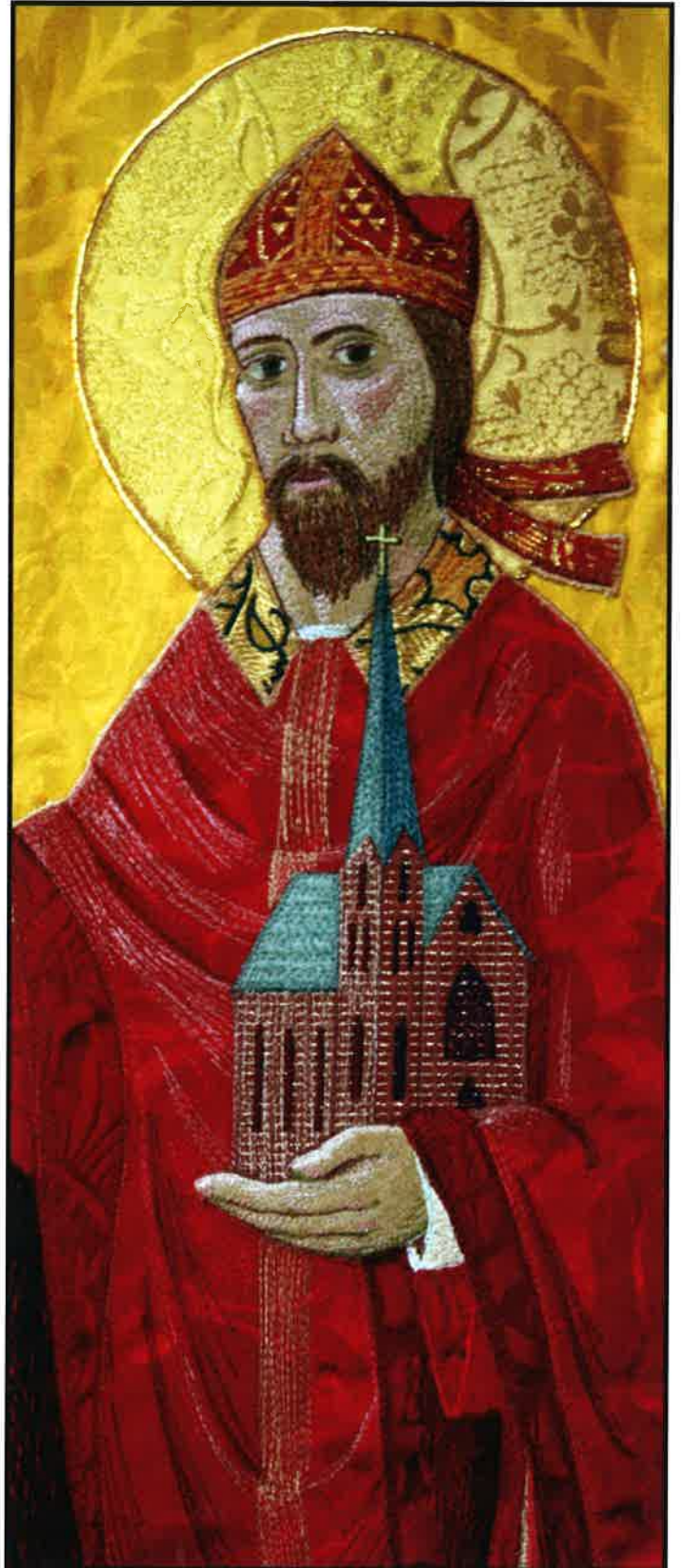

The Catholic Bishops have granted the dispensation of the weekly obligation to attend weekend Mass indefinitely. Those who are feeling well and who are not in the high risk categories are encouraged to come to Mass. Those in the high risk categories, or who are not feeling well, are encouraged to remain home.

If you choose to attend Mass, face masks are required as well as a ticket for the weekend Mass that you want to attend (including the new Sunday Mass at 11am.). Tickets may be obtained via the link on the St. Colman website or by calling the Parish Office before Thursday. Daily Masses do not require a ticket to attend.

From the Pastor's Desk...

The Eucharistic sacrifice, more commonly called Mass, is "the source as summit of the whole of the Christian life." How much do we understand it? We could attend Mass every week of our lives and never really recognize exactly what was happening before our eyes. The Mass is a magnificent gift to us, and the primary and necessary means of worthily offering God the worship He desires, deserves, and commands from us. If we want to live our lives to the fullest, we must treasure the source of that life and the heights to which it is called, the Mass. For us to get the most out of this great gift, we must know and understand the Mass better.

To begin understanding the Mass, we will need to find out exactly what the Mass is. What do we think of when we think of the Mass? Do we think of it as a religious "service", a ritual, a communal meal, something similar to a religious play or pageant, a Biblical reflection, or something else entirely? To answer the question of what the Mass is, we look to why Our Lord instituted it. The Council of Trent informs us that Our Lord gave the Church the Mass to be a "visible sacrifice" which human nature needs. So, if we wish to get the most out of Mass, and live life as Jesus wants, we need to begin to appreciate and participate in the Mass first and foremost as a true sacrifice. All other notions of what the Mass is are either secondary or erroneous. When we truly realize this, our experience of the Mass and our experience of God will be transformed.
