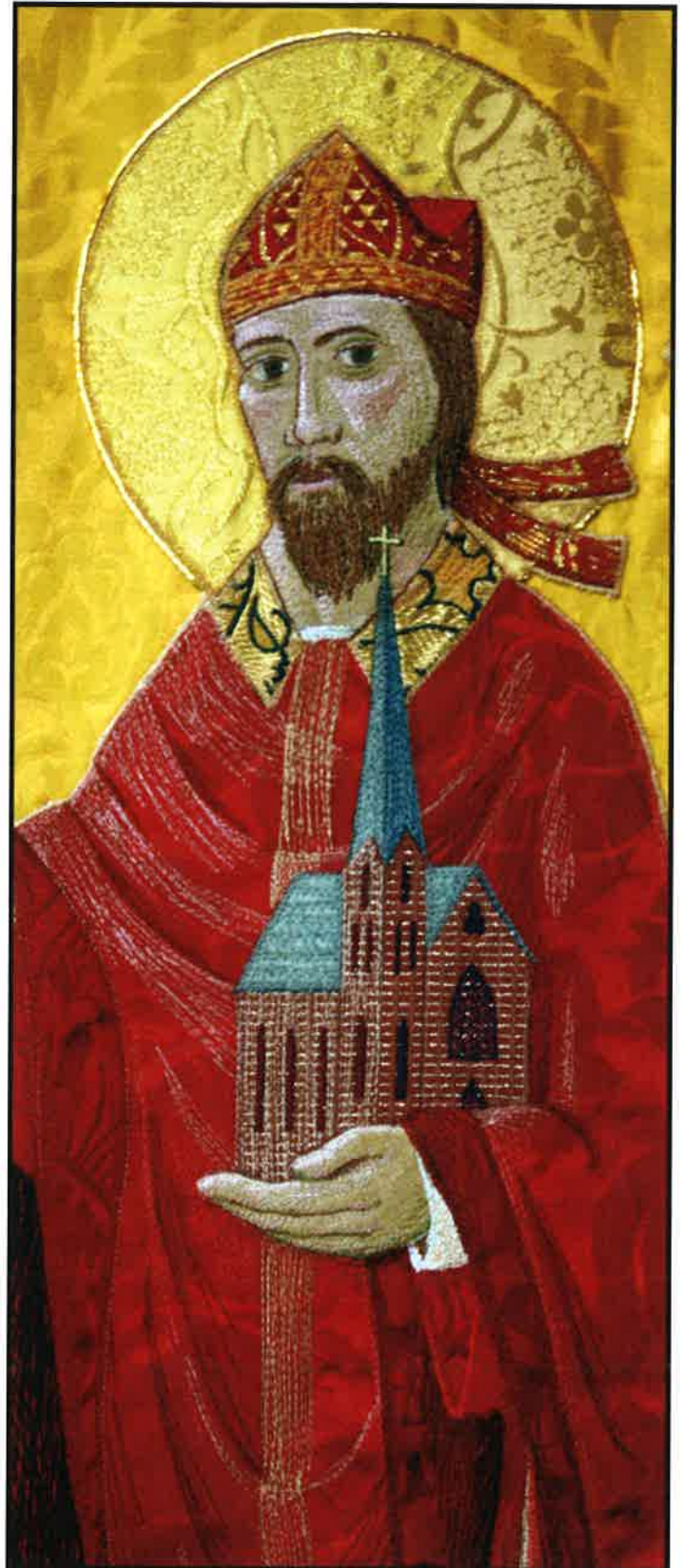

Thank you to everyone who participated in the Weekday Mass schedule survey. Your participation was very helpful and your answers, enlightening. Having reviewed the responses from the Weekday Mass survey, it appears that there is strong preference for Mass to be held at eight in the Morning. The two next most desired Mass times were at noon and five thirty in the evening and nearly equal in desirability. This new weekday Mass schedule is designed with the intention to make weekday Mass available to the most people in response to the data gathered.

Here is the new weekly schedule for **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament:**

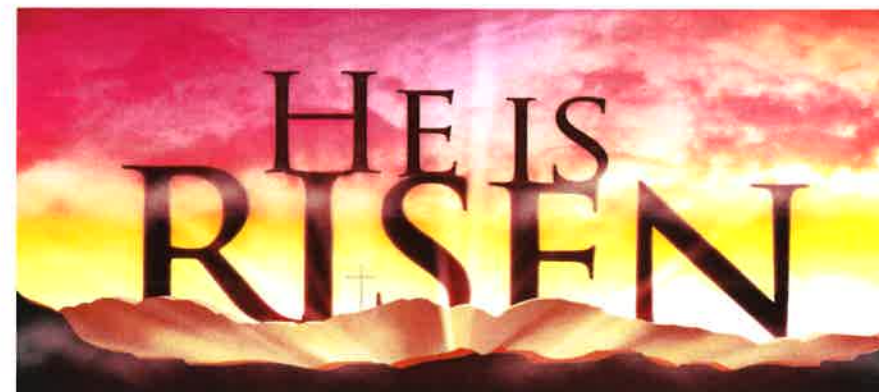
