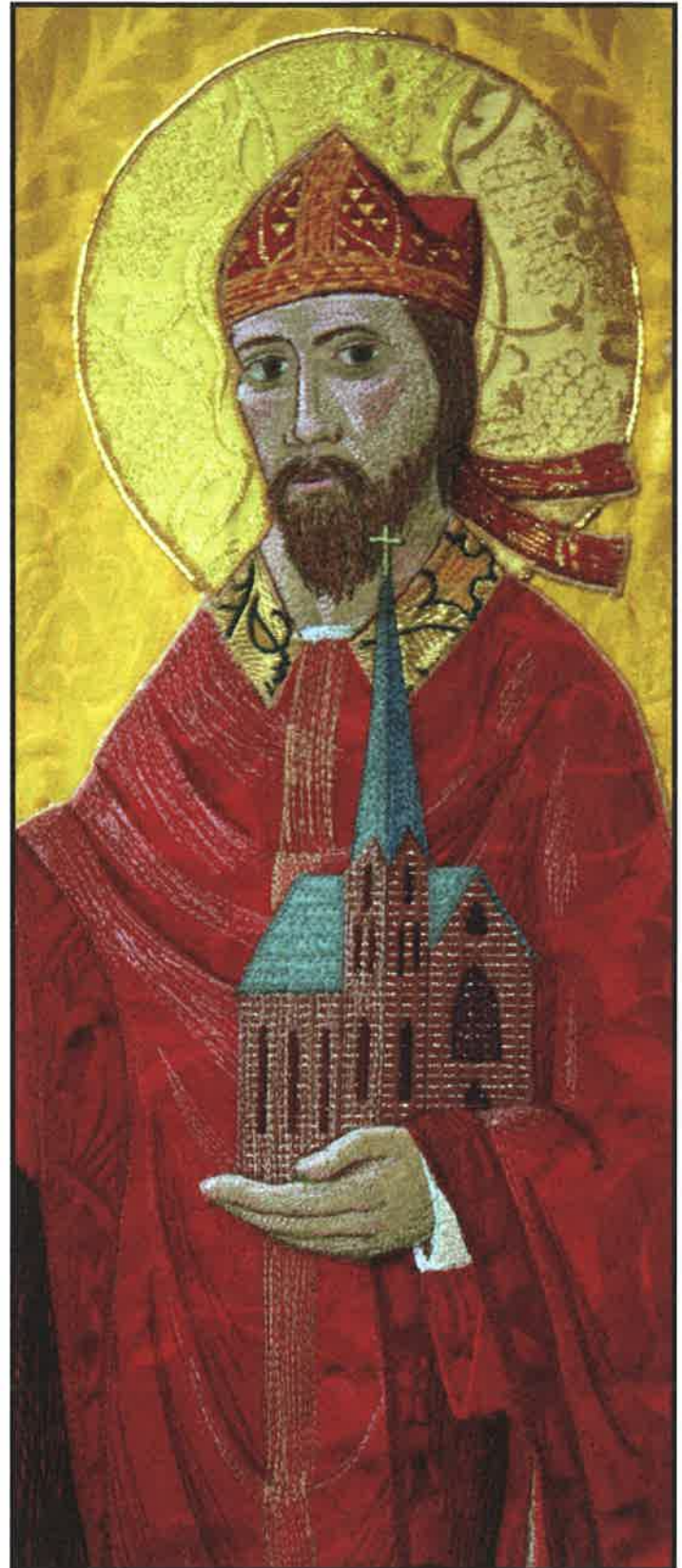

This week will see the celebration of a number of sacraments in the parish and diocese.

On Friday, June 12 in Columbus in a private ordination Mass, two transitional deacons will be ordained. One of them is seminarian Jacob Stinnett who you will remember from his time with us last summer. The following day, three men will be ordained priests for our diocese in a private ordination Mass. Please keep them all in your prayers. Because these are private Masses due to COVID regulations, they will be livestreamed for the general public. Saturday, June 13, our second graders will be making their First Holy Communion in a private Mass at 10am. We pray for them as they have waited even longer than normal to receive our Lord for the first time in this wonderful Sacrament!

