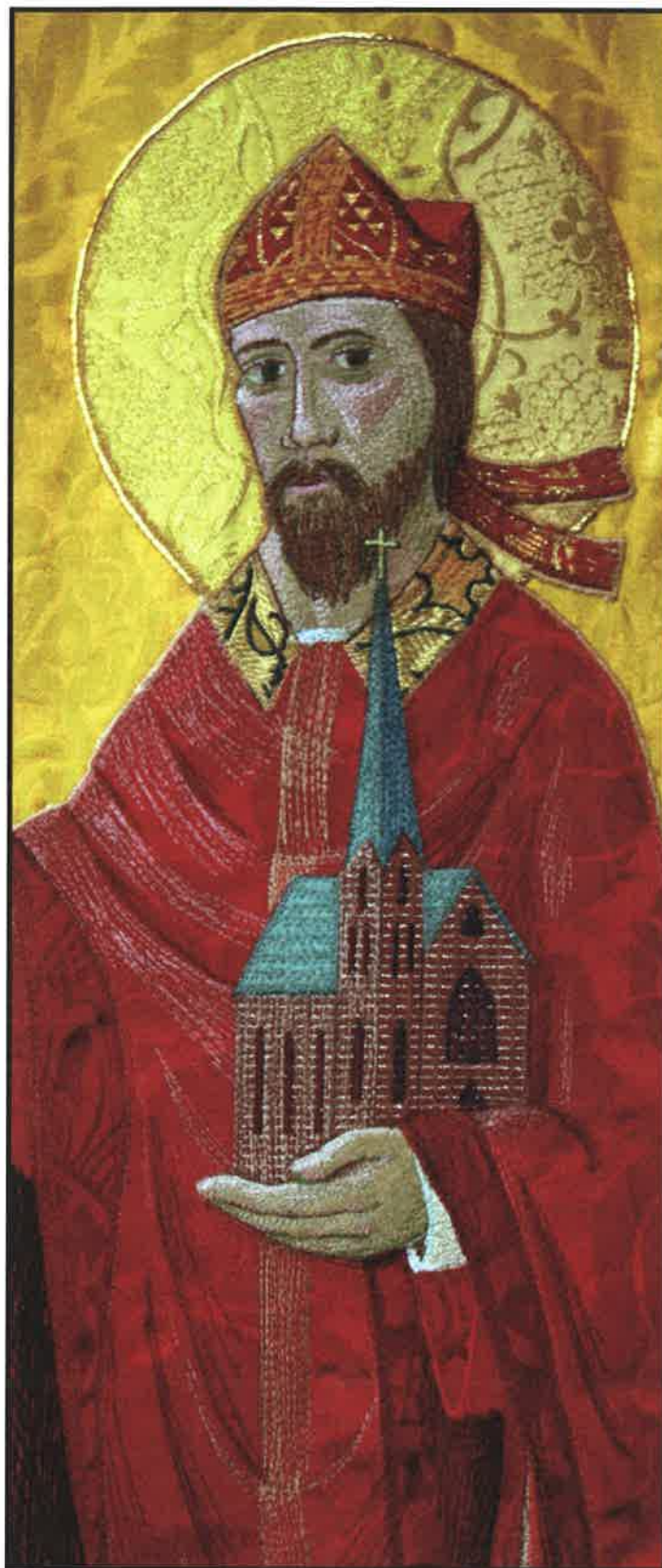

Miryante is working on a project to convert their bio gas stoves into more energy efficient stoves. Due to the amount of soot created by current stoves, residents' health is negatively affected. The new energy saving stoves will create a healthier kitchen environment, cook faster, save 60%+ on firewood, prevent open fire accidents, and last much longer. Besides this project, the orphanage will also be able to repair the nurses' bay which is in need of fixing. Be sure to take an offering box home with you next weekend, fill it up throughout Lent with your gifts of alms, and then bring back on Holy Thursday or Easter.

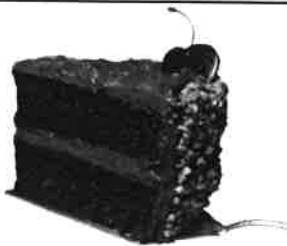

One request please: Homemade desserts only. Should there be store-bought desserts (and they can tell), they are put out last after all of the homemade desserts have been served.

Are you a Registered Parishioner?

We have several people who attend Mass here on a regular basis but are not *registered* at the Parish and counted as part of our parish family. Why is that important? Being a registered parishioner allows you to receive parish mailings, rent the facilities at a reduced cost, receive offering envelopes, participate in stewardship opportunities, and simply be *counted* in the parish census as part of our parish family.

Young adults 18 years and older must register as well even though you have been attending Mass here since you were a child (especially if you are no longer living with your parents). It is likely your information did not transfer over when we moved to ParishSoft a couple of years ago.

Registration can be done online at www.stcolmanwch.org. Paper forms are available in the Parish Office and on the literature rack in the Parish Hall.

NOTE: It is also important to keep your information current: address, phone numbers, emails, sacraments, births, divorces, etc. should be kept up to date. You can change your information in ParishSoft by using your login or email Tina in the Parish Office.

However, he would want us to remember him through happy memories and celebrate his life for the amazing journey it was.
