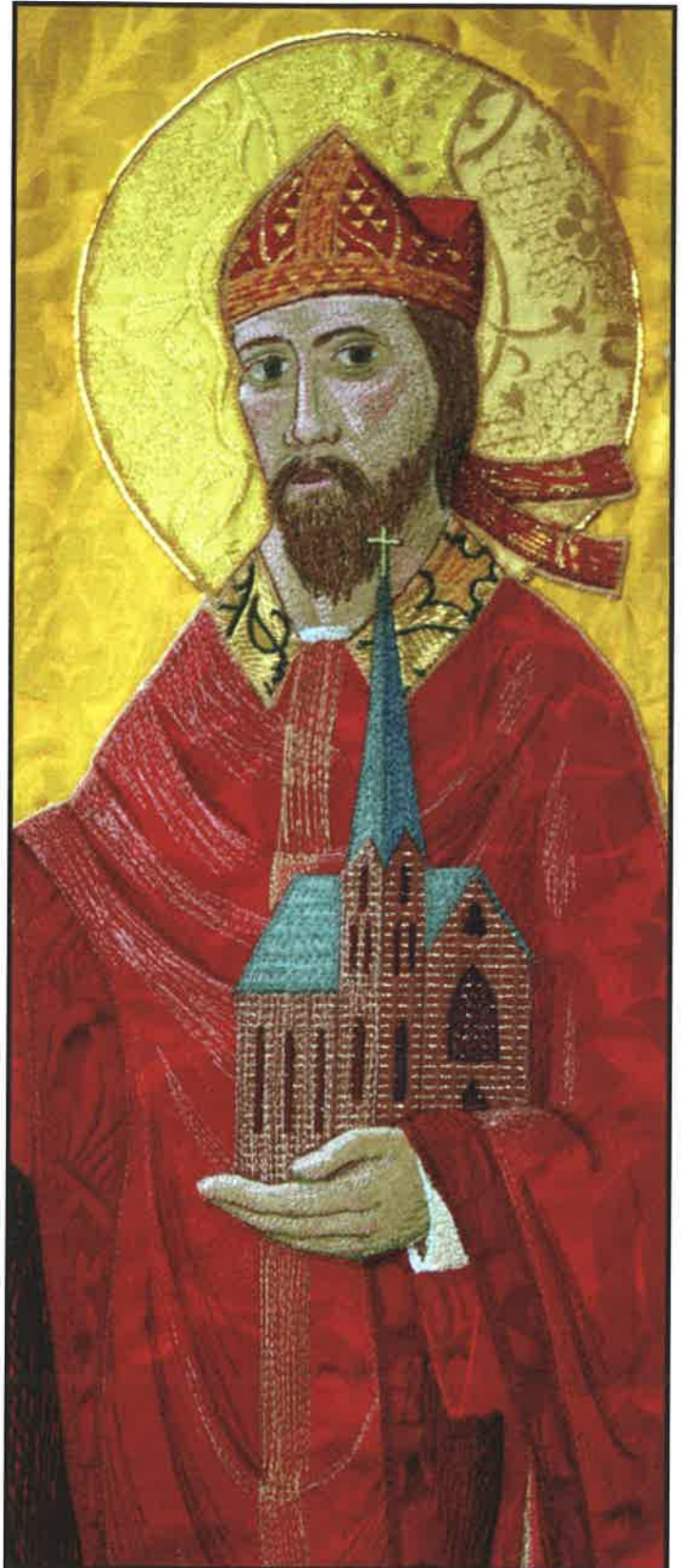

From the Pastor's Desk...

Feast of the Assumption

This coming Thursday, August 15, is the Feast of the Assumption. On this day we commemorate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, body and soul, into Heaven. The Lord saw it fit to never allow her body to know corruption, she whose body held Life itself, Jesus Christ, in her womb. It is debated within the Church whether she died and then immediately was assumed into Heaven or whether the Lord assumed her into Heaven at the end of her life rather than have her undergo corruption. There are saints on both sides of the debate, and it may be something we won't know the answer to until the next life. This is a holy day of obligation. We will have two opportunities here to fulfill our obligation and to honor Our Lady. One will be Wednesday night Vigil Mass at 7:00 p.m. the other Thursday morning Feast Day Mass at 8:30 a.m. There will also be Thursday Feast Day Masses at St. Peter's at 8:30a and 7:00p. Any of these would fulfill our obligation.

