MATRIMONY

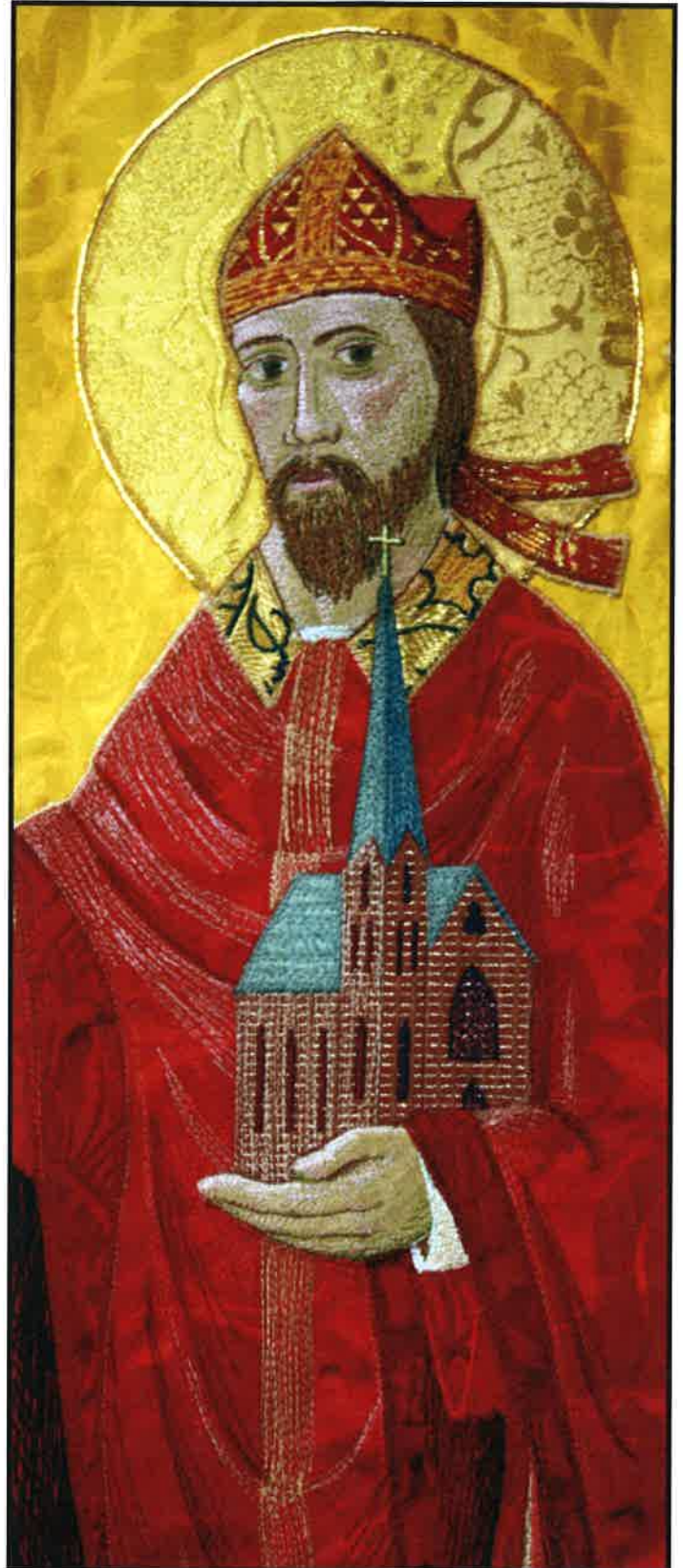

The Catholic Bishops have granted the dispensation of the weekly obligation to attend weekend Mass indefinitely. Those who are feeling well and who are not in the high risk categories are encouraged to come to Mass. Those in the high risk categories, or who are not feeling well, are encouraged to remain home.

If you choose to attend Mass, face masks are required as well as a ticket for the weekend Mass that you want to attend (including the new Sunday Mass at 11am.). Tickets may be obtained via the link on the St. Colman website or by calling the Parish Office before Thursday. Daily Masses do not require a ticket to attend.

Watch the St. Colman Mass on our YouTube channel: "St. Colman of Cloyne Streaming". You can also access it from the website. Just click the link where it says to view Mass "click here".

