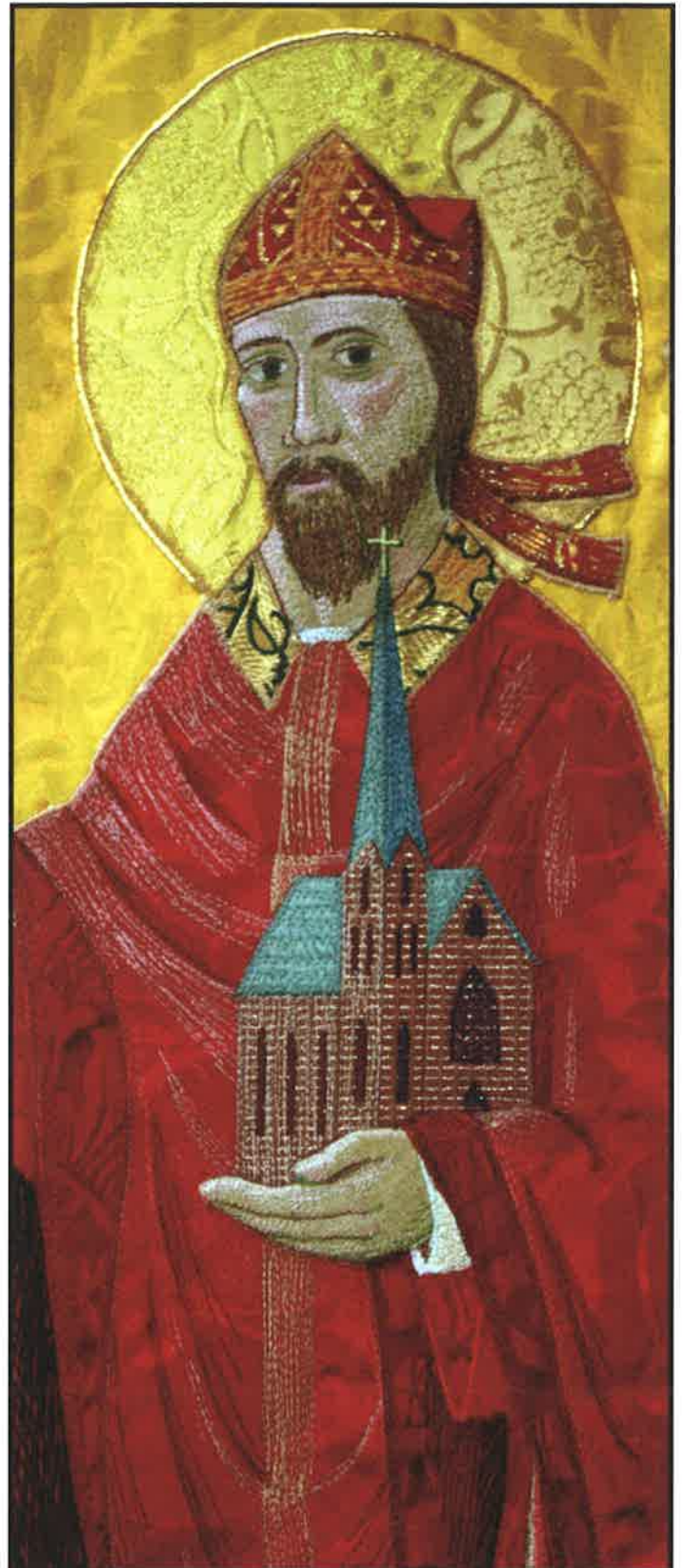

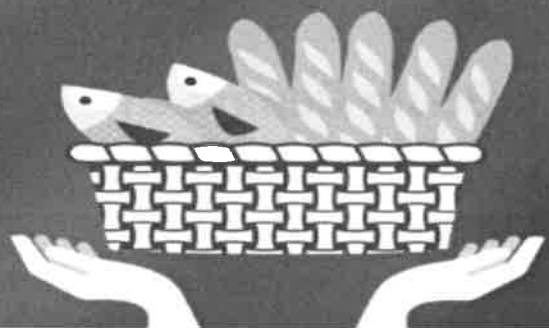

Disaster Response & Dispatch Volunteers - Volunteers that respond to local disaster situations (ranging from single family home fires to larger community events) to provide financial, emotional and referral support to victims of a local disaster.

Dispatchers receive incoming calls from the American Red Cross and contact local on-duty volunteers to respond, verifies information. The Dispatcher role is a virtual volunteer position and they work from home/remotely.

Blood Drive Donor Ambassador - Volunteers needed to help at our local American Red Cross Blood Drives. Welcoming donors and engaging with them to feel comfortable, setting up an appointment for their next donation (if desired), etc.

Local Disaster Responders: Once trained may be called to respond to local home fires, flooding, etc. generally two shifts per month. Offer comfort, assess situation, gather information. May be offering aid immediately. Follow up done by Red Cross Caseworker(s) who will continue to assist the family/individual.

Dispatchers: Receives incoming calls from the Red Cross to dispatch local on-duty volunteers to respond to the scene. Verifies info. Virtual position, work from home.

American Red Cross Washington Courthouse Office: Answers phones, greets and interacts with staff and visitors. Some data entry, assist with mailings and correspondence.

**MARCH FOR LIFE 2020
PRE-REGISTRATION FORM**

If you are planning / considering attending our March for Life 2020 pilgrimage, please fill out the following information, include a deposit of \$30 and **return to Stephanie Robinson in the Parish Office by December 15, 2019.** (If the deposit is a financial hardship, please let Stephanie know . . . no one is refused attendance for this reason.) The estimated cost per person this year is \$200 (includes bus, hotel accommodations, a couple of meals, MFL Hat and snacks/water on the bus). St. Colman Parish is paying \$100 per person from the fundraising efforts from the Fair Booth and the Oktoberfest Raffle. We will be asking for sponsorships, so if you know of someone who would like to sponsor a pilgrim please let them know. There will be additional paperwork to fill out prior to leaving for Washington in January. We will have 50 spots available for High School teens, young adults (former Youth Group members in college), Members of Knights of Columbus Council, clergy and adult chaperones (These are 25 for St. Peter/St. Mary Waverly and 25 for St. Colman). They will be on a first come first serve basis, with priority given to actively participating High School teens. Eighth graders are permitted on the pilgrimage as long as they have a parent with them. All adults over 18 and out of High School must be safe environment compliant, meaning have taken the PGC training session and had a BCI fingerprint background check completed.

This is our preliminary itinerary:

Thursday, January 23 – we will meet at St. Peter's approximately 6:00 a.m. and travel to Fairfax, VA. We will stop for lunch and dinner along the way, so plan to have money for food. We will arrive at our hotel around 4:00-4:30 p.m. Once unloaded and things taken to our room, we will head to George Mason University for a youth rally put on by the Diocese of Arlington. This year's speaker is Immaculee (a Rwandan Genocide survivor) The event is over at 10:00 p.m. We will return to our hotel for a good night's sleep!

Friday, January 24 – We will return to George Mason University for the Morning Mass and Youth Rally. The Rally finishes at 11:00 a.m. On the way out of the venue, everyone will receive a Chic-fil-A meal to eat on the bus as we travel into DC for the March. At approximately 1:00 we will join thousands of others as we March for Life! After the March, we will take a group shot near the Senate Office building. Our hotel rooms for this evening will be at the same location as Thursday night.

Saturday, January 25 – We will do some touring of DC, then head home to Chillicothe.