Michaelmas Fast

Lent is a great 40-day opportunity to work on our asceticism which is to work on our sensitivity to the Lord's movements in our life. Through our increased prayer and fasting and self-denial, we help in making ourselves more receptive and docile to the Lord. Often by the end of the summer, people are looking for some spiritual help in this area and have a deepening awareness of the need to be more self-disciplined. Good news is we don't have to wait for Lent. In the Tradition of the Church there is already a model we can tie into much sooner. It is called the Michaelmas Fast. There was traditionally a 40-day penitential period leading up to the Feast of St. Michael on September 29 (now called the Feast of the Archangels). For you who have a devotion to St. Francis, this was the fast during which St. Francis received the stigmata (the visible wounds of Christ) on his body in 1224. Consider taking up some form of penance for the forty days preceding the Feast of the Archangels. The Michaelmas Fast begins on August 20. Looking for some proven ideas of asceticism? 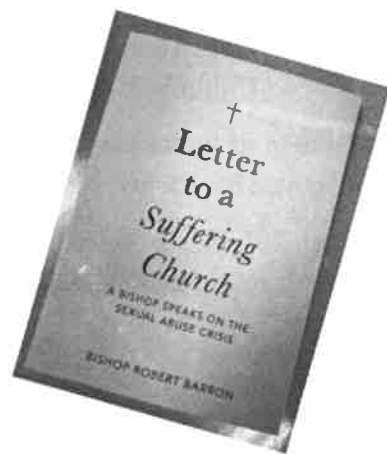

Join Father Hahn on August 25

Saturday, August 10: Feast of St. Lawrence...

The relic of St. Lawrence is placed in our Altar. The relic was from the estate of Monsignor Lawrence Corcoran, a priest of the Diocese of Columbus, who for many years served as President of Catholic Charities USA, an office of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington D.C. He was also a professor of social work at The Catholic University of America. The relic was given to Father Jan Sullivan from Father Jerome Stluka. It is encased in a sterling silver casket (a gift from Father Jan Sullivan to St. Colman) with the image of Mary and Jesus enthroned and surrounded by saints.



Corresponding to the early days of the Church, it is customary to have a relic of a martyr in the altar. In the early days of the Church, people would gather at the graves of the martyrs on the anniversary of their death to celebrate the date they gave their lives and celebrate the Eucharist. St. Lawrence was tied on top of an iron grill over a slow fire that roasted his flesh little by little, but Lawrence was burning with so much love of God that he almost did not feel the flames. In fact, God gave him so much strength and joy that he even joked. "Turn me over," he said to the judge. "I'm done on this side!" And just before he died, he said, "It's cooked enough now." Then he prayed that the city of Rome might be converted to Jesus and that the Catholic Faith might spread all over the world. After that, he went to receive the martyr's reward. Saint Lawrence's feast day is August 10th. (www.catholic.org)

The altar is made of red oak. The top is made of green Connemara marble imported from Ireland.

The altar is a gift of the Garland Family in memory of their parents, Robert and Martha during the restoration of the church in 2010-2011. It was handmade by Lamar Ratliff, husband of Stephanie (Garland) Ratliff. It was dedicated on June 12, 2011 by Bishop James F. Garland. Bishop Garland is a younger brother to Bob. The shields around the altar are the shields representing the patron saints of each of the Garland children: Nancy (St. Anne), James, Nicholas, Christopher, Joseph and Stephanie (St. Monica) in addition to the shield of Pope Benedict in the middle front flanked by the shield for Bob (St. Robert Bellarmine) and the shield for Martha and the shield of Bishop Garland in the middle back.