A reminder... I encourage all who would like to attend Mass on Sundays to sign up ahead of time. You may sign up in three ways: 1) online, 2) by email, or 3) by phone. If you choose not to sign up and come to Mass anyway, you may be asked to wait before being able to sit. Occasionally, there are Mass times when all of the available seats have been taken. Sadly, in these cases, those who have not signed up will not receive a seat. (This seems to be less of a problem at the eleven o'clock Mass, Sunday mornings.) If you would like to discuss the seating policy, please see me—the ushers are volunteers and are simply abiding by what I have asked of them.

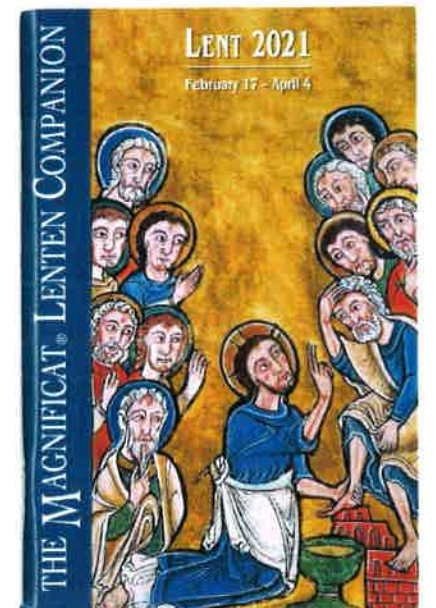

From the Pastor's Desk...

Bishop Brennan has asked us to have a particularly intense devotion to the Real Presence of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Most Holy Eucharist during this Lenten Season. The Diocese is promoting 40 Days of Adoration as a first part of the planning for the future of the Diocese. This means that for every day of Lent a parish in the Diocese will be hosting twelve hours of Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The Real Presence Real Future is the planning process for the future of the diocese and the bishop wants to make sure that it is focused on prayer and on Jesus Christ.

St. Colman will be participating on **Saturday, March 6th**, from 9am until 9pm. Please, come and pray before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament during that time for the good of our parish, the good of the diocese of Columbus, and the spread of the faith, both in Fayette County as well as the Diocese of Columbus. We do need to have a minimum of two people signed up for each hour. The signup sheet is in the back of the church.

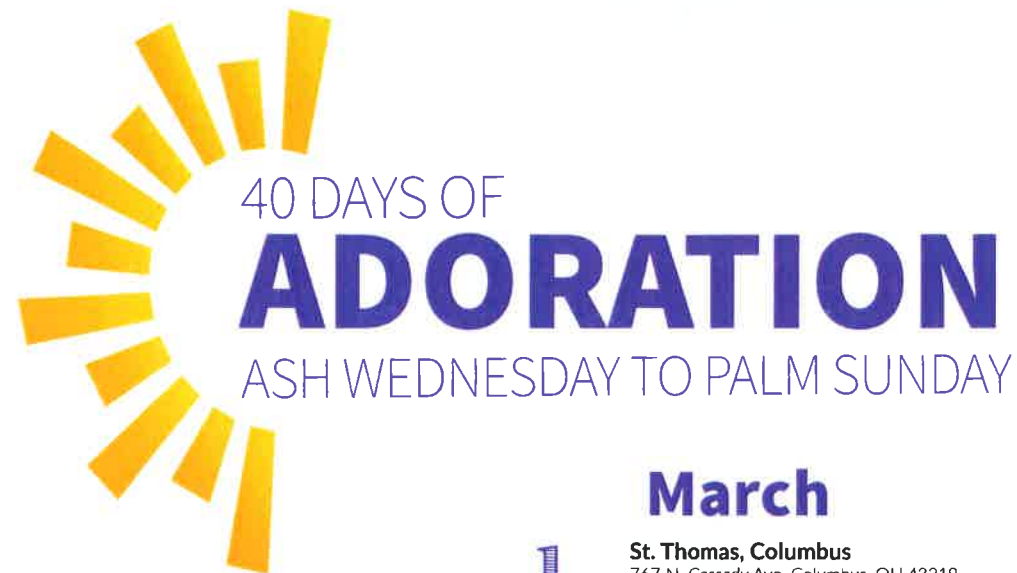
