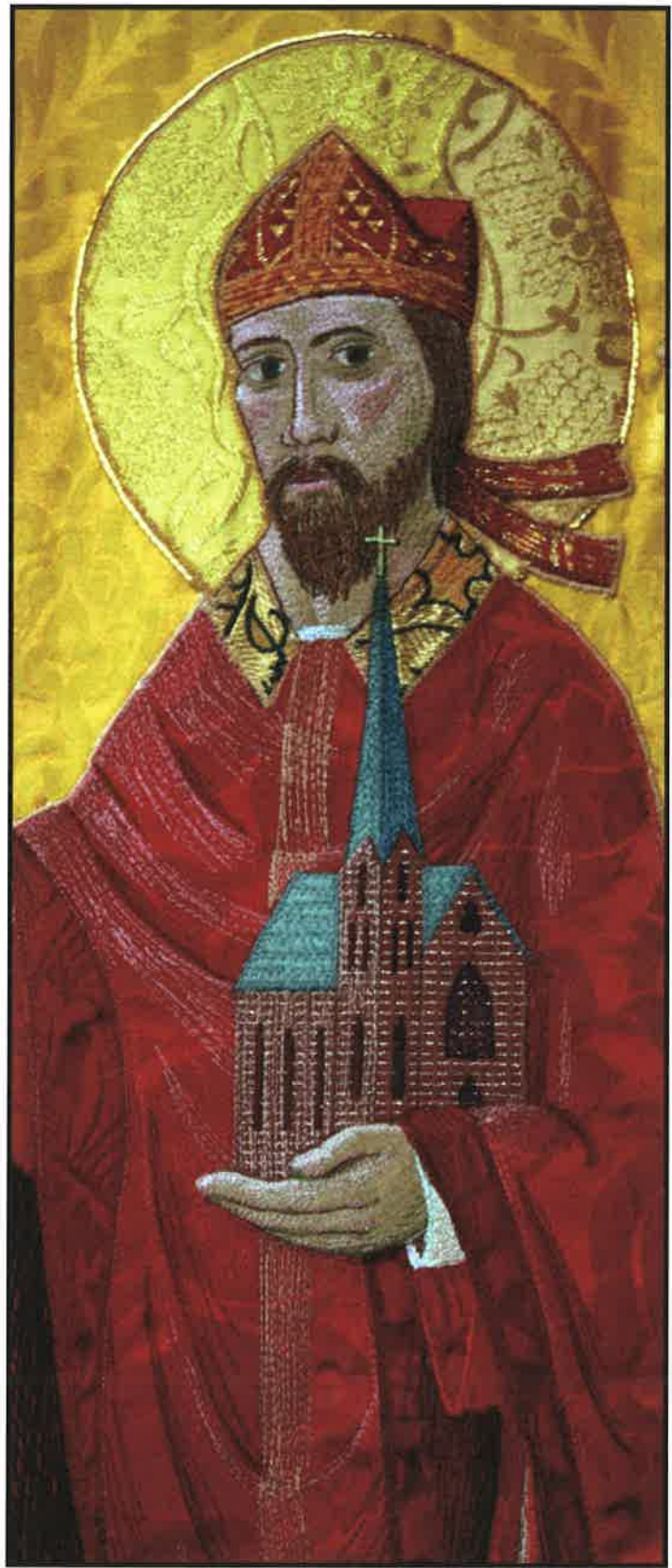

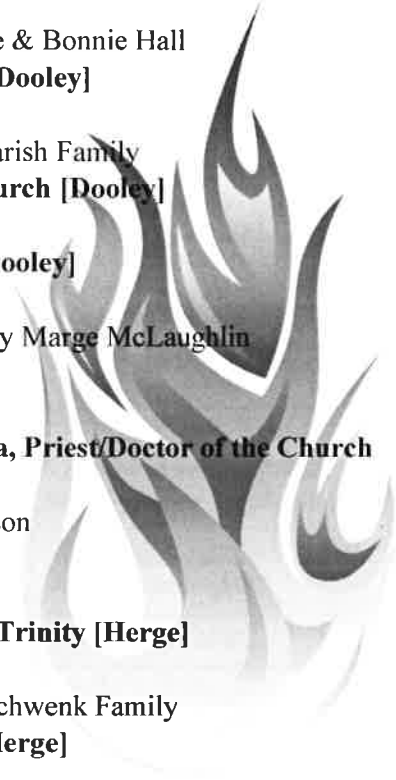

A new consortium is being formed from parts of the Southern Consortium (Scioto-Jackson) and ours. The new one will be Wellston-Jackson-Zaleski. Fr. Nic Ventura will become the pastor of this new consortium.

More impactful in the life of the consortium will be the fact that both Fr. Dooley and Fr. Herge have received new assignments. We will be sad to see them both go. Fr. Dooley has been here four years and has become an integral and very well loved priest in our consortium. Fr. Thomas, although here only a year, has fully entered in to the life of the consortium and has affected so many for the good.

Fr. Dooley will become pastor at Our Lady of Peace in Columbus. He has served as Parochial Vicar Administrator both at St. Mary/St. Sylvester and St. Colman and I have no doubt is very ready to become a great pastor. Fr. As you see in the bulletin this week, Fr. Thomas will be here next weekend. Please come by the Parish Hall after Sunday Mass during coffee and donuts to say goodbye to him. Father Dooley will be back at St. Colman July 6 and 7. A farewell get-together for him will be held after Mass on Saturday, July 6.

