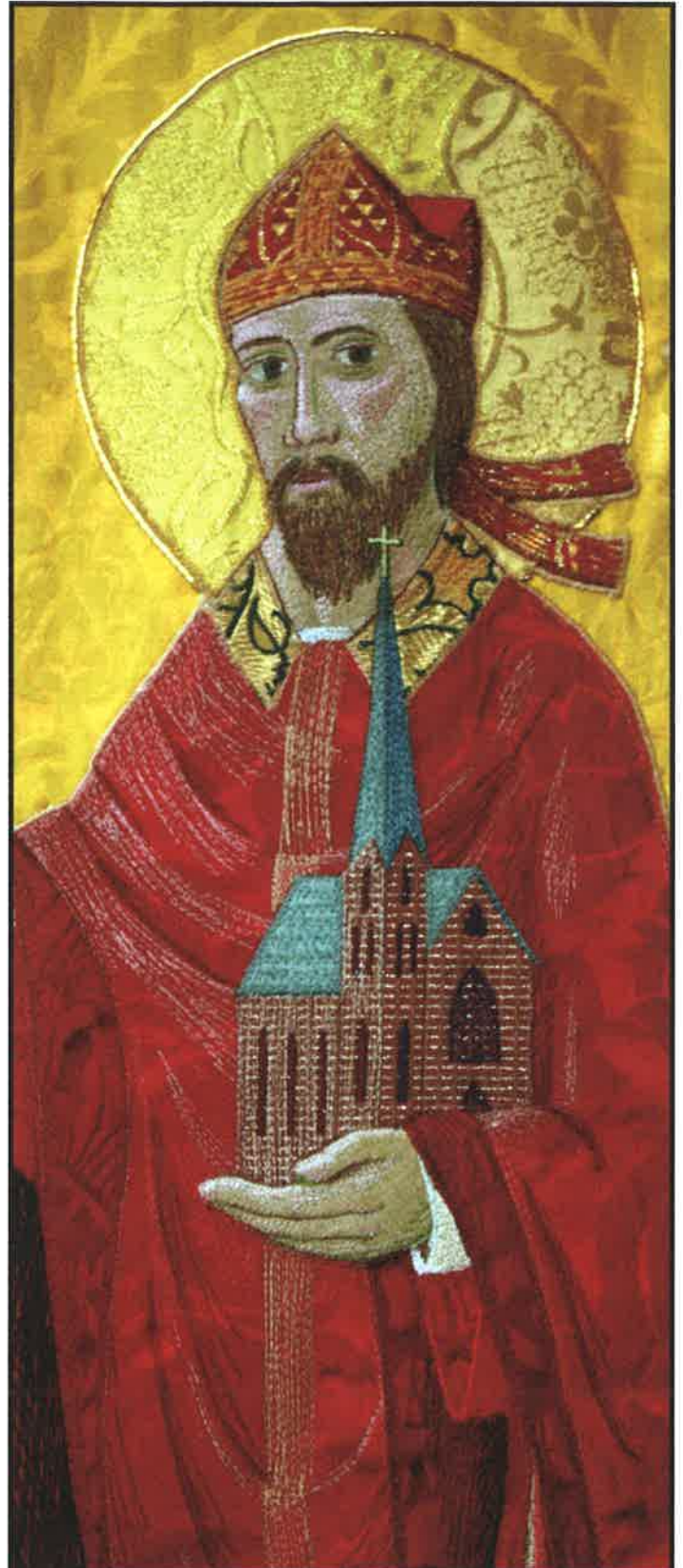

Initial Offering Envelope

The Initial Offering Envelope (in the offering envelope pack) is to help offset the cost incurred by the parish for the offering envelopes. For those of you who receive offering envelopes, each pack costs the parish approximately \$1.00/pack/family. Packs are sent six times a year. So the parish pays approximately \$6.00/family for the offering envelope packs.

If you are receiving offering envelopes, but do not want them or use them, please contact Tina in the parish office, and she will cancel your subscription.

Our online giving program contains all of the offering envelopes included in your pack. The only ones not included are those for Easter and Christmas memorial flowers where you list specific names (although you can still donate to those two flower collections online).

If you have moved to online giving but are still receiving offering envelopes, contact Tina so that she can cancel your envelopes.

Bat Man Will be Here January 6 (weather permitting)

Unfortunately it isn't *The Bat Man*. AAA Wildlife Removal are the bat men who will begin work on January 6 to perform the bat exclusion and full attic restoration to rectify this issue. Found when Marquee Construction was installing the tower doors, the problem is so serious that we must take care of it now or risk damage to the structure of the church. We called three removal companies to quote the project. The Finance Committee and Father Hahn approved the lowest bid from AAA Wildlife Removal. This is a \$25,000 project (barring no unexpected problems or issues) and will be paid for with Capital Improvement monies. We had a generous donor pay off the remaining balance of the tower doors, so the monies collected in the next Capital Improvement collection will go towards the bat removal project. The balance will be paid with the Capital Improvement Reserve Fund that has a current balance of \$28,200. (This is the savings account held at the Diocese that was created in 2018 with the Capital Improvement monies collected in 2017-2018.)

We do not expect our Mass times to be impacted during this time. However, you may see the lift outside the church as early as January 3. They will be removing the damaged insulation and replacing it with new among other things.

It is also important to note that the bats are not being harmed in any way. "Great care is taken to ensure bats are not harmed and as little human to bat contact as possible". They are simply being relocated outside of our church. Exclusion devices will be installed to allow bats to leave naturally and not allow re-entry.

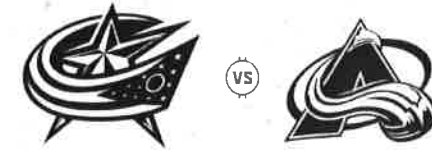
