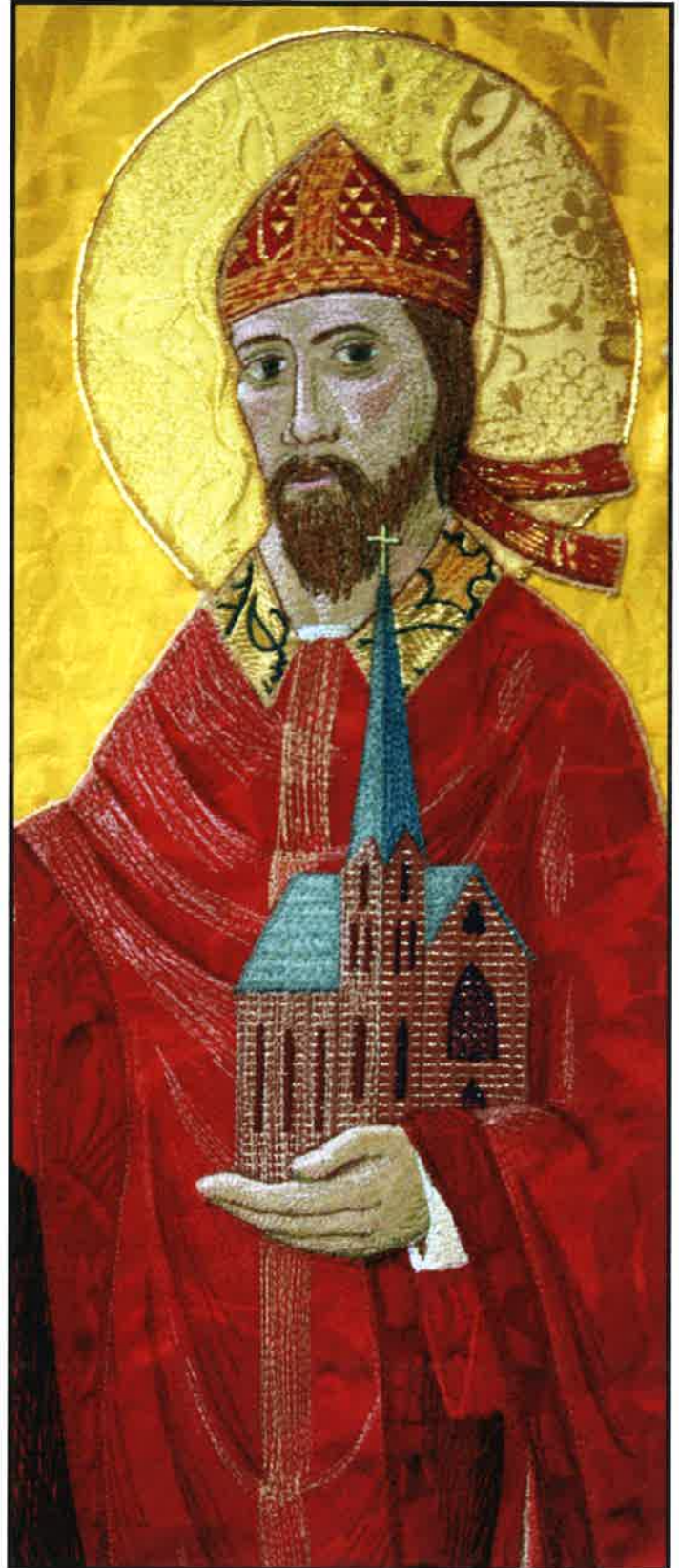

## From the Pastor's Desk...

This week we will celebrate St. Justin the Martyr. He was beheaded for his faith sometime between 162 and 168AD. He was a learned and respected philosopher in his time. While most of his works are lost, among them are his two apologies, explaining the faith to the Roman Senate. Here we are able to find a great insight into the life of the early Church, including one of the earliest accounts of the Holy Sacrifice after the New Testament. This is a great resource for those who want to take a peek back into our ancient roots. More than this, St. Justin is an inspiration and model. His attempts to explain the faith to unbelievers and demonstrate that as Christians we are able to be good citizens of the Empire show the internal coherence of the faith as well as its essential compatibility with reason. Many of the claims against the faith today are similar to those with which St. Justin dealt. "Faith is contrary to reason." "The faith contradicts itself." The claims are inherently false and St. Justin shows us how we can respond. While a man of reason, St. Justin was also a man of great faith. When threatened with torture to induce him to sacrifice to an idol, St. Justin responded, "That is our desire, to be tortured for Our Lord, Jesus Christ, and so to be saved, for that will give us salvation and firm confidence at the more terrible universal tribunal of Our Lord and Savior." St. Justin embraced suffering and death for the sake of the Gospel and so won his martyr's crown. St. Justin Martyr, pray for us.

### Capital Improvements Collection Next Weekend

Next weekend is the second of the four Capital Improvement Collections we have this year. All of the monies collected will go directly to a tuck pointing project. As we mentioned in February, the Diocese had Kabil Associates conduct structural inspections on all of the churches in the diocese last fall. The most pressing issues found here are areas of the brick that need to be replaced and tuck pointing needed on all four sides. Legacy Restoration will be the company completing the work. We planned originally for the project to begin this summer, but more funds need to be secured before that project can commence. More information concerning the tuck pointing will be forthcoming soon.

All of the Capital Improvement monies collected, as well as any BAA refunds we receive this year, will be applied towards this project. In addition, we will apply for a grant from The Catholic Foundation in hopes of securing funds to help offset our out-of-pocket expense. We will make every effort to keep from using any of our Parish Reserves for this project.

Please give as you are able so that we can continue to maintain our church and steer clear of any serious damage in the future. Any amount helps and is greatly appreciated!
