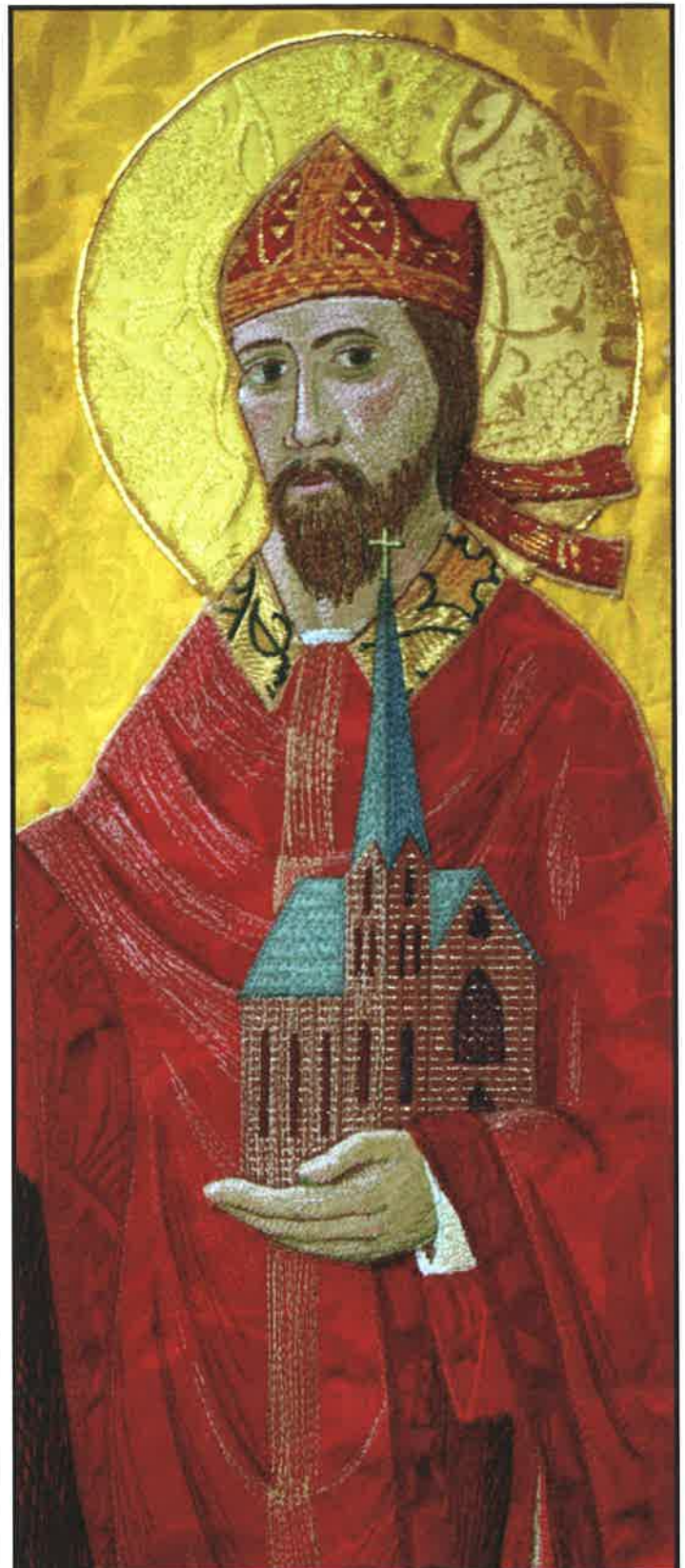

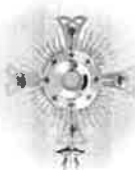

From the Pastor's Desk...

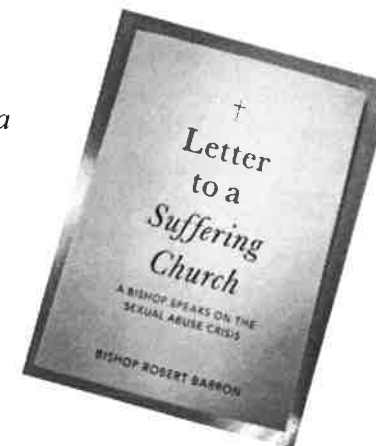
Wilderness Outreach

Thank you to everyone who came out to the Parish Picnic to welcome Father Tim Lynch and Father Brian Beal! What a wonderful evening we had with about 80 parishioners attending! Great music! Great weather! Great fellowship and Great Food! Below are two of the zucchini recipes people were asking for!

Caprese Zucchini Salad

2 Medium zucchini, spirialized then noodles trimmed to 5 inches or less
1/4 cup cherry tomatoes, halved

Marinade:

1 TBS lemon juice
3 TBS balsamic vinegar
2 TBS olive oil
1 medium garlic clove, minced
Salt and pepper

12 small mozzarella balls, halved
1/2 cup thinly sliced basil leaves

Place zucchini and tomatoes in a large bowl. Make the marinade. Pulse the ingredients in a food processor until the garlic is smooth. Pour the marinade over the zucchini noodles and tomatoes and toss to combine. Place in the refrigerator to marinate for at least 10 minutes. Add the mozzarella and basil to the zucchini noodles, toss to combine and serve. *Note: Sandy used lime juice was used instead of lemon and added semi dried basil to add more flavor.*

Tomato-Zucchini Casserole

1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
1/2 tsp. dried oregano
1/2 tsp. dried basil
1 clove garlic, minced
3 zucchini thinly sliced and divided
2 tomatoes sliced and divided
1/4 cup butter
2 TBL onion, minced
1/2 cup Italian-flavored dry bread crumbs

Combine cheeses, oregano, basil and garlic; set aside. Spread half the zucchini and half the tomatoes in a greased 8"X8" baking pan; sprinkle with half the cheese mixture. Repeat layers; set aside. Melt butter in a small skillet; add onion and saute until tender. Remove from heat; stir in bread crumbs. Sprinkle over cheese layer; cover with foil. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes; uncover and bake 25 more minutes. Serves 8.

Community Service for Historic Auditorium

As you may know, the Washington Court House City Schools owns an Historic Auditorium on Temple St. in WCH. This beautiful and majestic space is attached to the old middle school, which is vacant and in disrepair. Washington Court House City Schools are interested in bringing our Historic Auditorium back to FULL life, not only for our students, but for the entire community of Washington Court House and Fayette County. "We may not have a great deal of finances to make this space better, but we do have a great deal of caring people and a passion for our community to GROW", says Tom Bailey, superintendent.

On Saturday, August 10, they are going to be holding the first of several Historic Auditorium "clean-up" days.
