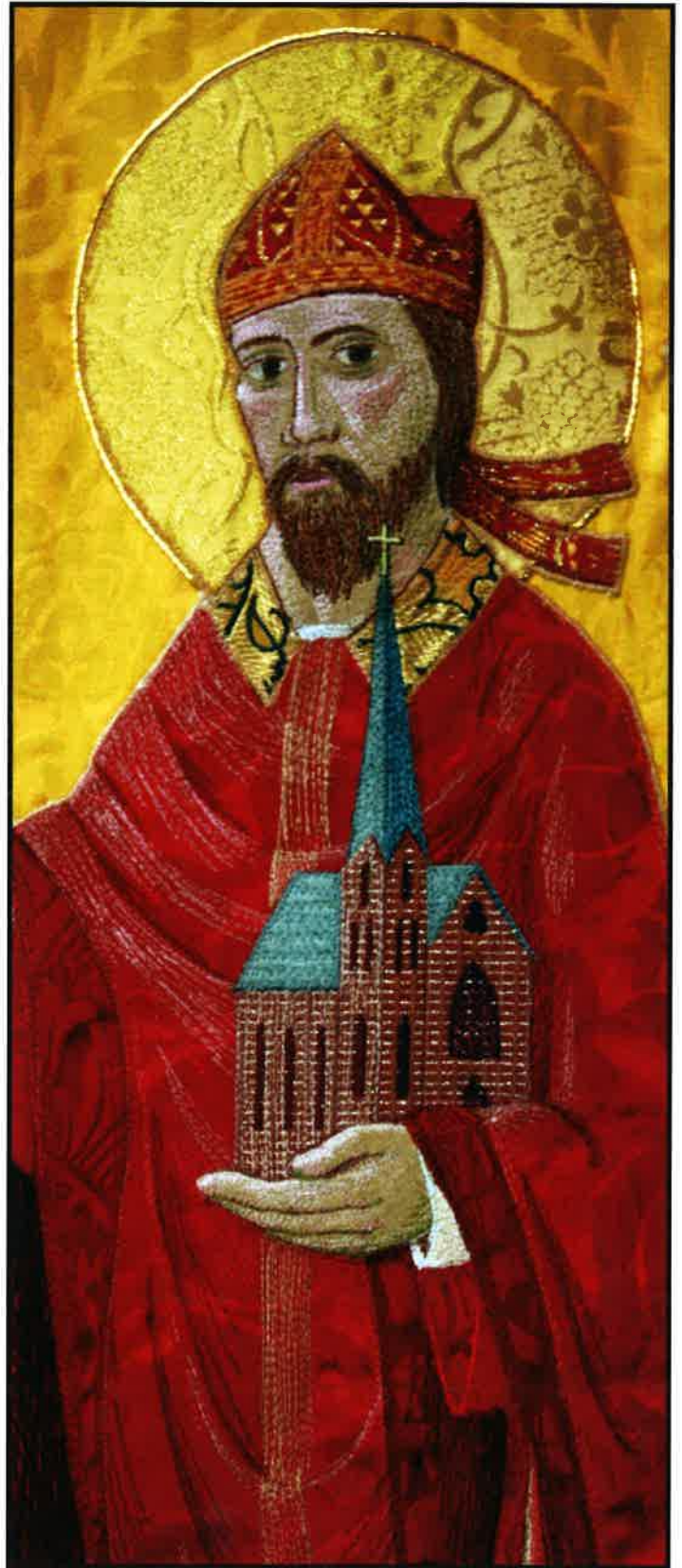

Robert Clark Conaway, 86, of Washington Court House, Ohio died Monday, November 2, 2020, at 4:23 p.m. at his home. He had been in failing health.

Bob was born April 10, 1934, in Bloomingburg, Ohio to Clarence E. and Zelma Mae Donahue Conaway, Sr.

He was a U.S. Air Force veteran of the Korean Conflict and Vietnam War. After serving 28 years, he retired in 1979, as a senior master sergeant. He then worked 24 years for the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services, retiring as a supervisor.

The Feast of St. Colman, November 24th

The patronal feast of a parish is a time of celebration and joy. This year, we have a special opportunity to make the most of it. We will have a special Solemn High Mass celebrated by St. Colman's own son, Fr. Brett Garland. It will be Father's first Solemn High which is a notable moment in his priesthood. Additionally, this is a meaningful moment for the parish as it is likely that it has been some time since a Solemn High Mass was celebrated here.

Unfortunately, even before the changes to the liturgy, Solemn High Masses were somewhat rare in the United States. We had fallen into the idea that Mass was a mere obligation and something to "get it over with" as soon as possible. Sadly, this caused many priests and parishes to shy away from more solemn celebrations and many who grew up in that time, did not have the opportunity to see the fullness of the Mass, the fullness of the worship of the Church.

A Solemn High Mass is the most beautiful expression of worship. It has wonderful music as well as significant silences to enter deeply into prayer. While it is in Latin, and that can be a hurdle for many, it need not remain an obstacle to prayer and a profound experience of the graces of the Holy Sacrifice. It takes a little more effort, but all things worthwhile do. And when that effort is made, our hearts are able to soar and we know that we have glimpsed past the veil into our heavenly home.

This is our heritage as Christians. This is the way Christians have prayed and offered their oblation to God down through the centuries. We can look back and imagine all of the saints attending these Masses, having their hearts lifted up to the Lord. And, we know in the silence, the Sacrifice of Christ on His Cross takes place. Offered at the hands of the priest, the Mystery of the Cross is there before our eyes. Those same saints and all the angels are now with us, too, in that quiet moment when the priest pronounces the words of institution, kneels in adoration, elevates the Blessed Sacrament so that we might adore as well, then kneels once more.

For our patronal feast, we will have a special Mass setting sung by the St. Philip Neri Singers. They will be singing the Mass for Four Voices by William Byrd. This is a polyphonic Mass setting which was written with the intention of celebrating Mass in secret as it was composed during the persecution of the Church in England. This is a breathtaking piece of music and well merits listening all on its own, but when united to that sacred liturgy for which it was originally intended, it is sublime beyond measure.

So, mark your calendars for November 24th at 7:00pm and come celebrate the feast of St. Colman. St. Colman, pray for us.

From the Pastor's Desk...

From the Pastor's Desk... On Tuesday afternoon of this past week, I was informed that, on Sunday, I had contact with someone who has been confirmed to have COVID-19. Immediately, I scheduled a test and was able to secure a spot that same day. As of this writing (Thursday, November 5th, 2020), I have not received the results of the test. In reviewing our protocols, speaking with my contact with the diocese, and having the specifics reviewed by a doctor who is an expert in the spread of contagion, we came up with the following plan.

First, I would quarantine myself. If my test results come back as negative, then the quarantine will last through Sunday, November 8. Provided I am also symptom free, with seven days since the potential exposure, and a negative test, I have been assured that I will be absolutely safe at that time. If this is the case, as I expect it will be, I will return to public action on Monday, November 9th. We do have a priest to cover Saturday afternoon Confessions and Masses this weekend. PSR will remain unaffected and will be held as usual. But Adoration on Sunday evening will not be held.

Should the test results turn out positive, I will quarantine until it is safe for everyone, following the best medical advice. In any event, we will have weekend Masses and Saturday evening Confessions with substitute priests until it is determined that it is safe for me to return. Unfortunately, with fewer priests available than usual, weekday Masses and other adult catechetical activities will be postponed until further notice.

I appreciate your prayers and forbearance in this time. I am feeling well and am optimistic that I will be able to return on Monday. You will remain in my prayers. May God bless you and St. Colman Parish.