On Tuesday, June 16, our RCIA candidates and catechumens will be brought into the Church at the 5:30 evening Mass. We rejoice with them that their long wait has at last come to an end.

Finally next Saturday, June 20 at 1:00 pm, our confirmandi will be confirmed in a private Mass with Bishop Brennan and their immediate families and sponsors. We pray for a full outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon them in this final sacrament of initiation.

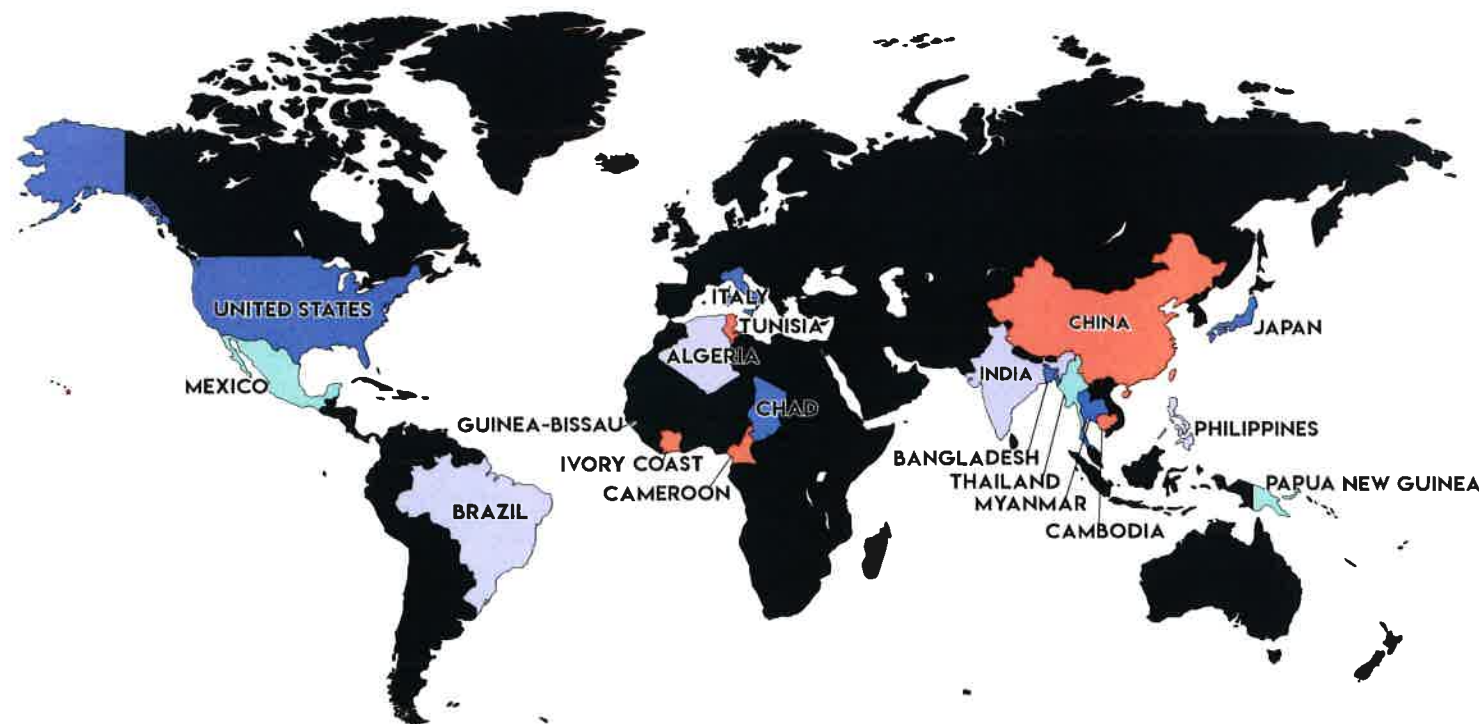