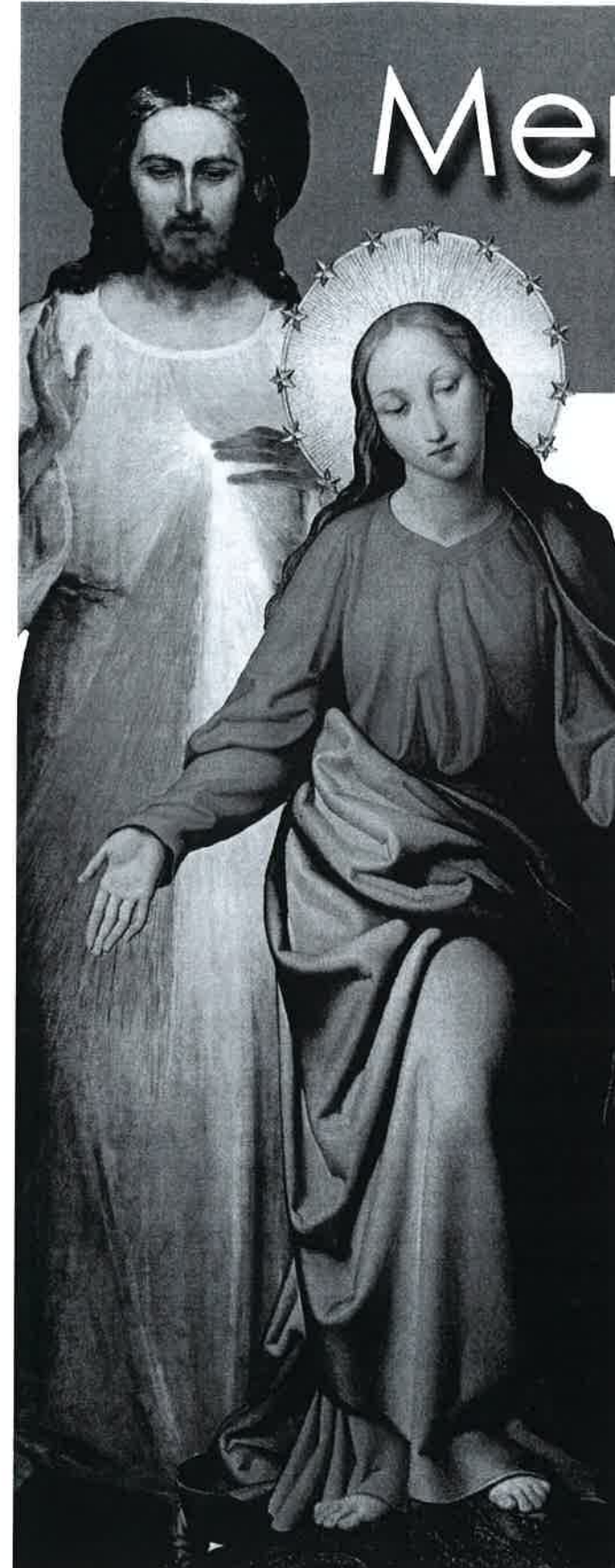
We pray that God blesses Frs. Dooley and Thomas in their new assignments and that he continues to bless the parishes of our consortium.

Week Of June 9th – June 15th

St Anthony of Padua (August 15, 1195, to June 13, 1231)

June 13th – Anthony was a Portuguese Catholic priest and friar of the Franciscan Order. He was born and raised by a wealthy family in Lisbon, Portugal, and died in Padua, Italy. Noted by his contemporaries for his powerful preaching, expert knowledge of scripture, and undying love and devotion to the poor and the sick, he was one of the most quickly canonized saints in church history. He was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church on 16 January 1946. He is also the patron saint of lost things. The reason St. Anthony's help is invoked for finding things lost or stolen is traced to an incident that occurred in Bologna. According to the story, Anthony had a book of psalms that was of some importance to him, as it contained the notes and comments he had made to use in teaching his students. A novice who had decided to leave took the psalter with him. Prior to the invention of the printing press, any book was an item of value. Upon noticing it was missing, Anthony prayed it would be found or returned. The thief was moved to restore the book to Anthony and return to the order. The stolen book is said to be preserved in the Franciscan friary in Bologna. When his body was exhumed 30 years after his death, it was found turned to dust, but his tongue was found to be glistening and looked as if it were still alive and moist; those involved and church authorities though the centuries have

perceived this as a sign of his gift of preaching and never speaking a vulgar or uncharitable word. Consider praying to Saint Anthony for his intercession when responding to others verbally or on social media.

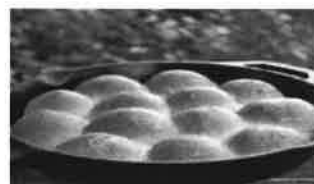
Saint Anthony's Bread

Ingredients:

- 1 cup warm water
- 1 cup warm milk
- 1/2 cup honey
- 2 1/4 teaspoons yeast (1 packet)
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 5-6 cups flour

Directions:

Combine the warm water, milk, honey and yeast in a medium bowl. Allow the yeast to prove for 5 minutes. It should look



bubbly. To your mixer add the yeast mixture, butter, flour and salt. Using your dough hook, knead the dough until combined about 3-5 minutes. Transfer dough to a work surface and shape into a rectangle about 1 inch thick cut into uniformly sized pieces. Form each piece into a ball pinching the seams on the underside making a smooth top. Transfer dough to a greased pan, I use my Cast Iron Pan. Give the rolls a bit of room to rise. Cover and allow to rise about 2 hours in a warm place. Preheat oven to 375. Bake for about 20 minutes. Serve warm.
