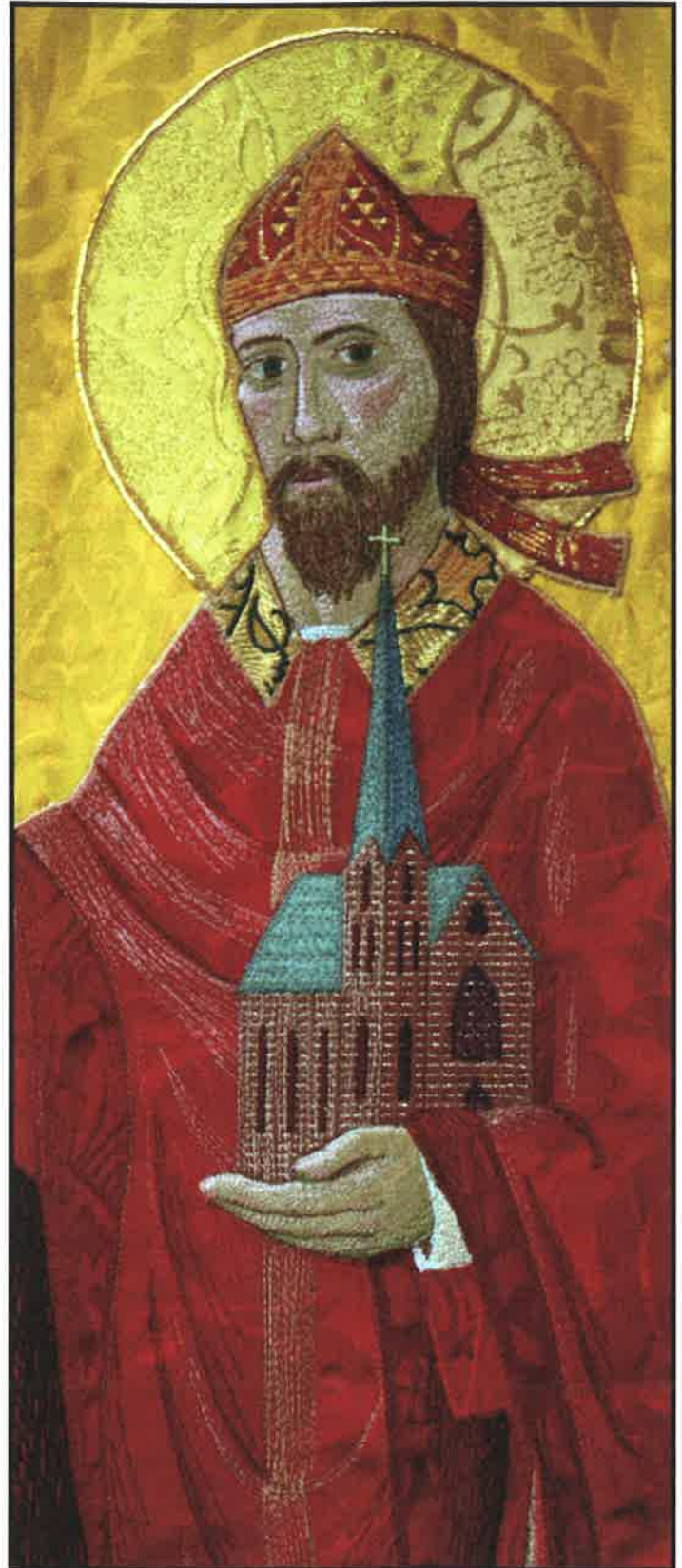

Dear Parishioners of the Consortium,

It is with great joy that we return to public worship this weekend in the consortium. Although it will be greatly modified and limited for the time, we are at least able to gather together once again and many are able to receive our Lord in the Eucharist for the first time in months. As we enter back, I ask for your patience with the changes. I also want to thank those who have stepped up to help them in this time by serving as temporary ushers.

As we celebrate Pentecost, may the Holy Spirit give us a new fire and focus in this time. Come Holy Spirit!
