MATRIMONY

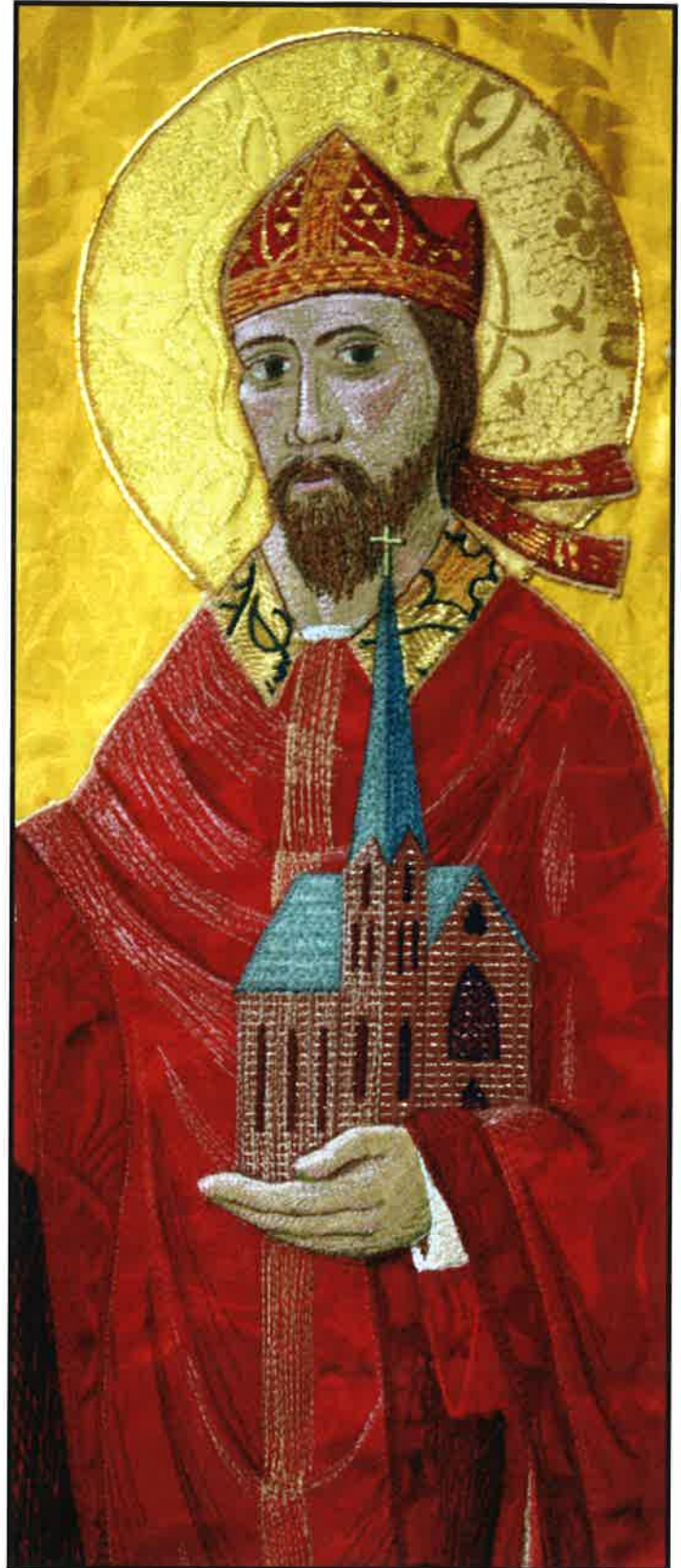

New Fiscal Year Begins

July 1 begins the new fiscal year. The "budgeted" figure for the offertory indicates how much we should collect to meet expenses. This total is obtained by taking all *operating* expenses and dividing by the 52 weeks in the year. This figure does not include our special collections. Special collection totals are reported at the beginning of each month except for St. Vincent de Paul contributions. (SVdP keeps their own accounting records.)

The weekly offertory includes the money collected at the weekend Masses and the online giving contribution for that week.

One last note of importance: the tuck-pointing project is not included in the operating expenses for this year.

From the Pastor's Desk...

Recently, someone asked me why I say the Prayer after Mass, after each Mass. There are several reasons. A priest is required to make an act of thanksgiving after offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and while it may be delayed, the best time to do so is immediately after Mass. All who receive the Blessed Sacrament in Holy Communion, also ought to make an act of thanksgiving after Mass. Often people in their busyness fail to remember to make their act of thanksgiving, so I figure if I lead everyone in this short prayer, we will have at least done that much. Really, the thanksgiving God deserves is so much greater than that prayer, but it is a good start. We should all individually take a little time in prayer before Mass to prepare and even after the common thanksgiving prayer to offer our gratitude. Saying this prayer together helps express the thanks we have for the Sacrament as a community, plus, this allows me to greet people after Mass, since I have at least begun my thanksgiving.

As to why this prayer over any others, several reasons come to mind. First is the author. St. Thomas Aquinas, sometimes called the Angelic Doctor composed this prayer. He had a great devotion to the Eucharist, advanced many positions concerning the Eucharist which were adopted by the Council of Trent, and has unsurpassed eloquence. Second, it is a beautifully written prayer that asks for so many graces and so much of what we need from receiving the Eucharist. Finally, it is one of the prayers contained in the Missal for this very purpose.
