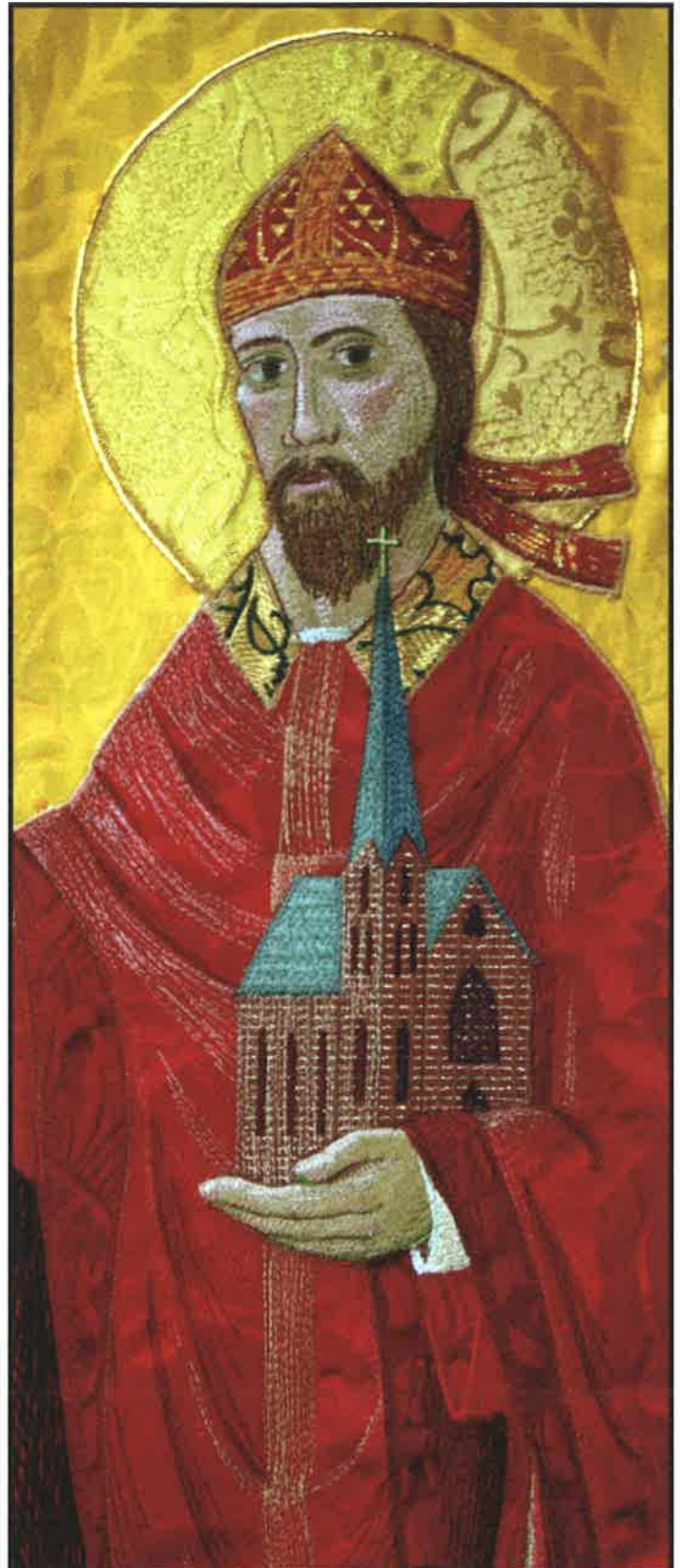

From the Pastor's Desk...

Happy Fourth Sunday of Advent and very shortly Merry Christmas!

This Christmas we will be giving you a Christmas gift from the parish. This is a book by popular Biblical writer Brant Pitre. Its title is *Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary*. In order to understand the New Covenant more completely we must constantly go back to the foundation in the Old Covenant. Another way to say that is that the New Testament is only fully revealed by reading it in the light of the Old Testament. For it is the same One True God who is the author of all old and new. God prepared for the coming of His Son, and part of that was a particular choice that he be born of woman. That woman and her role were first foreshadowed in the Old Covenant. As its description says, "Dr. Pitre uses the Old Testament and Ancient Judaism to unlock how the Bible itself teaches that Mary is in fact the new Eve, the Mother of God, the Queen of Heaven and Earth, and the new Ark of the Covenant." So I invite you to learn more about Mary this Christmas Season. Consider taking up the book and give it at least three chapters before deciding whether to continue reading or not. I think you may be pleasantly surprised by Dr. Pitre.
