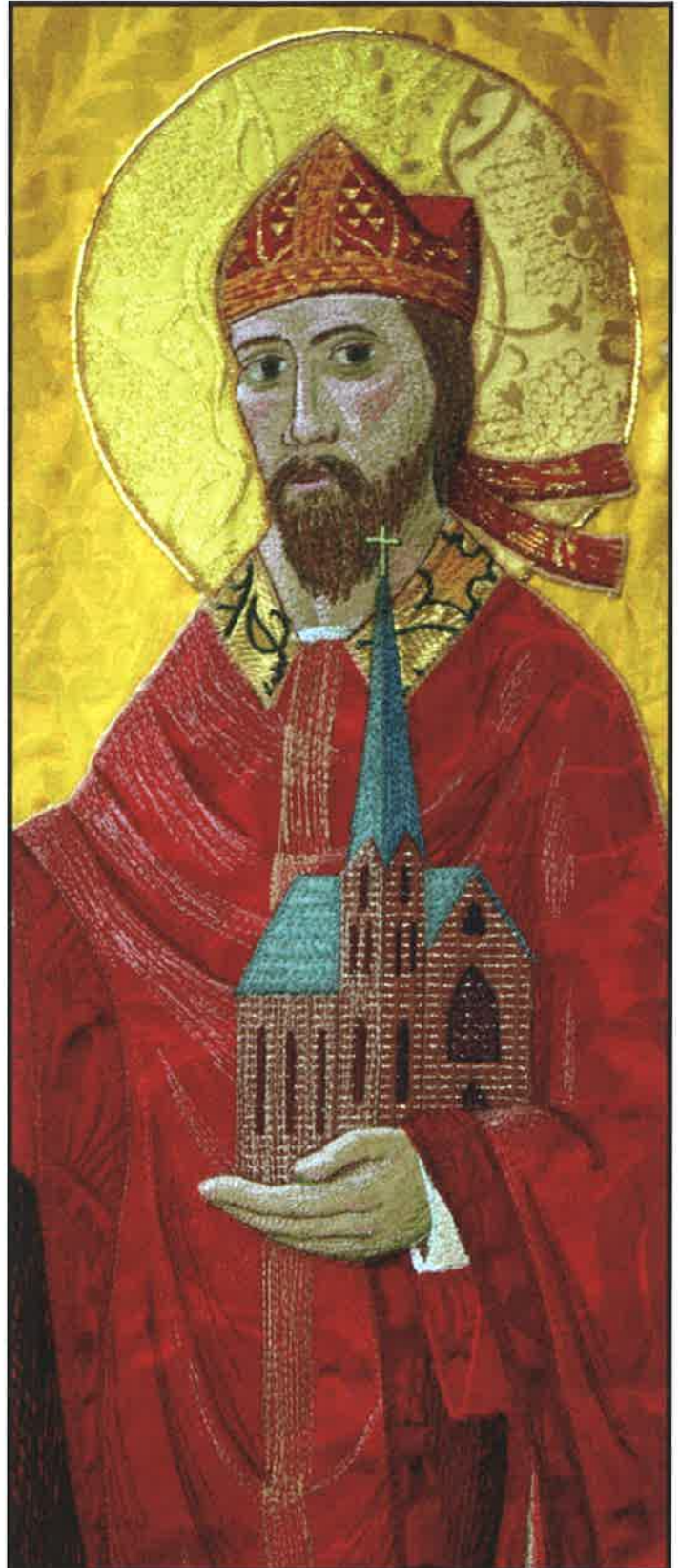

From the Pastor's Desk...

As we begin this second Sunday of Advent, a few reminders for your Advent journey (and your calendars)...

We normally celebrate the **Immaculate Conception on December 8**, however since December 8 is a Sunday this year, the feast day gets bumped to the Monday but loses its obligation. However, Our Sunday Visitor placed an envelope in your giving packets for this Mass. **Mass on Monday, December 9 will be held at 8:30am.** There will be a collection basket in the back of church if you wish to make an offering on this day of our Lady. We will not take up a collection during Mass. Although there is no obligation this year, it still is a wonderful day to celebrate Our Lady and in particular the grace she received of having been conceived without sin.

Daily Mass on Tuesday is at 8:30am so that Fr. Lynch, Fr. Beal and I can be at the St. Peter-St. Mary joint Penance Service in Chillicothe that evening. This is also a reminder of our **Penance Service** here at St. Colman on **Monday, December 16 beginning at 7pm.** We will have two other priests in addition to Fr. Lynch, Fr. Beal and me to hear Confessions. We typically hear confessions until about 8pm. So come anytime in the hour. You do not need to be here at 7pm when the Service begins.

Join us for our traditionally held **Gaudete Sunday Lessons and & Carols on Sunday December 15th at 3:00pm.** This is a wonderful hour spent in scripture and song for your Advent devotion.

Then before you know it, we will be celebrating the birth of Jesus. Masses will be held on **Christmas Eve at 5pm and 10pm** (the choir will begin music at 9:30pm.) **Mass Christmas morning will be held at 10am.**
