MATRIMONY

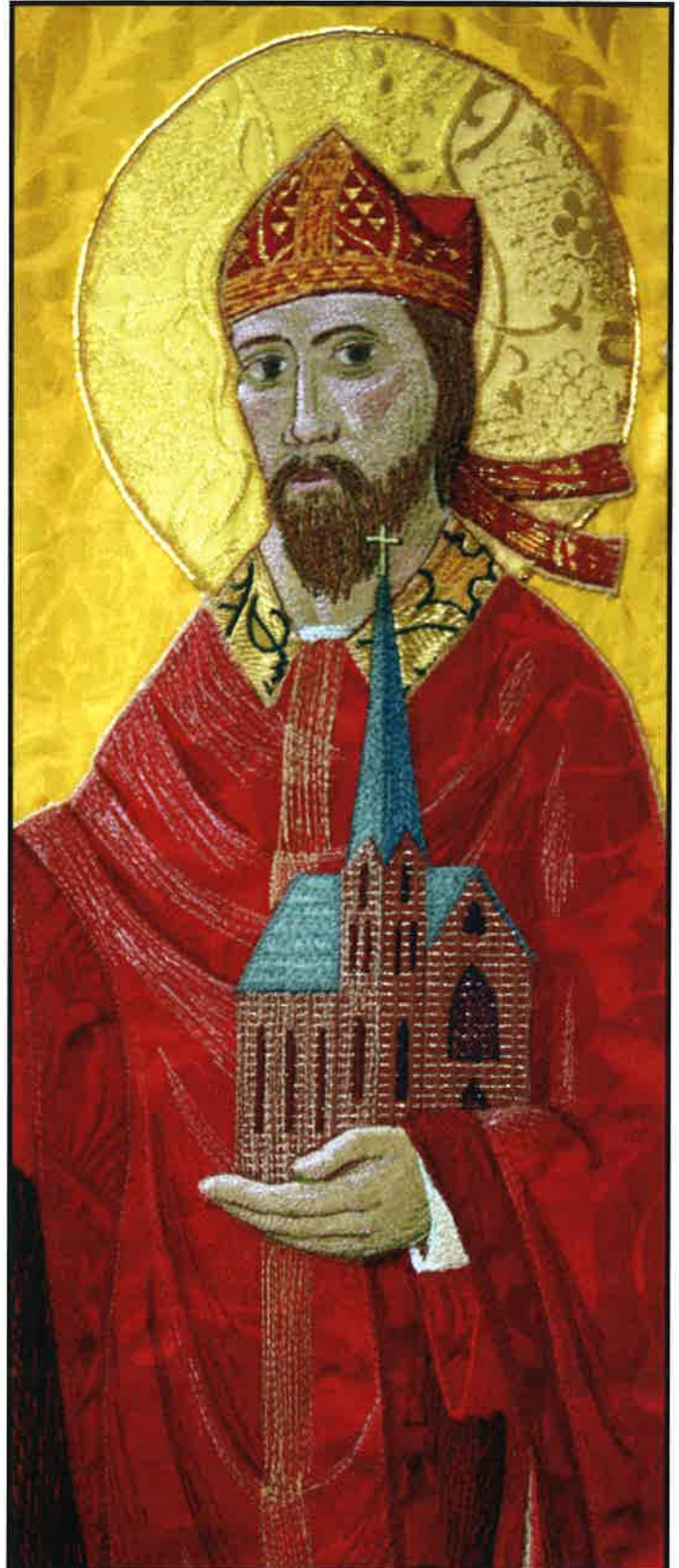

From the Pastor's Desk...

It has been my intention to reorganize the daily Mass schedule here at St. Colman. I would like to offer Masses at times that are the most convenient for the most people. I had originally intended to do this after the pandemic had come to some sort of official conclusion. Given the responses to the Disciple Maker Index, however, I think that it is likely that we can get a good response and make the best decision possible.

I am asking that you take four minutes of your time and fill out the survey. The first part offers several potential schedules for weekday Masses. I am asking that you consider the number of Masses per month you are likely to attend if Mass were offered at that time during the week.

For instance, if you would probably attend Mass ten times per month if Masses were offered Tuesday through Friday at 8am, then you would mark "10" for that potential schedule on the survey. Then if you would likely only come only eight times if Masses were offered at noon, then you would also mark "8" for that potential schedule. This way I will be able to consider your first preference as well as all of the potential times. You may have several potential schedules marked with the same number, or you may have many of them marked with a "0", because you cannot make it to Mass at that time. Ultimately, I am simply attempting to get good data on who would want to go to which Masses so I can make a schedule which serves as many parishioners as possible.

After the first section, there are simply two questions about reading and serving. These are just to gauge interest. Once the schedule is set, I will be looking for people who will be available to help in those roles in a stable way.

Survey ends Monday March 29th, 2021.
