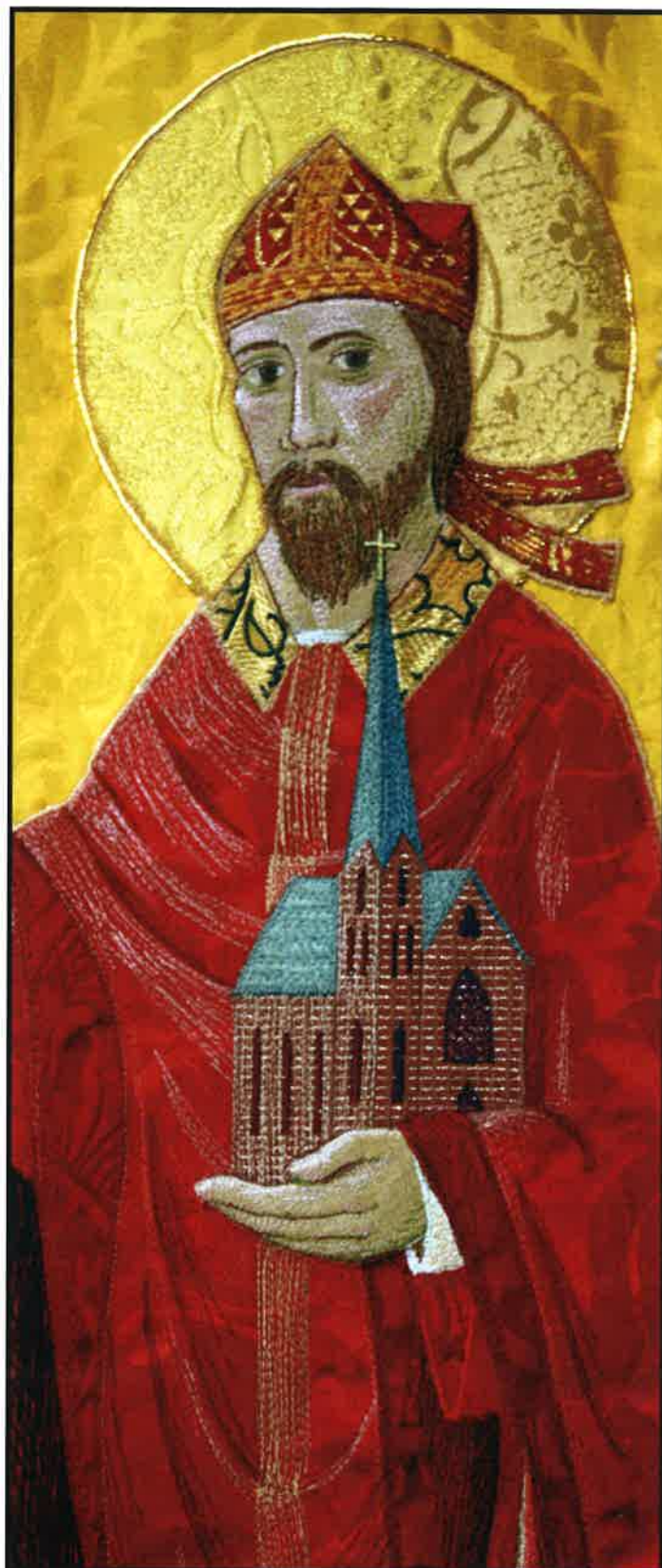

For those who would like, please take a palm as you enter the building. The palms will be blessed as you are holding them in the pews.

♦ Holy Monday through Spy Wednesday Mass at 8:30am

♦ Holy Thursday:

* Mass will begin at 7:00pm. *(Tickets needed. Obtain until noon 4/1)*

* Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will continue in the Chapel of Repose in the Parish Hall after the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday until 10:00pm.

* Compline (Night Prayer) will begin during this Adoration at 9:50pm. Booklets will be available.

• Good Friday:

* Office of Readings & Morning Prayer will be held at 9:00am in the Church. Booklets will be available.

* Confessions will be heard from 1:30-2:30pm.

* The Good Friday liturgy will begin at 3:00pm. *(Tickets needed. Obtain until noon 4/1)*

* Vespers (Evening Prayer) will begin at 5:30pm. Booklets will be available.

♦ Holy Saturday:

* Office of Readings & Morning Prayer will be held at 9:00am in the Parish Hall. Booklets will be available.

* The Vigil Mass will begin at 8:30pm. This year, please, remain in the pews. The procession from the Easter fire will take place with just those being baptized or received into the Church. *(Tickets needed. Obtain until noon 4/3)*

♦ Easter Sunday Mass at 9am and 11am

(Tickets needed. Obtain until noon 4/3)

♦ Easter Monday Mass will be held at 6:00pm.

Topics include: Access to Health Care for the Poor, Addiction and the Opioid Crisis, Medicine and Morals in Making Clinical Decisions, and more!

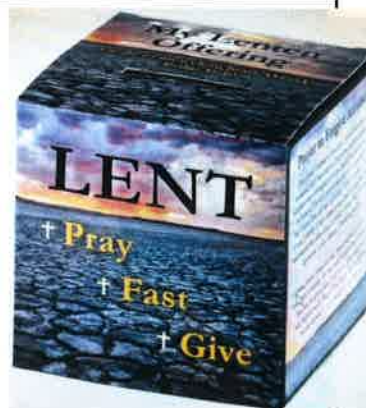

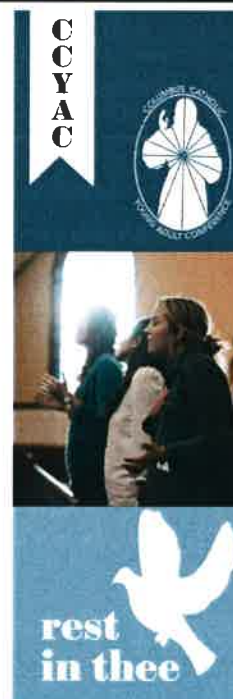
