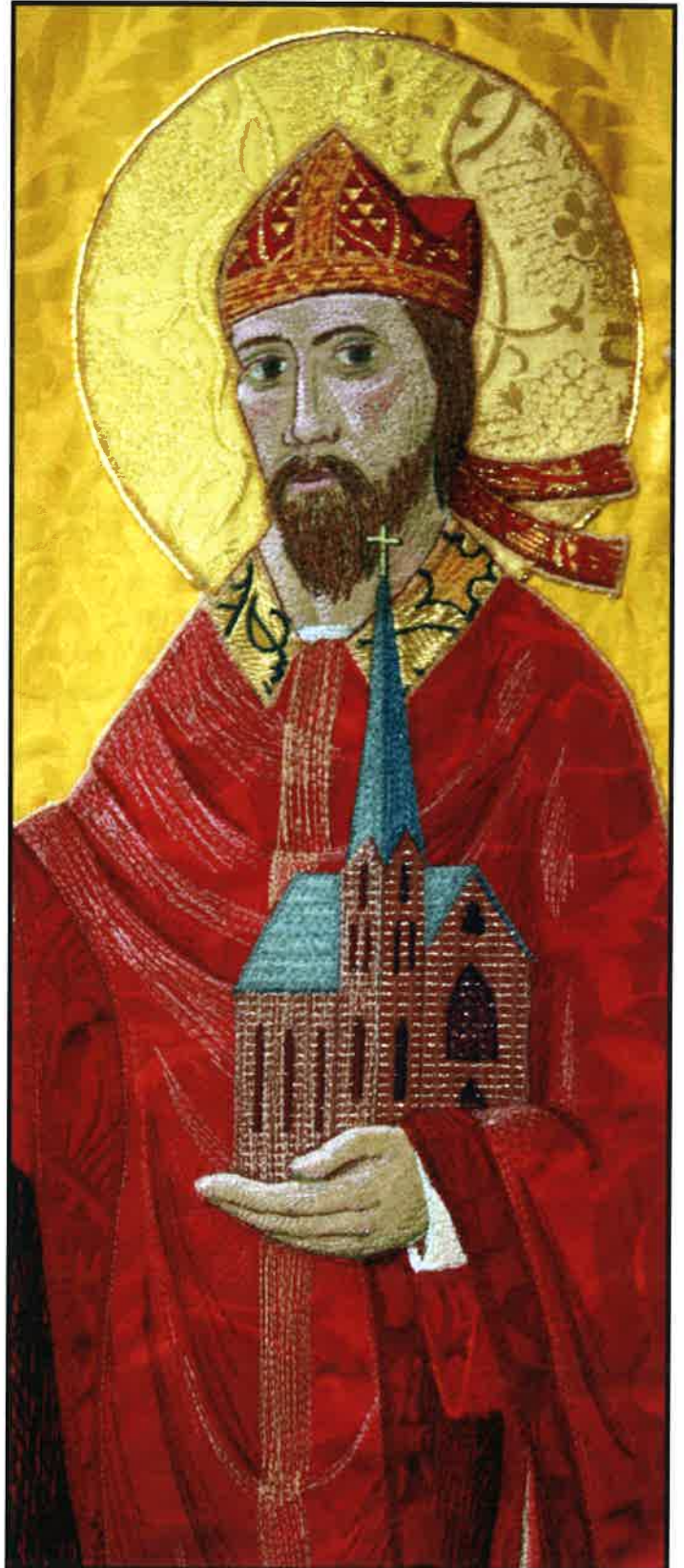

From the Pastor's Desk...

When is the last time you were on a spiritual retreat? Have you ever been on one? What is a spiritual retreat? A spiritual retreat is a prolonged period of recollection, instruction, spiritual reading and reading of Sacred Scripture, examination of conscience, and prayer. Retreats can play a key part in spiritual growth as well as helping us to truly rest and recreate, that is be re-created. So many graces are present when we take this time out to work on our relationship with the Lord. We are strengthened in our convictions and refocused on carrying out the work to which He has called us. We tend to notice better those things that are holding us back from being closer to Him and are often led to how to remedy whatever the issue is. Mostly they are a break from our daily routine and an opportunity to rejuvenate spiritually.

Retreats are often, though not always, taken in a place other than that which we live. This allows us to truly be free of the concerns and cares of day-to-day life and really focus on our relationship with God. Most retreats last a few days to a week. Some mini retreats are only a day and at the other end, the Ignatian Exercises take thirty days. Retreats can be in a monastery or convent, they can be in a dedicated retreat center, or they can be in some other restful environment. Retreats can be self-guided or led by a retreat master. Likewise, they can be taken singly or as a group. There are countless ways to go on retreat and almost everyone would benefit in some way from the right retreat. I encourage you to investigate the possibilities, or if you would like suggestions, I am available to give those. I do encourage everyone to think about taking the time for a retreat. The spiritual benefits are immense.

WOMEN OF ST. COLMAN FUNERAL LUNCHESES

If requested, the Women of St. Colman prepare and serve complimentary lunches after Funeral Masses. Tina Garland, Parish Office Administrator, gets details from the family representative and then contacts the chairman of the lunch committee. The group consists of four different areas (see below). The committee chairs will contact their volunteers to help with the luncheon. Your help may not be needed at every lunch. Each "on-site" committee assignment could be approximately 2-3 hours of time.

Menu/Food Preparation: Mandy Findley The women's group provides the main entrees and this committee is responsible for preparing the menu "items". You are *not* required to be present for the luncheon but will be asked to bring your food to the Parish Hall throughout the morning *before* the luncheon.

Set-Up: Co-Chairs Helen McHolan and Andrea Varney This committee is responsible for getting the Parish Hall ready for guests. This includes setting tables, setting out utensils and decorating tables if needed. The Committee will arrive about two hours before the luncheon begins and will stay until set up is completed.

Serving: Co-Chairs Gwynne Gibson and Carolyn Shoemaker This committee is responsible for cutting and displaying desserts, preparing and maintaining drinks, setting food on the buffet tables and keeping those tables stocked with food during the meal. This committee will arrive about an hour before the luncheon begins and will stay until the guests have finished eating.

Clean Up: Chair Faith Stroud This committee will arrive during the meal and will stay until clean up is finished.
