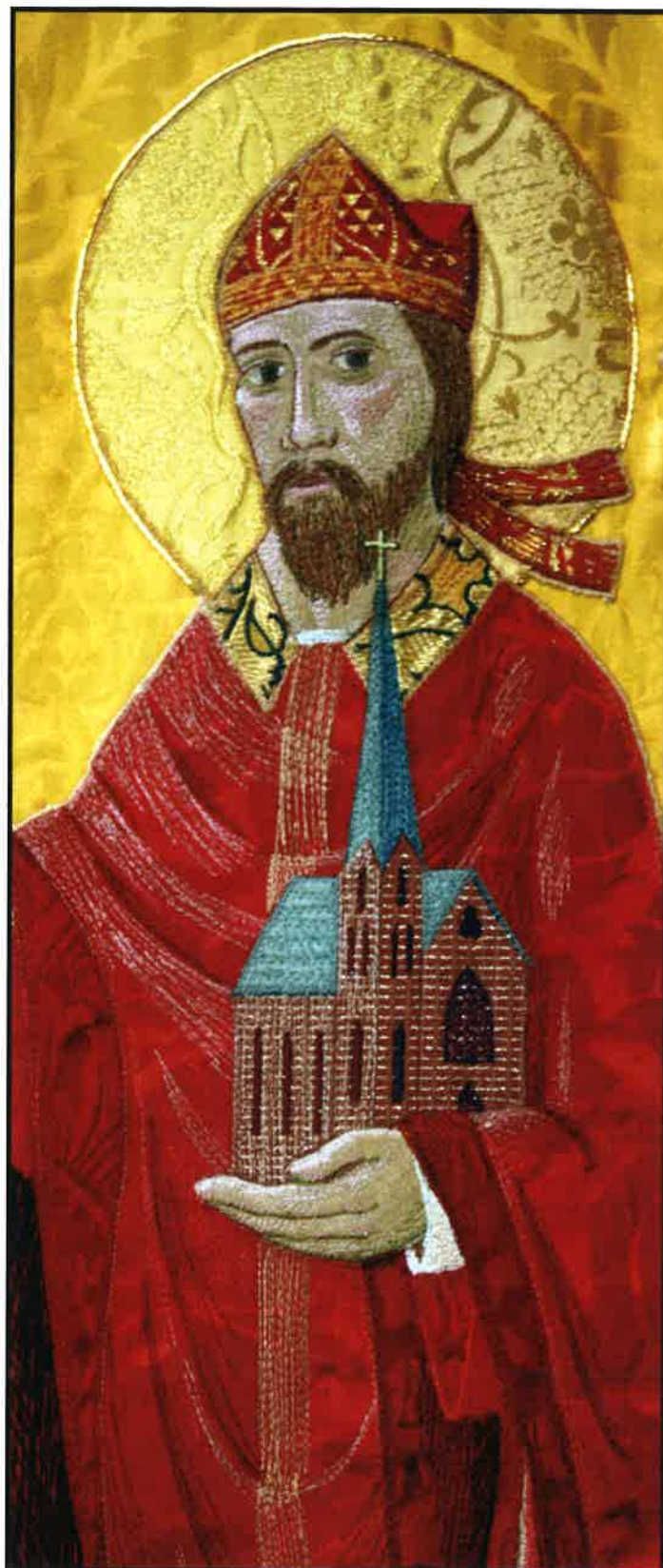

From the Pastor's Desk...

Starting this week, we have a new schedule for Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament here at St. Colman. Starting Sunday, April 25th, exposition will take place at noon on Sundays, after Mass at 6pm on Tuesdays and at 6:45am on Wednesdays through Fridays. But, what is Exposition of the blessed Sacrament?

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is a devotional practice in which the Blessed Sacrament is taken out of the tabernacle so that the faithful might adore it. The Blessed Sacrament is worthy of our worship, the same worship we give to God. Indeed, the perfection of this worship is offered at the Eucharistic Sacrifice, the Mass. There is that moment at Mass when the priest raises the newly consecrated Host, the Most Blessed Sacrament and all adore Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ the Eucharistic species. This is the most intense moment of prayer in the Church, the most complete self-abnegation and abasement before Almighty God. It endures only a brief moment, however. The practice of exposition is an attempt to imperfectly lengthen the time of that moment of Adoration. While it can never be the same as it is at Mass, it is still real adoration offered to our Lord and God. If we wish to be close to Jesus, there is no better way than spending time in His Presence and offering the worship He so richly deserves. So, stop in for one of our hours of exposition, or maybe just for fifteen minutes, and worship Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Bishop's Annual Appeal Kick-off Weekend
