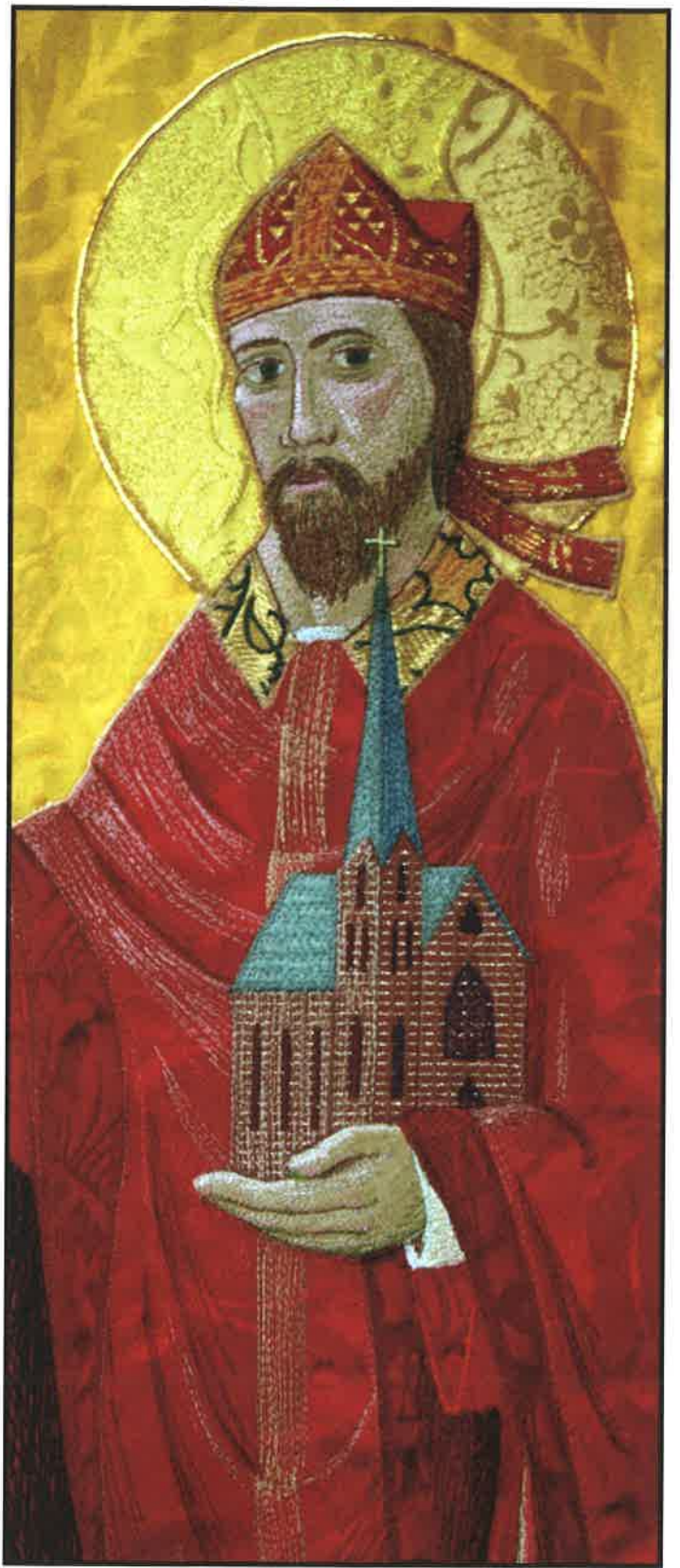

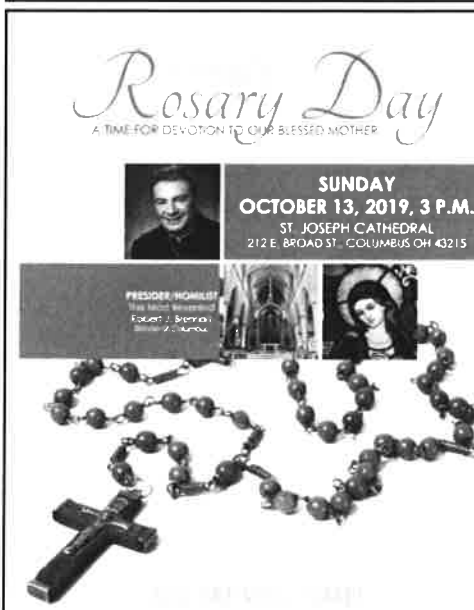

NCYC 2019

This November St. Colman will have 8 students attending the National Catholic Youth Conference in Indianapolis. This event is an opportunity for youth from all over the US to attend workshops and talks given by nationally recognized Catholic speakers as well as interacting with other Catholic youth. As you can imagine, this is an expensive endeavor because of travel and lodging expenses. In order to offset the cost, I applied for and received a generous scholarship from the Diocese. This brought the cost per student down to \$326 from \$545. We have used the money that we made by working the K of C fish fries as well. As of now, the total cost per student is \$276. We also have the cost of 3 dinners left to cover. The Women of St. Colman have already given us a donation to cover our lunches. (Thank you so much, Ladies!) If anyone would like to make a contribution to offset our expenses, we would be most appreciative. We have 3 families who are each sending 2 students so they are doubled up on the cost. Our parish family is always so generous to the youth and We thank you for your help.

Library Notes



Wives do What?! by Dr. Brant Pitre DVD (FAM/PIT).

Dr. Pitre tackles the controversial scripture of St. Paul - "wives be submissive to your husband". What was God trying to teach us in Ephesians? This very good explanation is as important today as it was during the paganism of the Roman Empire.

Rediscovering the Saints by Matthew Kelley (SAI/KEL)

NO!! This isn't another book about saints. This tells us how they are active in our lives, how they love being asked to pray for us, how they are cheering us on and showing us the way to happiness and Heaven.

A Manual of Prayers (PRA) Don't skip over this prayer book by thinking that you know all the prayers that you need. Do you say a Prayers of Thanksgiving after going to Confession? How about "a complete trust in God" by St. Vincent de Sales? You will find beautiful prayers to enrich your spiritual life in this book.

How to Wolf Proof your Kids: A Practical Guide for Keeping your Kids Catholic by Gary G. Michuta

Do your kids grumble about going to Holy Mass and/or PSR classes? Are their friends telling them that the Catholic Church is too strict or that they have lots more fun in their churches? If so, the friends are guilty of "sheep-stealing". This short book helps parents be aware of anti-Catholic wolves who try to entice young people to rebel against parent and our Catholic faith.

A Well-Built Faith by Joe Paprocki

A Catholic's guide to knowing and sharing what we believe. In only 18 chapters, the author explains the Creed, sacraments, morality and prayer in profound and, at times, humorous ways. For instance, we are made in the image of God. This is not to be thought in physical terms. God is not physical. We are to be loving as God is love. God is not a supreme being. God is God. This is a good way to be able to explain our faith to others.

Who is Jesus? By Ellen Morgan (JES/MOR)

This is a short biography of Jesus for children in grades 5-7. Succinctly written and well illustrated, this easily read book could be read by parents and children together. Conversations between them would expand on the stories told. With only 101 pages, it is a quick one to read for a book report!

Borrowing a book is easy. Just write your name on the white index card found on the front inside binder of the book and place the index card in the plastic container on the table. When you return the book, just leave it on the table in the library.

Topical new books are purchased throughout the year for both adults and children. Take a few minutes and browse the shelves. It's a great way to feed your soul, deepen your faith and learn more about our Church.
