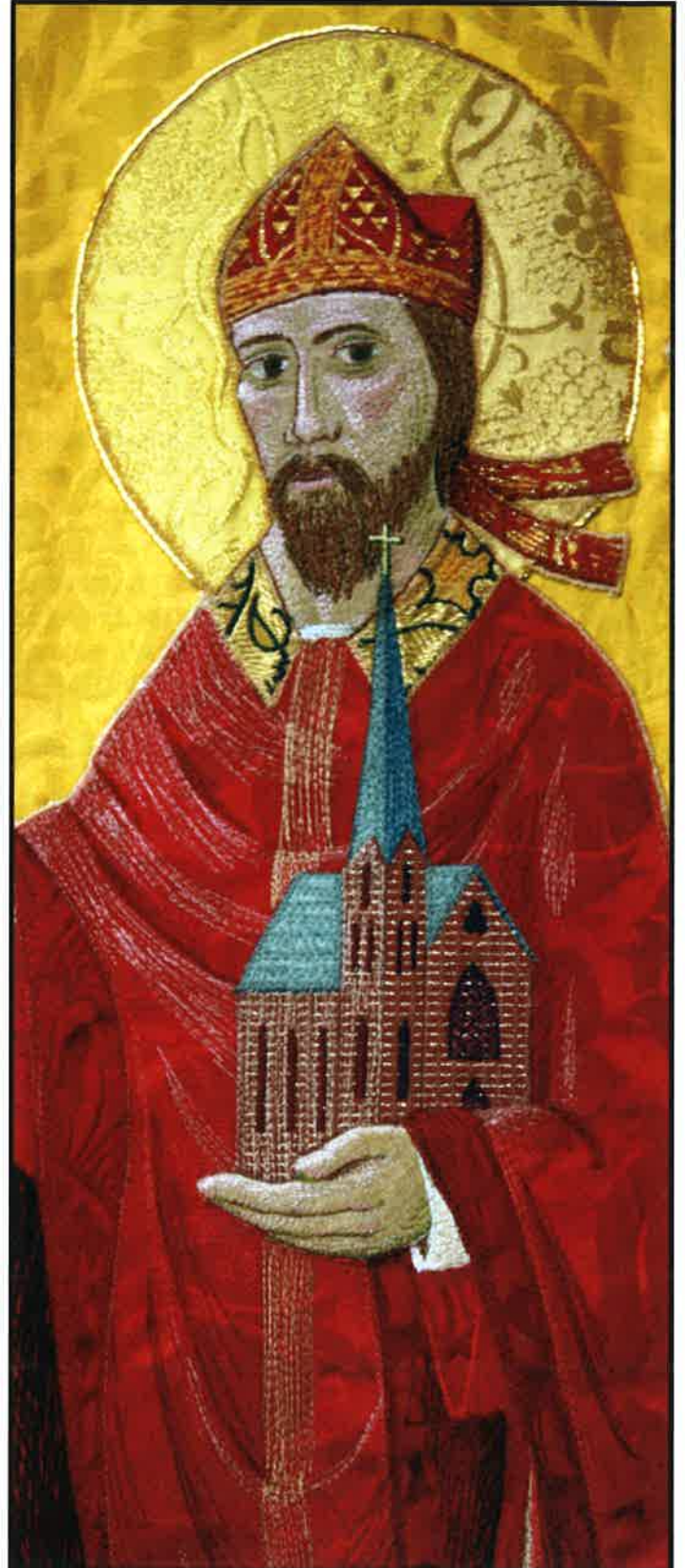

From the Pastor's Desk...

In my homily last Sunday and during announcements some time before that, I spoke about some resources for reading and understanding Sacred Scripture. Some have asked what the names of those resources are and to put them in the bulletin. So, I thought I could include them as well as some of the other resources I find helpful.

The New Testament of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is published by Scepter Publishers. This uses the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine translation of the New Testament which is an updating of the Challoner revision of the original Rheims. This means that the language may feel a bit antiquated, but is still highly readable. The real advantage of this edition of the New Testament is the built-in reading plan with sections marked off by dates so it is easy to follow and make daily progress getting through the entirety of the New Testament in a Year.

The Navarre Bible is a rich commentary on Sacred Scripture which spans the whole length of the Bible. This commentary draws upon the Church Fathers, the saints, as well as magisterial documents. While maintaining scholarly integrity, it is easily readable. This series consists of seven Old Testament volumes and twelve for the New Testament. My suggestion is to pick a book you would really like to know better and simply buy the volume with that book in it, rather than invest in the whole thing at once. The translation is the Revised Standard Version – Catholic Edition. This is one of the better modern translations of Scripture. And is easy to follow.

If you are looking for excellent commentary by the Church Fathers on the four Gospels, then the *Catena Aurea* (meaning "Golden Chain") is the four-volume work for you. Organized by St. Thomas Aquinas, this gives a wonderful and in-depth examination of the contents of the Gospels by saints and scholars who were closer to the events in time, but also spiritually, since they ate, drank, and breathed scripture in a way few have done since.

Finally, the best commentaries on scripture I have ever seen are those of St. Thomas Aquinas. St. Thomas wrote Commentaries on the Psalms, on the Epistles of St. Paul, the Gospel of St. John, the Gospel of St. Matthew, the Prophet Jeremiah, the book of Job, and the Prophet Isaiah. These are highly detailed and can take some effort to understand, but the depth of both knowledge and insight expressed by the Angelic Doctor in these commentaries is unparalleled. There are several editions of many of these works available on Amazon.com. Right now, the Aquinas Institute is in the process of translating (or retranslating) all of St. Thomas' works into English. Of his biblical commentaries, the two Gospels, the Pauline Corpus, and the Book of Job are available now. It looks like the Psalms and Isaiah are scheduled to come out in the Fall, with Jeremiah being released in the Spring of 2022. Also, those commentaries out now are available on Kindle.

No. None of these companies are paying me, I am simply sharing some of the resources I like to use to help me understand Scripture better. I hope you find something useful.
