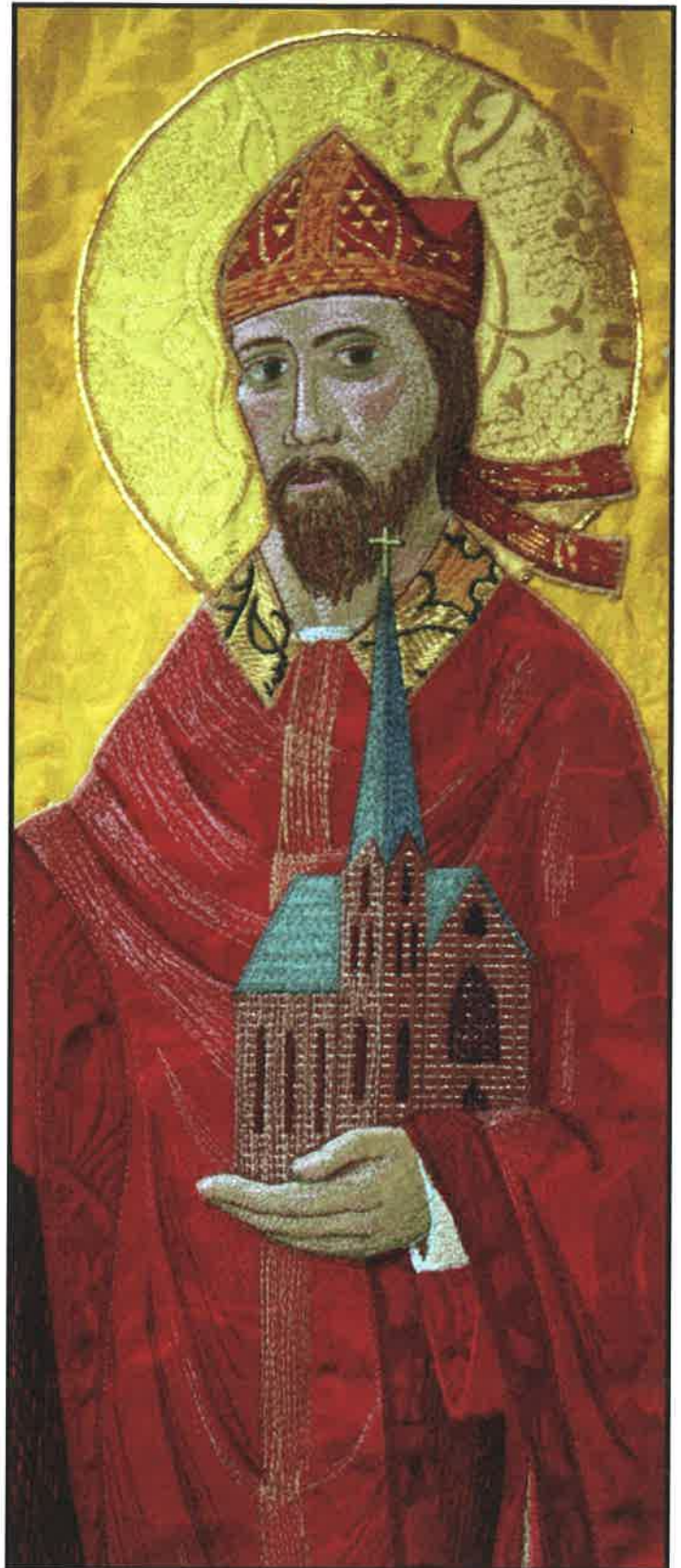

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

Now that we have a week of Masses back in the church, I want to thank everyone who attended for your patience as we try to find the best plan of action. We found already that we can make a couple of changes that may make things more convenient:

Sunday Mass time is now 9:00am. We found it didn't take as long to sanitize the church between the Saturday and Sunday Masses as originally thought. So beginning this weekend, the Sunday Mass will now be at **9:00am**. We expect this to remain in place at least until Fr. Haddad arrives in July.

Seating plan has changed. You will find a different configuration for the seating than we had last weekend. Now that we have seated people for four Masses, we think seating in every third pew would be easier for the Usher team and for parishioners to manage. This plan allows for families to sit where they like as well as everyone else — so long as you stay 6 feet away from the others in your pew. The 6ft. required distance is accomplished front to back by using every third pew. It is only the side-to-side distance you need to be mindful of to make sure you are 6 feet from your neighbor at the other end of the pew if it is someone you don't plan to sit right next to.

For weekend Masses, we ask that you sit at the end of the pew if you are sitting by yourself or with another family member instead of in the middle of the pew. This maximizes the seating capacity. As long as daily Mass attendance is low, you can sit in the middle of the pew if you prefer because not all of the seats are needed.

We tried the other plan first because it accommodated more people. However, this new plan allows you to sit where you like regardless of how many are in your party.

Ticketing will continue at this point. This eliminates you from driving to the church only to find out all of the available seating is taken and you cannot stay for Mass. This system is still being perfected. We are still trying to figure out how many available tickets we can have to accommodate the way everyone needs to sit throughout the church. That is why you see a different number in the maximum tickets allowed for each Mass. We should have it ironed out in the next couple of weeks.

While this isn't the ideal way to celebrate Mass, it was wonderful to celebrate Mass with parishioners sitting in the pews, singing and responding throughout the liturgy.

Those of you who continue to stay home and watch our live-stream of Sunday's Mass or another Mass production, you were still with us in spirit. Since the Bishop has granted the dispensation to attend Mass into September, we do not expect you to join us in the church until you are completely comfortable doing so.

On another note, this coming week we will celebrate the Mass of First Holy Communion for Matthew Arnold, Shayla Bonine, Reese Carner, Griffin Davidson and Kinzley Sword. What a wonderful sacrament to receive for the first time. As Catholics, we believe that the consecrated bread and wine is the actual body and blood, soul and divinity of Christ. What a grace-filled moment for them all!
