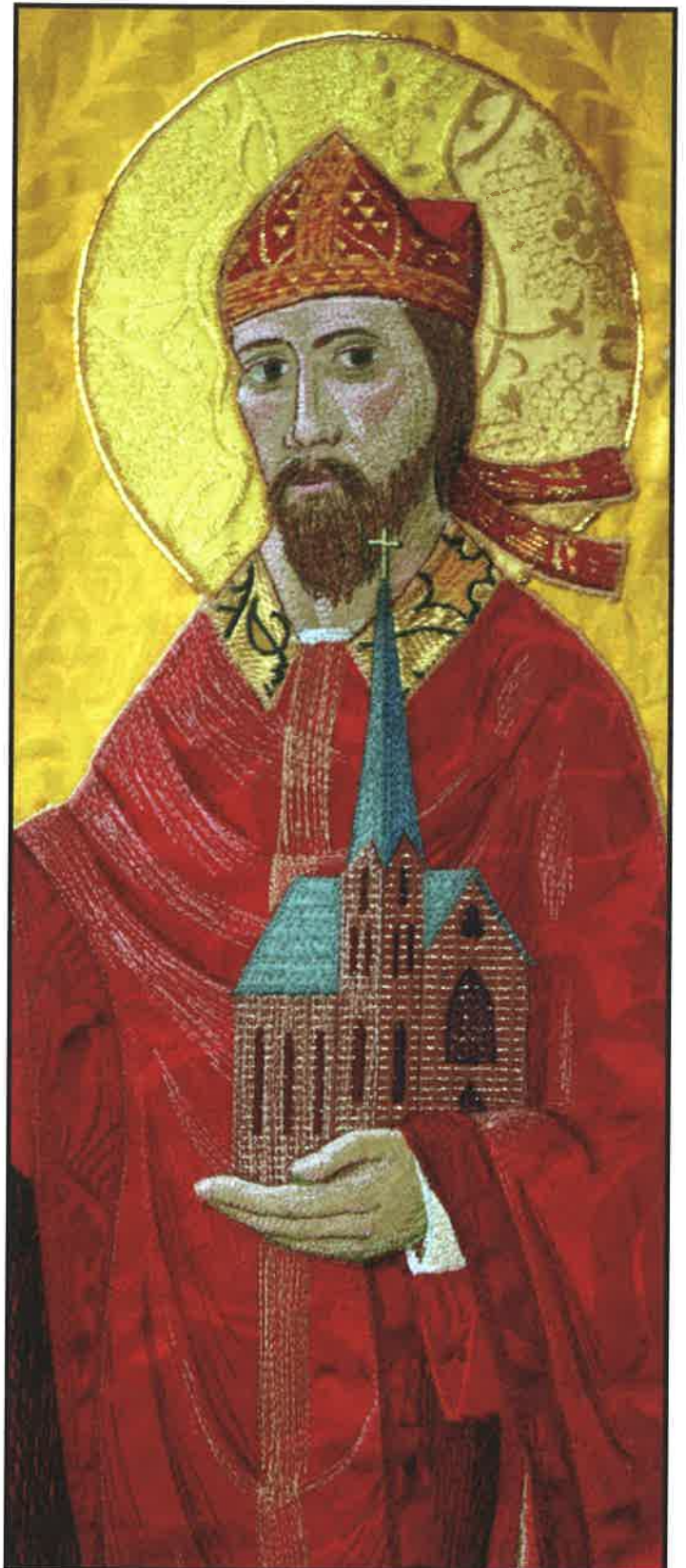

Capital Improvement Collection Next Weekend

Next weekend is the final of the four Capital Improvement collections we have each year. We will continue to use the money collected to pay for the tower doors. The bill from Marquee Construction totaled \$20,880. The grant from The Catholic Foundation is \$7,000 and the Capital Improvement collections thus far total \$5,641. We still have an \$8,239 need to cover this project. Originally we planned to use BAA refunds to cover this; however, we have not exceeded the diocesan goal this much.

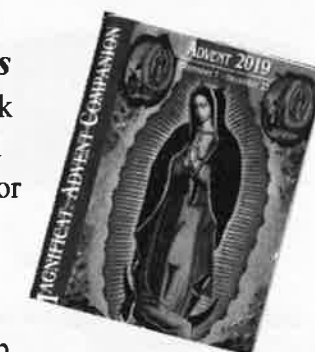
