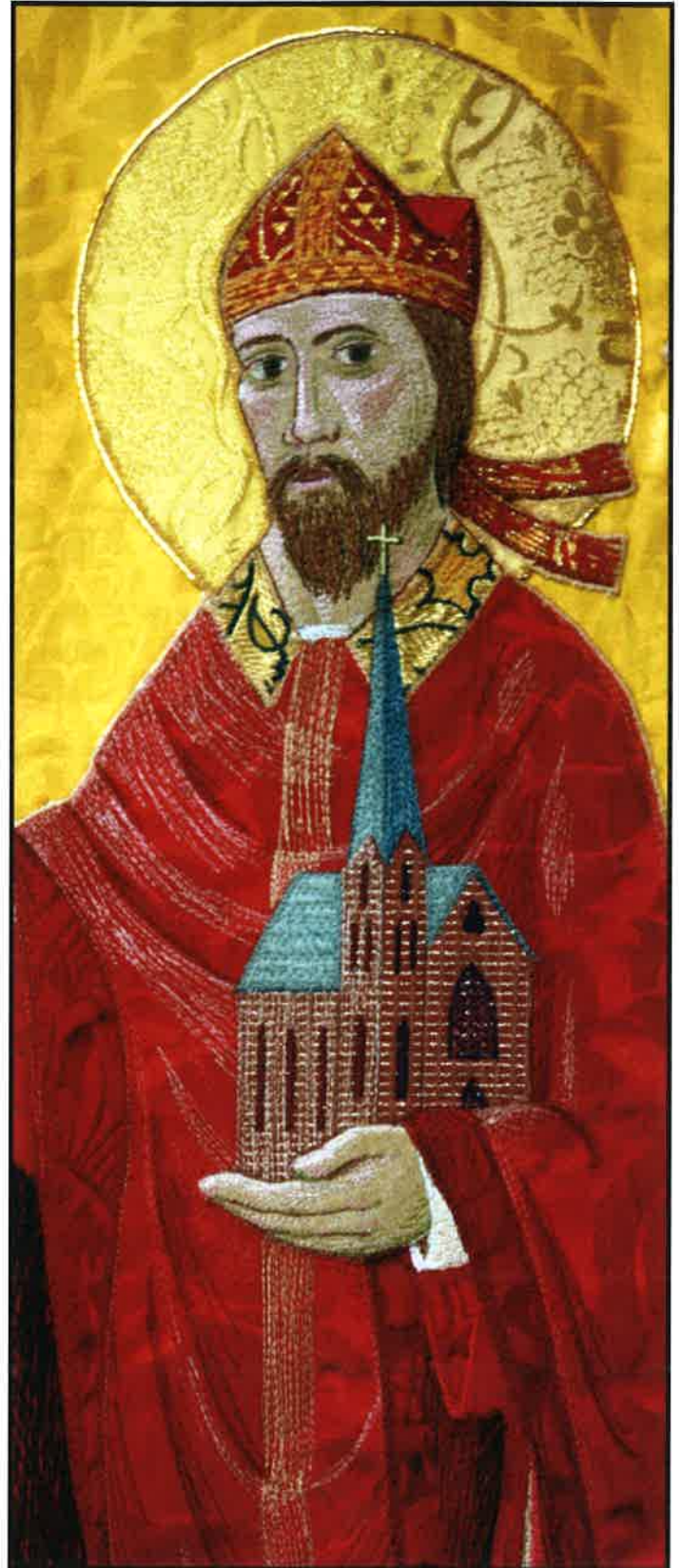

## From the Pastor's Desk...

Many Catholics are invested  
with a scapular or simply wear  
one for devotional reasons.  
Many, however, do not know  
what it is. Originally the scapular was a  
garment that is a part of a monastic habit,  
often called the "yoke of Christ", because  
it is a long strip of cloth which fits over  
the head and hangs almost to the floor  
before and behind the wearer. As the laity would adopt the spirituality of  
these monastic orders and associate with them as members of a third order,  
some laity would take on the wearing of the scapular. Later these would be  
made smaller and could be worn by those who are connected to the order by  
a confraternity rather than taking the vows of the third order. Some may  
even wear a scapular simply as a devotion without entering a confraternity.  
There are many graces associated with each scapular. The Brown Scapular  
of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the most popular (*pictured above*), but  
there are many others in the Church offering a variety of spiritualities and  
graces. It may be worth while to investigate the possibilities and see if you  
feel called to one of these spiritual practices.
