## MATRIMONY

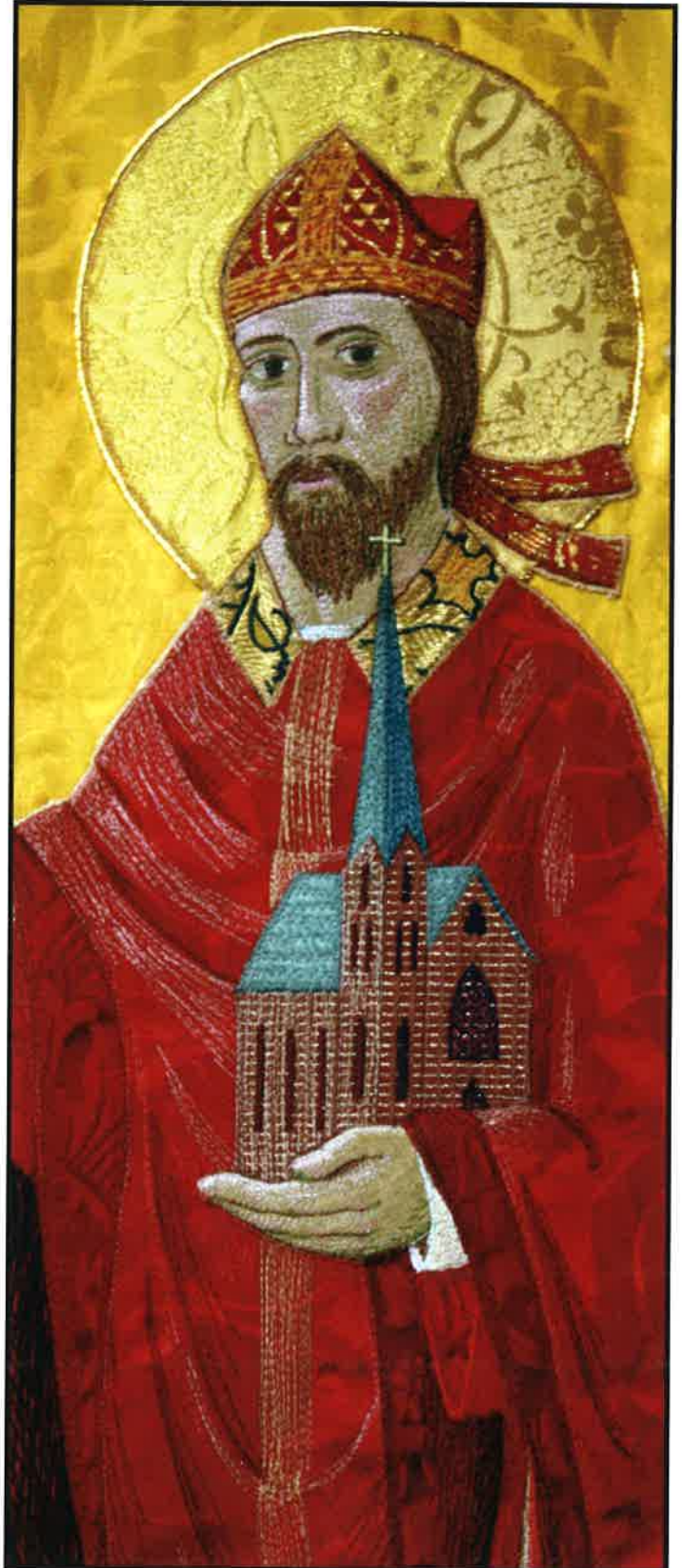

## From the Pastor's Desk...

This past week St. Colman parish has been hosting a

Vacation Bible School focused on vocations. Thanks to our CRE, Rebecca Elrich, and a band of intrepid volunteers, our Parish Center was transformed from a multi-purpose room to the "Vocation Islands", through the ingenious and creative efforts of the team along with some very generous donations. The children were on a hunt to decode the secret message on the treasure map. To accomplish this goal, they had to visit all three of the "Vocation Islands." First, they visited the "Isle de Nuptialis", where they learned that for most, Christ calls us to live our Universal Call to Holiness in the context of Holy Matrimony and family. We are meant to be perfected by our spouses and through them grow closer and closer to Christ. This is accomplished foremost through daily prayer together. And, when marriages are blessed with children, married couples are called to raise their children with the faith, praying with them, and sharing the love and truth of Christ.

Next the Children visited the island of "Consecratia" and learned about the role of men's and women's religious as well as the other types of consecrated life. Whether devoted to prayer and contemplation, or involved in active ministry, those in religious life are consecrated to Christ in such a way that they are totally free to give all of themselves to Him. Practicing the evangelical councils of poverty, chastity, and obedience, those who are called to live a life consecrated to God are free from worldly cares in their totality. Not bound to wealth and material possession, free from attachments to others, and even free from having to deliberate as to what God wants, those in religious life are able to grow closer and closer to the perfection of a life of happiness and holiness.

On the following day, the children proceeded to "Presbyteron", an island where they were to learn about the role of the priest. Whether religious or diocesan, the priest is conformed to Christ the Head by Ordination and celebrates the Sacraments for the glory of God and the sanctification of others. The priest in his role of priest, prophet and king is called to govern the people of God, call them to a greater righteousness, and sanctify them by means of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the sacraments and sacramentals.

Finally, the children are able to decipher the hidden message from the Gospel of Matthew—"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." This is the call of every Christian, of all the baptized. We are all meant to live lives that are Holy and to spread the Gospel wherever we can. So, this week the children learned that God can call us in different ways, to do and be different things, but we are always called to holiness, we are always called to proclaim the Gospel. Those two things make us the most happy we can be on earth and they eventually bring us to be with God "face-to-face" in heaven.
