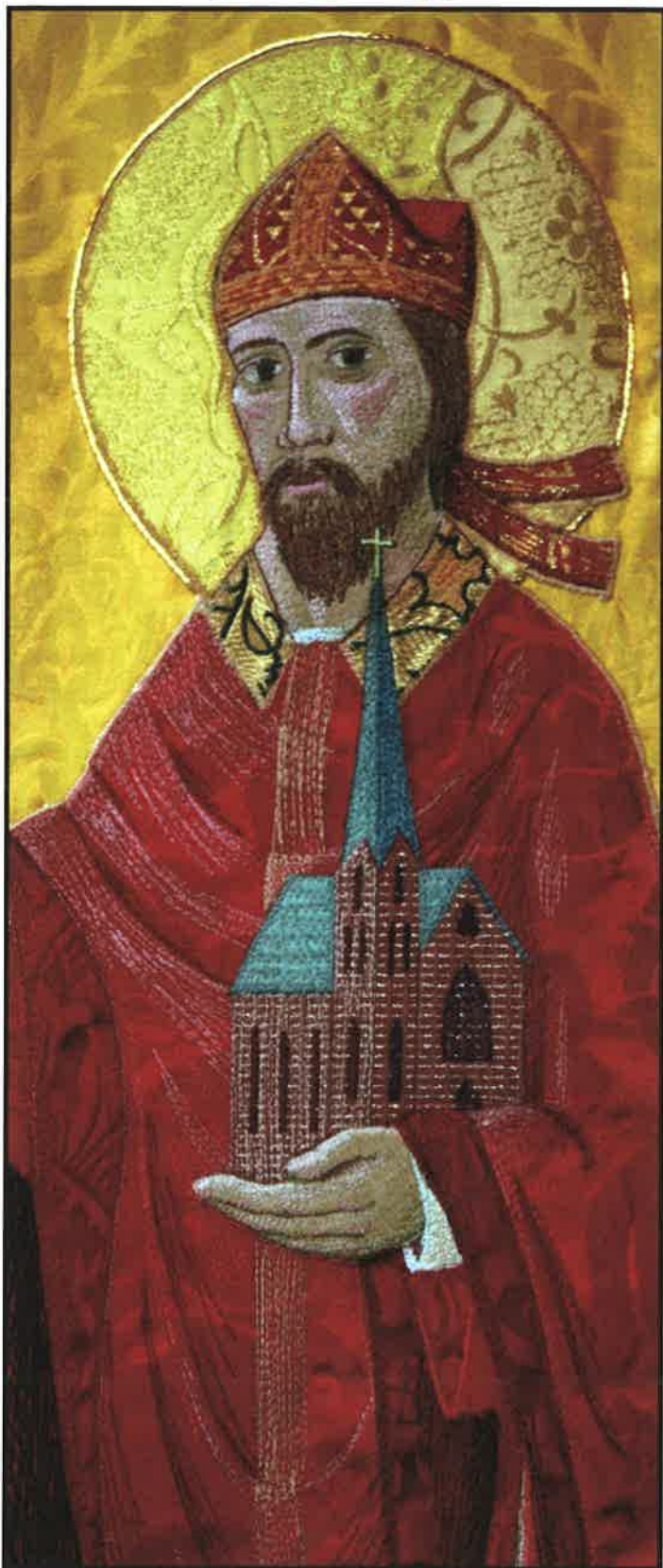

Father's Day Spiritual Bouquets

Spiritual Bouquets are prayers, or in this case, Intentions that are offered by someone in honor of, or memory of another. These are a wonderful way to commemorate special occasions or dates in the life of the family or the church. Everyone needs prayer, and this is an opportunity to come together as a community in honor of someone who has been an important part of our lives.

Father's Day Spiritual Bouquets are in the back of church. All bouquets collected by Monday, June 10 will be included in the bulletin and in the General Intentions on Father's Day weekend. The names will also be placed on the Altar.

The Bouquet consists of a card inside a donation envelope. A donation of \$10 is requested for each Intention. You keep the inside card and give it to the person in each Bouquet (one name per envelope). Give the inside card in its envelope to the person you are honoring. Complete the outside envelope with your Intention information, put the \$10 donation inside the envelope, and put in it the collection basket, or return it to the Parish Office. This is a wonderful way to honor the special people in our lives!

Celebrating Saints and Feasts to Enrich Hearts and Homes

Week Of May 19th – May 25th

St Rita of Cascia (Born Margherita Lotti 1381 – 22 May 1457)

May 22nd - Rita was a child bride, married before the age of 12. The marriage lasted for eighteen years, during which she is remembered for her Christian values as a model wife and mother who made efforts to convert her husband from his abusive behaviour. Upon the murder of her husband by another feuding family, she sought to dissuade her sons from revenge. Rita subsequently joined an Augustinian community of religious sisters, where she was known both for practicing mortification of the flesh and for the efficacy of her prayers. When Rita was approximately sixty years of age, she was meditating before an image of Christ crucified. Suddenly, a small wound appeared on her forehead, as though a thorn from the crown that encircled Christ's head had loosened itself and penetrated her own flesh. For the next fifteen years she bore this external sign of union with Christ. Various miracles are attributed to her intercession, and she is often portrayed with a bleeding wound on her forehead. At her canonization ceremony she was bestowed the title of Patroness of Impossible Causes. She is also the patron saint of sterility, abuse victims, loneliness, marriage difficulties, parenthood, widows, the sick, bodily ills, and wounds. On the 100th anniversary of her canonization in 2000, Pope John Paul II noted her remarkable qualities as a Christian woman: "Rita

interpreted well the 'feminine genius' by living it intensely in both physical and spiritual motherhood." Rita's body, which has remained incorrupt over the centuries, is venerated today in the shrine at Cascia.



FEASTING WITH THE SAINTS

Home-made fig bars

1/2 c. butter

1 c. brown sugar, packed

2 eggs

1 tsp. vanilla extract

2 1/2 c. all-purpose flour

1/2 tsp. each salt and baking soda

Fig filling: Chop 1 package (12 ounce) moist dried figs. In small saucepan mix with 1/4 cup sugar, 3/4 cup water and 2 tbsp. lemon juice. Cook over medium heat, stirring until thick and jam-like. Remove from heat and cool.

-Beat together butter, sugar, eggs and vanilla until well blended.

-Mix flour, salt and baking soda. Stir into first mixture (dough will be stiff). Wrap in plastic wrap and chill for at least 3 hours.

-When ready to bake, turn dough out on lightly floured surface. Roll into a 14 by 12 inch rectangle. Cut into 4 strips 3 1/2 by 12 inches long.

-Spoon filling evenly down center of strips. With spatula, turn in sides of strips. Press edges together to seal. Cut each strip into 10 pieces. Arrange seam side down on baking sheets.

-Bake at 375 degrees for 10-12 minutes or until firm and lightly browned.

Serve with rose scented tea or pink lemonade in honour of St. Rita.

Reading: St. Rita of Cascia: Saint of the Impossible – Joseph Sicardo. Desirous of being a nun, she instead obeyed her parents and married. Her husband was cruel, and caused her much suffering, to which she responded with love and prayers and eventually converted him. After the death of her husband and two sons, Rita was able to enter a convent, where she devoted herself to prayer and penance. She abandoned herself totally to God, diminishing herself as He increased in her. An inspiring story of a soul completely resigned to God's will, 132 pg.
