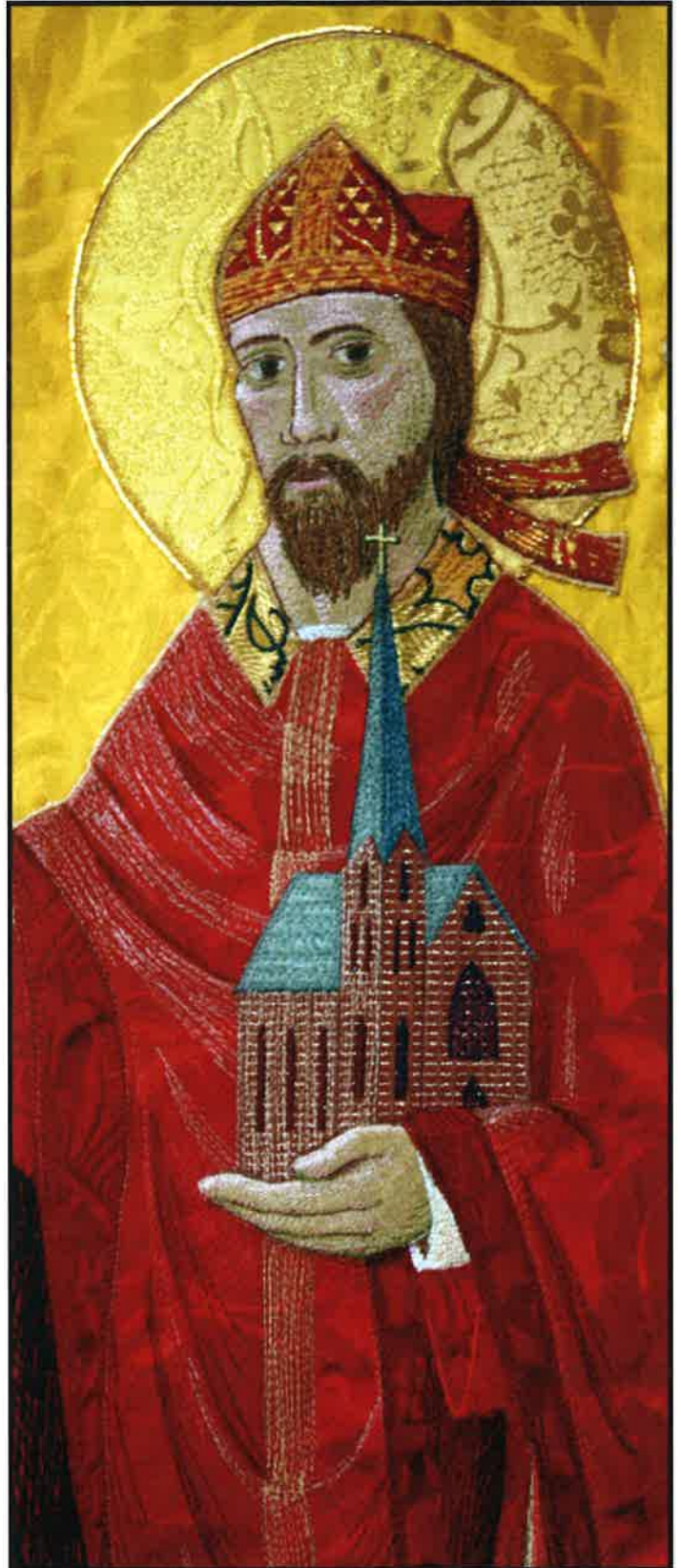

# From the Pastor's Desk...

## Coming up...

This week, on Tuesday, February 2nd, we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord, often called Candlemas, due to the traditional blessing and procession of candles. While sadly we cannot hold the procession this year, we will be blessing your candles at the 5:30pm Mass. We will also have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after Mass as it is the first Tuesday of the month.

Additionally, on Wednesday, February 3rd, is the feast of St. Blaise. The traditional blessing of throats will be given after Mass. Mass will be offered in the Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite.

## Reminder:

Lent is just around the corner. In fact, this Sunday used to be called Septuagesima Sunday, which would be the start of a brief three-week season to get ready for Lent. So as we get closer, we want to think of how we want to make Lent a penitential season. What might we offer up in fasting? What more might we take on, in prayer? What might we give of ourselves, in almsgiving?

Furthermore, we know that while we are dispensed from attending Mass, we are not exempt from the obligatory penitential practices of the Church.

**“Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.”**

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.”<sup>1</sup>

“Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs --- all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, consomme, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are technically not forbidden. However, moral theologians have traditionally taught that we should abstain from all animal-derived products (except foods such as gelatin, butter, cheese and eggs, which do not have any meat taste). Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish are permitted.”<sup>2</sup>
