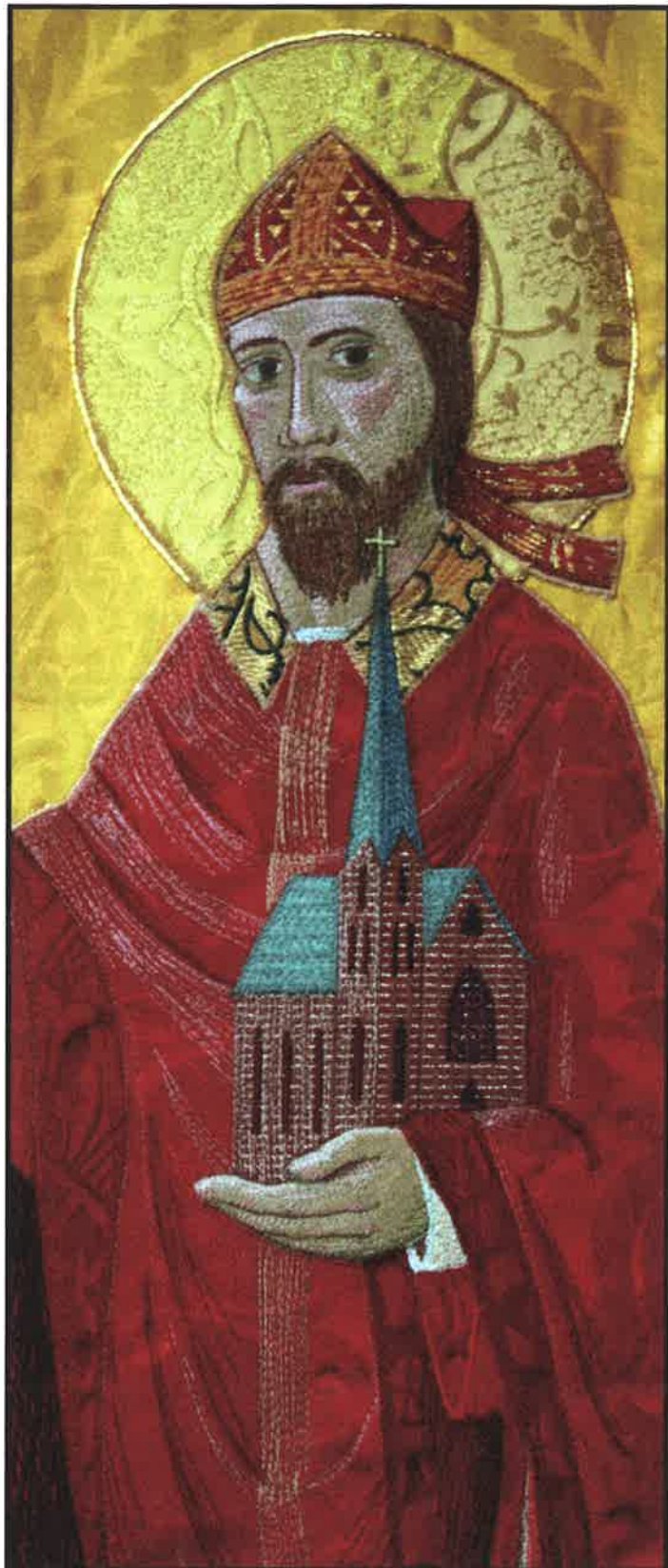

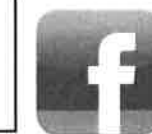
## CUM CHRISTO

## **A Child's First Catholic Dictionary** by Dyches and Mustachio (J/CAT)

It is very colorful as well as informative!

## **Getting to Know God** by Cristine Pedotti (J/FAM)

This is also very colorful! It shows the sacraments as they are performed, the life of Jesus as a boy and prayers.

## **Our Father** by Mary Joslin (J/PRA)

It is beautifully illustrated and explained by various psalms. All who read this will enjoy it!

## **The Mass Explained to Children** by Maria Montessori (XMAS/MON)

This noted teacher shows how to show children the basics of the Mass in easy steps. This is a very good book for children to read before becoming altar servers.

Are you a dynamic Catholic? If so, you pray, study, are generous and evangelize. Yes, you evangelize by being kind, smiling often and showing others your love. Is your prayer life strong? Do you read something informative about our faith? This book will help you become more involved in your basic beliefs and volunteer in our parish activities.

### **Tweeting with God** by Michel Remery (EVA/REM)
