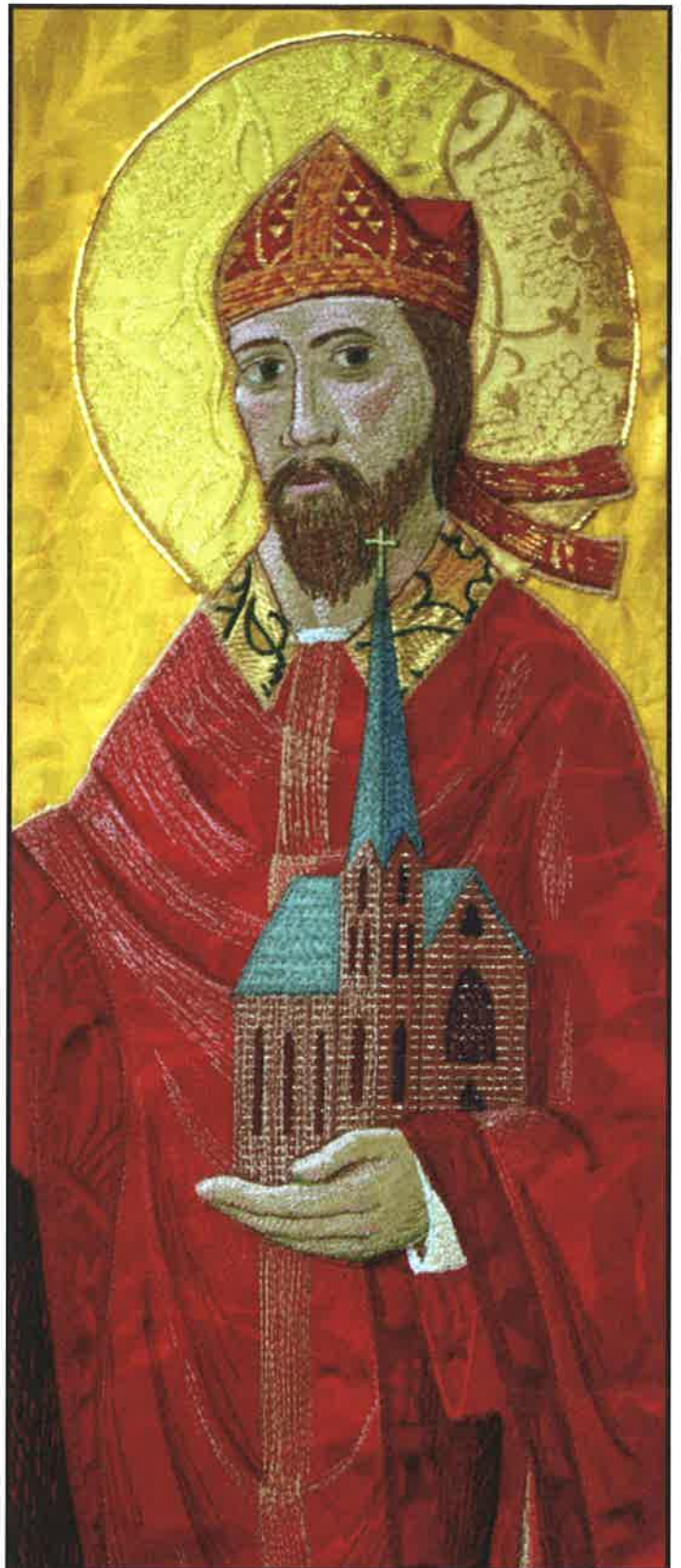

## From the Pastor's Desk...

This Sunday we are celebrating the **Rite of Acceptance** and **Rite of Welcoming** for our RCIA candidates and catechumens. We are very blessed as a parish to have four who are studying the Faith this year. This rite is the first major gateway in the process. According to the Church's ritual book, those going through this rite are "assembling publicly for the first time to declare their intention to the Church and the Church in turn, carrying out its apostolic mission, accepts them as persons who intend to become its members...they prepare to be sealed with the gift of the Spirit in Confirmation [and of course to receive the most important initiation sacrament of baptism if they have not yet done so] and take their place at the Banquet Table of Christ's sacrifice." (RCIA 41, 412) So in effect the candidates are declaring that they do hope and intend to eventually become Catholics, and the Church is affirming their desire and strengthening them. I know that you will join me in deepening our prayer for them now that they will have taken this first step.

In the calendar of the Church, St. Cecilia is commemorated on November 22. I bring this up because St. Cecilia is the patroness of musicians, so this is always a good time to say thank you to all who help enhance our liturgies by sharing their talents: musical, vocal, and planning and organization. We at St. Colman's are very blessed in this. Our choir director/organist, our choir and cantors, all are very gifted and share their gifts for the glory of God. They put in a lot of time and work to help ensure our liturgies are properly and beautifully celebrated. The next time you see one of them, thank them for adding to the beauty of our liturgies and helping us to glorify God by their hard work and sharing of their talents.

## "March for Me" - March for Life Sponsorships

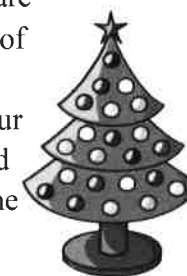
