MATRIMONY

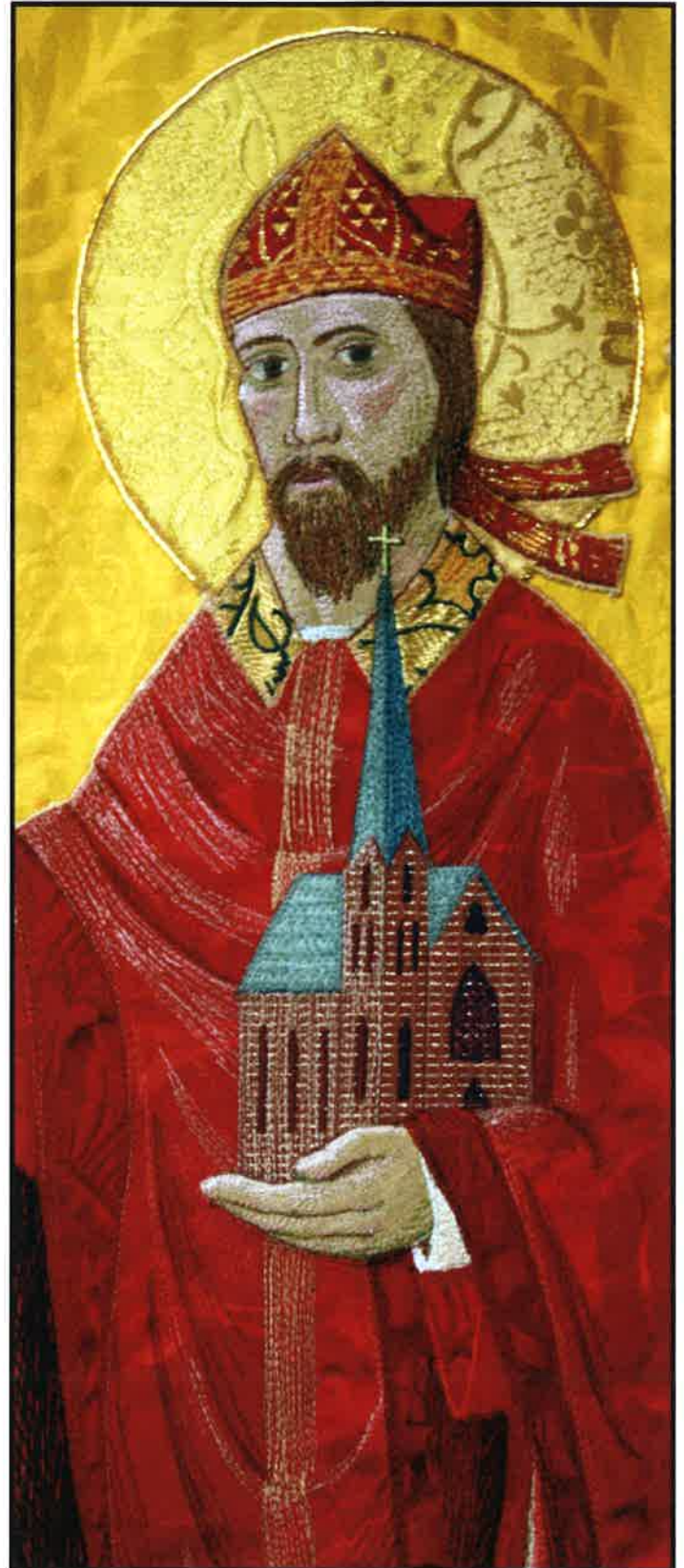

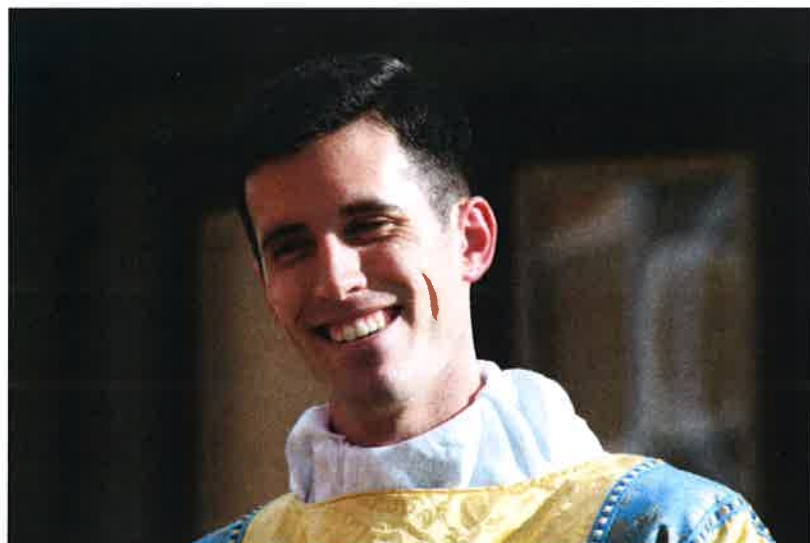

From the Pastor's Desk...

FWhen Christ teaches His disciples to pray, He gives us the "Our Father" as the prayer to pray. This is the prayer with which we are certainly the most familiar, as well it should be since it is literally prescribed by Jesus. There may, however, be some aspects of this prayer which we may not have fully internalized. "Hallowed be Thy Name..." is potentially one such aspect. We don't use the term "to hallow" much anymore. Even if we did, what does it mean in this context. To hallow something is to make it holy. In the context of the Our Father, when we say "hallowed be Thy Name" we are not making God's Name holy, but rather recognizing that it is already holy. This is, in and of itself, an act of adoration. Since we are acknowledging God as He Who is most holy. In fact, He is Holiness Itself. The more we come to realize this, the more we recognize God as our Creator and our Redeemer and the Holiness of the Most High. The more we enter into the mystery of Our Father, the greater the worship we can offer to the Father Who has loved us into existence. The next time we offer up the "Our Father", let's make that effort to truly unite our hearts more thoroughly to the sentiment of adoration carried by the words, "Hallowed be Thy Name."
