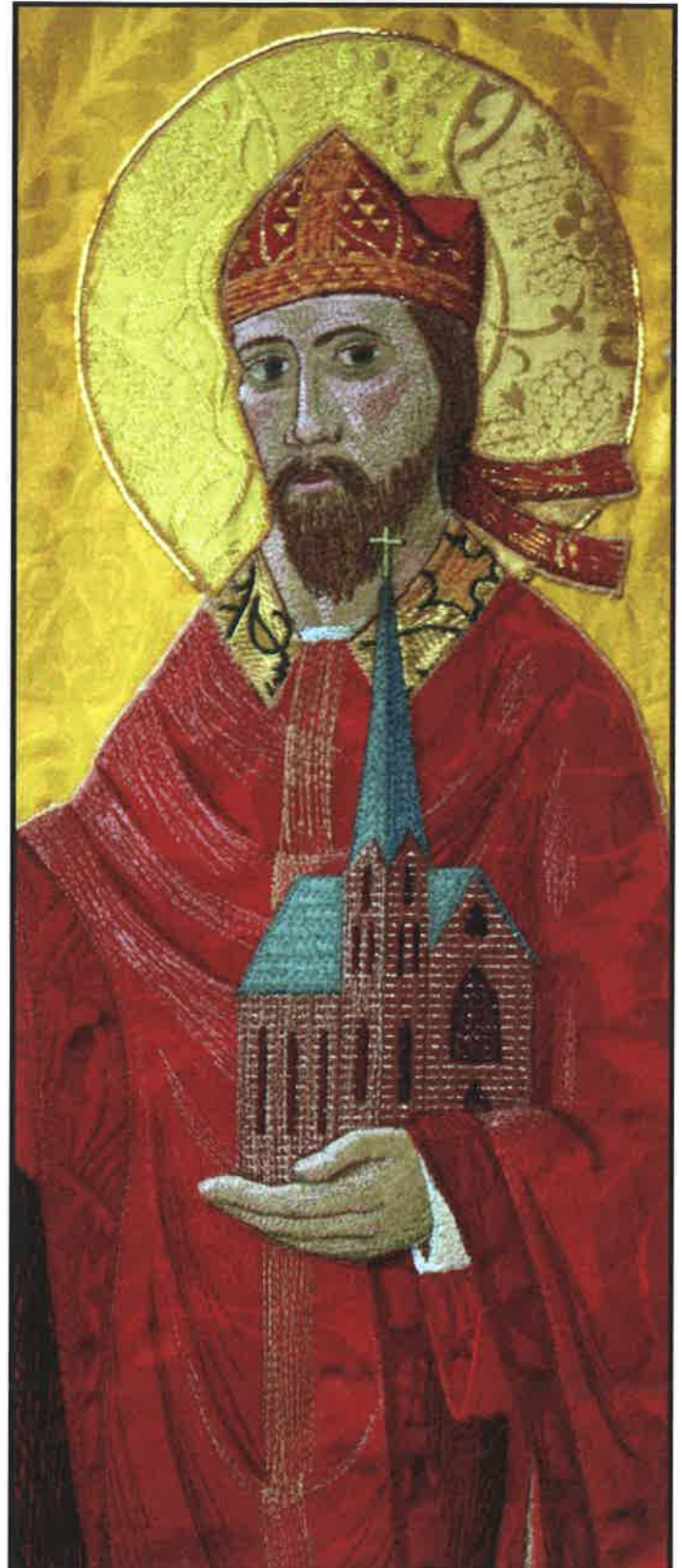

## From the Pastor's Desk...

### Blessing of St. Blaise

This weekend we mark the Feast of St. Blaise (Feb. 3) by providing the opportunity for you to come up and be prayed over with blessed candles. The blessing that is prayed as the candles are held over your throat is: "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." Anyone is eligible to receive this blessing. There is no minimum age and you do not have to be Catholic to receive it.

### Anointing of the Sick

Next weekend during the Mass, we will be celebrating the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Catholics eligible for the sacrament include:

[From the *Instruction on the Pastoral Care of the Sick*]

-A person who is seriously sick – the sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious.

-A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery.

-Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present.

-Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason [are of confession age] to be strengthened by the sacrament.

*After* the Mass next weekend, Fr. Lynch will give a blessing to anyone else wanting prayers and blessing (e.g., for addictions, minor illnesses, strength, faith, etc.).

## Are you a Registered Parishioner?

We have several people who attend Mass here on a regular basis but are not *registered* at the Parish and counted as part of our parish family. Why is that important? Being a registered parishioner allows you to receive parish mailings, rent the facilities at a reduced cost, receive offering envelopes, participate in stewardship opportunities, and simply be *counted* in the parish census as part of our parish family.

Young adults 18 years and older must register as well even though you have been attending Mass here since you were a child (especially if you are no longer living with your parents). It is likely your information did not transfer over when we moved to ParishSoft a couple of years ago.

**NOTE:** It is also important to keep your information current: address, phone numbers, emails, sacraments, births, divorces, etc. should be kept up to date. You can change your information in ParishSoft by using your login or email Tina in the Parish Office.

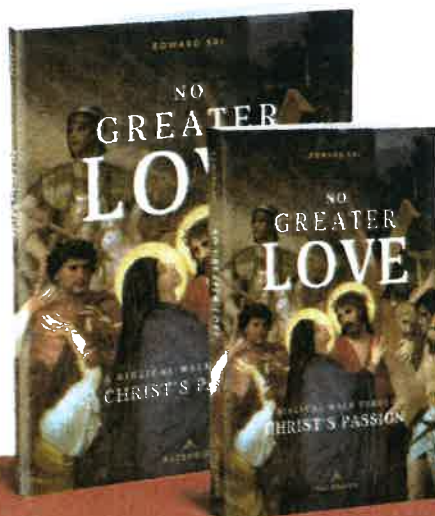
