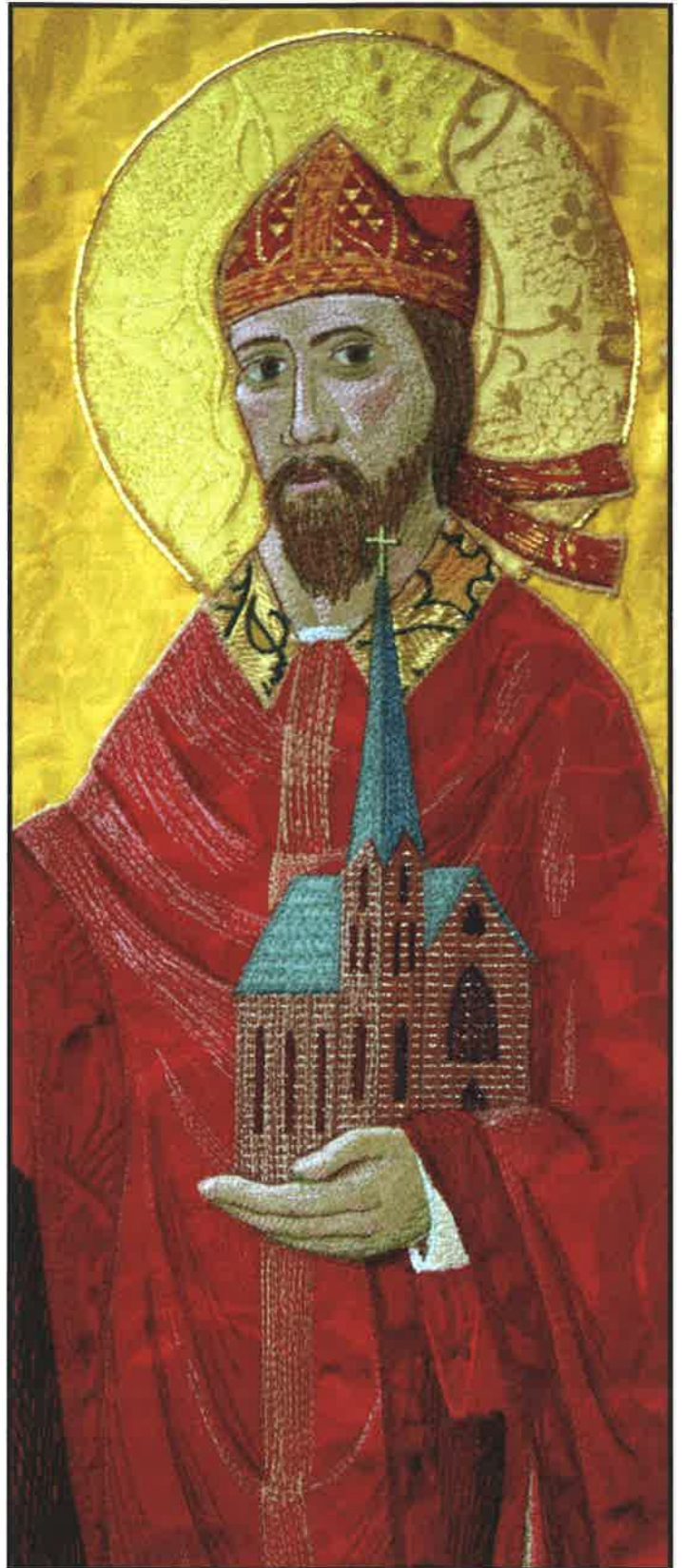

Our annual **Parish Picnic** for all St. Colman Parishioners and their families will be held on **Sunday, July 28th** beginning with evening vespers at **5:00pm**. The Picnic will follow outdoors at 5:30pm. *(In case of rain, we will retreat to the Parish Center.)* This is also a gathering to welcome Father Lynch and Father Beal to St. Colman.

Sign ups are in the back of church for you to indicate that you are coming and what side or dessert you are bringing. The parish will supply the meat, a potato dish and drinks. We will also have tables and chairs, but bring a lawn chair if you want.



From the Pastor's Desk...

Unfortunately, this is the first year in quite some time that our parish did not reach the BAA goal set by the diocese (\$5000 shy at this point), let alone our parish goal. My understanding from some of you is that you did not contribute this year as you want to make a point to the bishop that St. Colman's deserves to have its own pastor and not be part of a consortium. Whether this is the best way to make that point can be debated. However, I do ask that if you aren't contributing for that reason, at least turn your envelope in with a note to that effect or in some way make it clear that that is why you are not contributing this year. Bishops' Fund drives are down all across the US this year as a protest against the way the Bishops handled the abuse crisis and in particular those cases involving fellow bishops. For that reason, without a note, I have a feeling that the lack of support will be misread.

Also, for the sake of your spiritual life, I encourage you to make an equitable gift to another charity or to the parish. It's good practice that our protests not benefit ourselves or motives can become mixed.

Finally, I encourage you not to lessen your support of the parish finances. A month ago Bishop Brennan was in the area and so Fr. Dooley and I brought him to see St. Colman. He was impressed by the grounds and surprised at the size of the church. He said he had expected to see something more akin to a small run down country church. When I told him the reasons I thought that St. Colman should be on its own, he tended to agree with the reasons but then his first question was, "But can they afford it?" To which to this point, I could respond, "most certainly, they've run in the black very well these past few years."

So, know that the hope is to move St. Colman's to its own pastorate in the future. Also know that St. Colman's has to be seen to be financially still capable of such. Finally, if you want to let the Bishop know your thoughts, include a note with your empty BAA envelope, or maybe just as effective or better at creating good will towards St. Colman, include a BAA gift with your note. 😊
