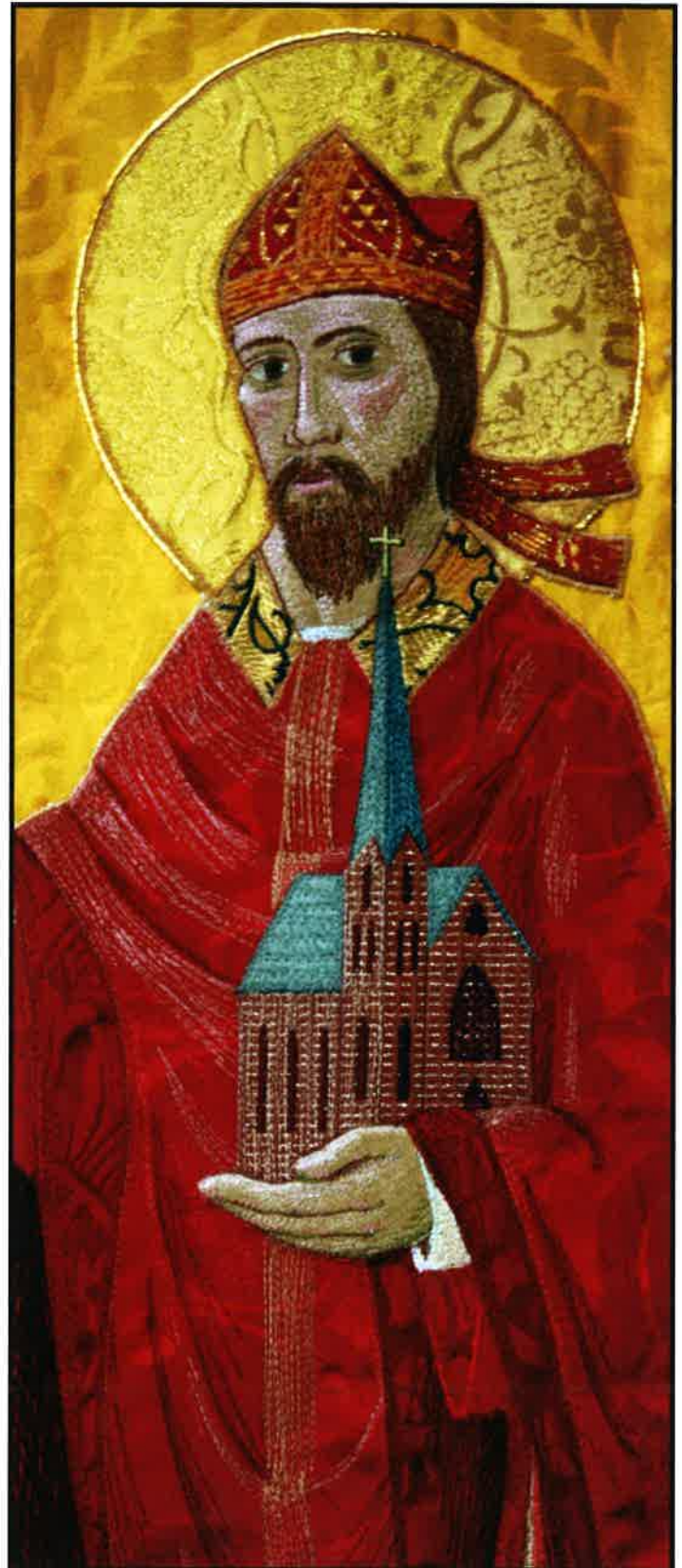

The Catholic Bishops have granted the dispensation of the weekly obligation to attend weekend Mass indefinitely. If you choose to attend Mass, face masks are required as well as a ticket for the weekend Mass that you want to attend (including the new Sunday Mass at 11am.). Tickets may be obtained via the link on the St. Colman website or by calling the Parish Office before Thursday. Daily Masses do not require a ticket to attend.

From the Pastor's Desk...

FNext week is national vocations awareness week. A vocation is a calling from God to live the universal call to holiness in a particular way. Living God's call to Holy Matrimony, which is also a Sacrament, is the most common of vocations. (And a good thing too. We'd run out of Church real fast if it wasn't.)

In this vocation, men and women are called to help one another grow in holiness and secure the salvation of their spouse. Marriages are often troubled when this goal is left unattended. If you are called to matrimony, pray now for your future spouse, even if that spouse is unknown. If you are married and if you don't already, start praying with your spouse every day. Even starting with a single Our Father can make a real difference in your marriage and in realizing the goal of salvation. Whether married or not, called to marriage or not, pray for married couples and those who will enter Matrimony, that their marriages are fruitful reflections of the marriage of Christ and His bride the Church.

The religious life is so varied and diverse. From orders who are missionaries, or teachers, or involved in medicine, to purely contemplative orders who hold the world together by the grace produced from their prayer, there is no end to the variety of charisms to be found in the religious life. Truly the unsung heroes of the Church often go unnoticed in humble service to us all. Often young men and women fail to recognize their vocation is in the religious life through a lack of exposure to this way of life. Visiting a monastery or abbey is always a worthwhile activity. We should pray for those who dedicate their lives to God in this way, and pray especially for those who are considering this vocation. It is such a radical choice for Christ, those who are discerning this really need our support in this day and age.

The priesthood is a vocation and a Sacrament which is dedicated to the service of the people of God through the offering of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the administration of the Sacraments. The priest has a special nuptial relationship to the Church and is called to see and serve the people of God as his spiritual children. As with all of these vocations, those priesthood are making a choice contrary to the secular world. We must pray for and encourage those considering the priesthood as well as the priests we have. I will add myself here and shamelessly ask for your prayers as your spiritual father. (I need'em.)

Whatever your vocation, whatever God wants from you and for you, remember holiness and the unbridled love of God, caritas, is the goal. We must all pray for each other's vocations and with God's good grace, grow in holiness together.
