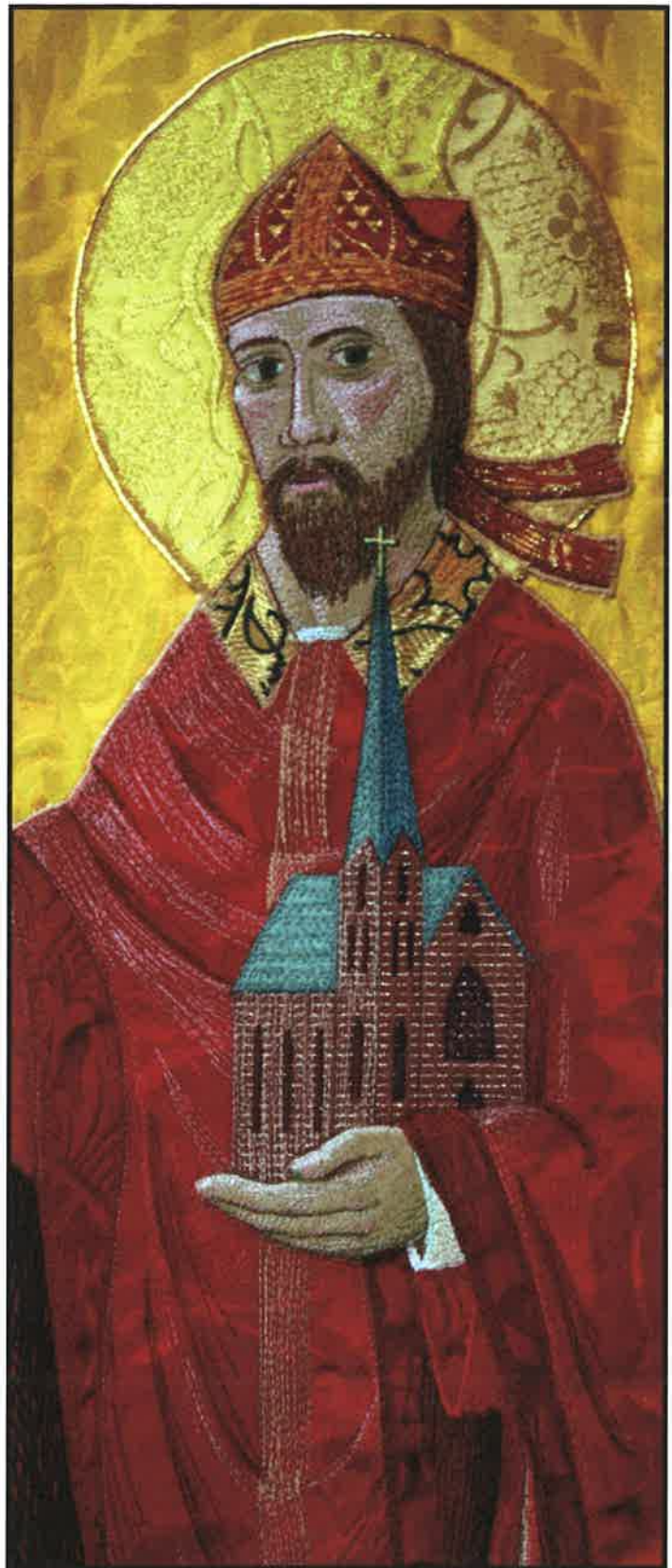

From the Pastor's Desk...

As we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Body of Christ, it is good to recall a few ways we can help strengthen our understanding, devotion, and love for our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

1.) Educate ourselves: On FORMED (the website we have a subscription to in order to use all of their videos, audios, Bible Studies, books, etc.)* you can listen to audios such as "The Body and Blood of Christ" by Dr. Scott Hahn or "The Holy Eucharist with Bishop Barron" or play a video for the kids such as, "The Eucharist for Little Children" or go deeper with a study either with a group of friends or by yourself, such as "Lectio: Eucharist." Pick one or more, they are all free to you thanks to the subscription that the consortium currently has.

2.) Spend time with the Lord in Adoration. Usually on First Tuesdays we have the Blessed Sacrament exposed for Adoration from 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. during the summer months. (During the school year it is 6:00 – 8:00 p.m.) Stop in and spend some time in quiet adoring our Lord. There is nothing that can replace prayer before the Blessed Sacrament as a way of growing in our understanding and devotion to the Eucharist. If you cannot make it on First Tuesdays, stop in any time on weekday mornings for some prayer time before our Lord in the Tabernacle

3.) Join in public witness of devotion to the Blessed Sacrament by joining us for the annual **Corpus Christi procession.** This is one of those events that we should be expected to attend as it is our one annual public display of devotion to the Lord in the streets.

The Lord gave us an immense gift, the most immense gift he could give to us in the Eucharist: Himself! Let's show our gratitude by planning to draw closer to Him in this gift in these coming weeks after the Feast of Corpus Christi.

*If you have not set up a FORMED account, it takes less than two minutes. Just go to www.formed.org, click on "Enter Code" and type in our parish code: VZ4F2W. Once set up, you will have access to hundreds of great Catholic Resources.
