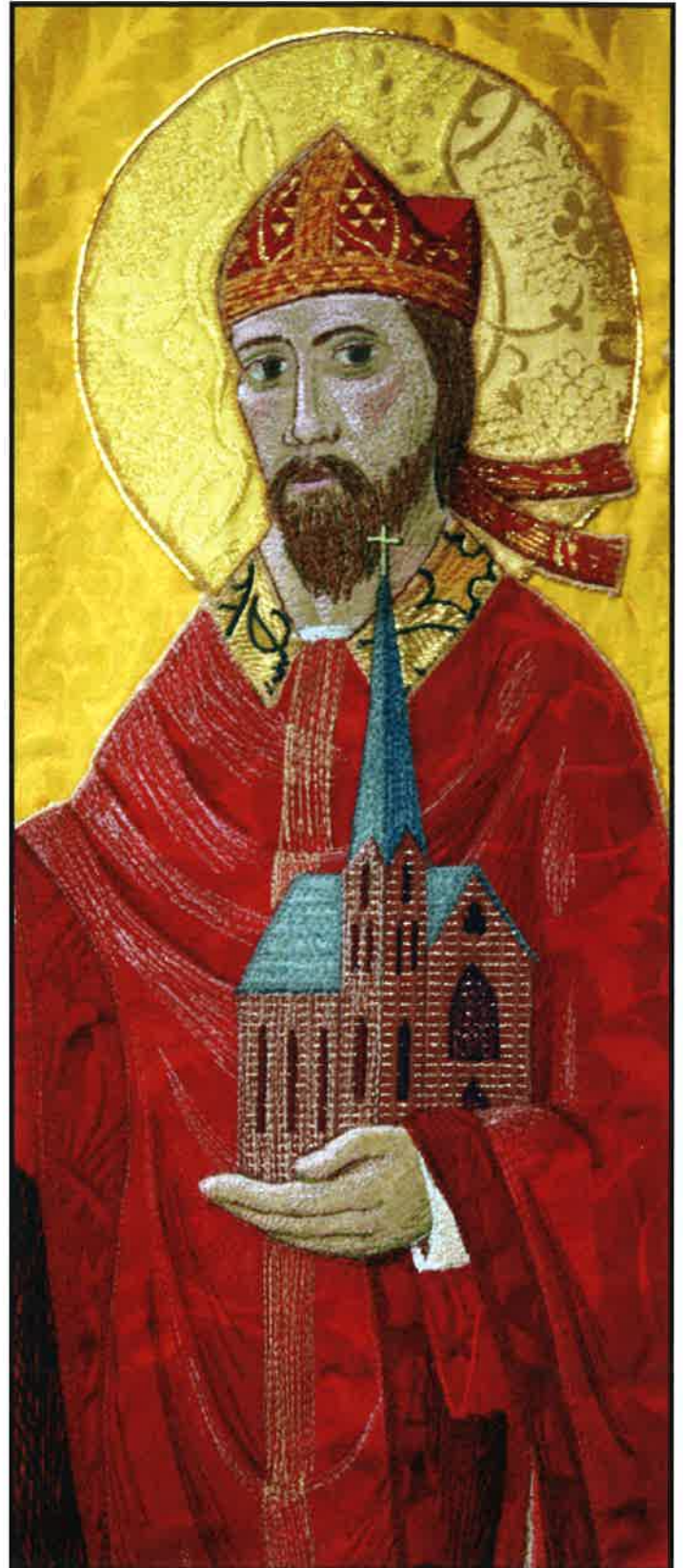

From the Pastor's Desk...

Evangelization is a fancy word that simply means to spread the Gospel. We as Catholics are a bit hesitant to do that, though it is the mission and purpose of the Universal Church. Why are we so hesitant? One reason is it has become somehow impolite to talk about our faith. We are expected by the society in general to keep our faith to ourselves as something merely private and internal. It seems as though the expectation is that our faith ought not affect our lives in any significant way. We wouldn't want to make anyone feel uncomfortable by talking about things that actually matter. Let's just stick with the weather.

Also, we don't want to be shunned by those who will think we're too religious. People may avoid conversation with us because we're perceived as a "Jesus freak" or some other equally disdainful moniker. So, we'll let our vanity and desire for the acceptance of others prevent us from fulfilling what we are called to by Our Lord and Savior.

Perhaps, we are afraid because people will have questions of us and we won't know how to answer them. We could become more educated about our faith so we will know what to say or we could admit our ignorance and answer that we can find out. Those things seem like they would take a lot of effort, and when Our Lord said, "Go and make disciples of all nations...", He probably meant if it wasn't too much of an inconvenience.

The real reason, however, we don't share the Gospel is that we are not excited about it. When we are excited about something, we can't stop talking about it. When we're really excited, we want everyone to be excited about it as well. The salvation Our Lord won for us, the grace given in the Sacraments, the Love of God, and life eternal are exciting in and of themselves. The Catholic faith is filled with wonder and the boundless mystery of the person of Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit are such that they can never be exhausted. As we move into this Easter season, let us pray that we can discover or rediscover in our hearts the wonder, the mystery, and the excitement that the faith ought to bring us and share it with whomever we can.
