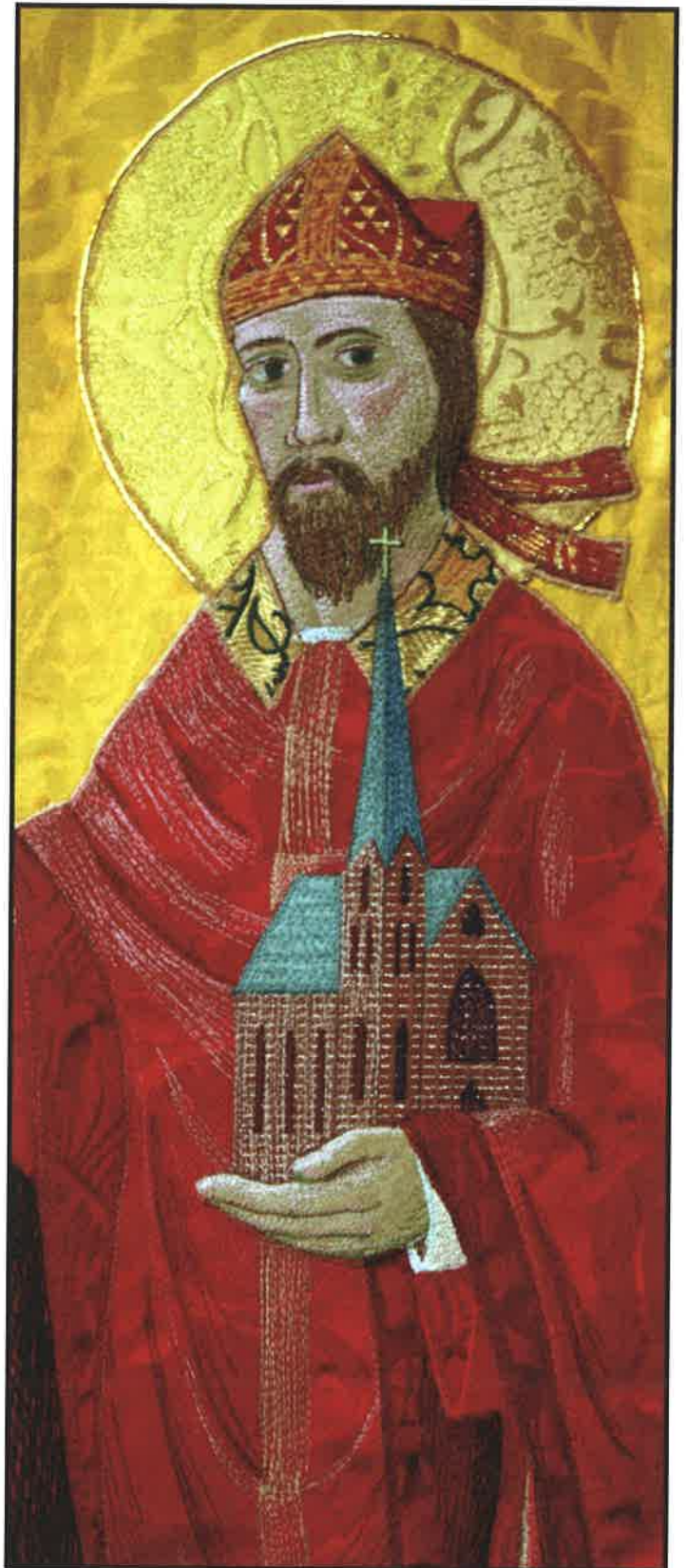

From the Pastor's Desk...

As you would have heard at Mass last weekend there are a number of changes coming to us. I will recap them here for clarity's sake:

A.) I've been named Vocations Director for the Diocese of Columbus. I will begin working in January part-time with the current director, Fr. Paul Noble, while still serving as pastor of the consortium and living at Chillicothe. Next July, I will become full time director, and at that time, will move to the Josephinum Seminary.

B.) At that time (July) St. Colman will become a stand-alone parish with its own resident pastor. That pastor will be appointed by the Bishop probably sometime in the Spring.

C.) St Peter-Chillicothe, St. Mary-Chillicothe and St. Mary-Waverly, will be formed into a consortium led by a pastor and parochial vicar living in Chillicothe.

This is exciting news for St. Colman to once again have its own resident pastor. For my part, although I am sad to leave the consortium and have been blessed these five years of the consortium and 14 years of living in Chillicothe, I am excited to become the Vocations Director of the diocese. I have very much enjoyed working with the seminarians and young priests over the years and look forward to being able to do so in a more formal role. Let us pray for God's guidance and blessing in this time of change!

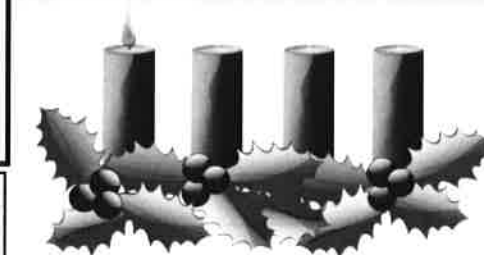

Christmas Flower Donations

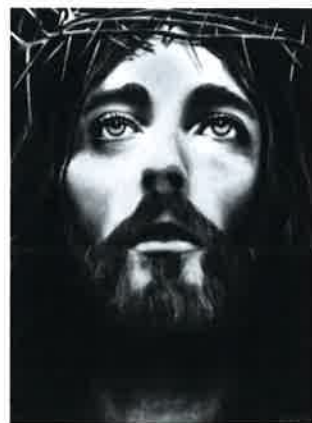
