MATRIMONY

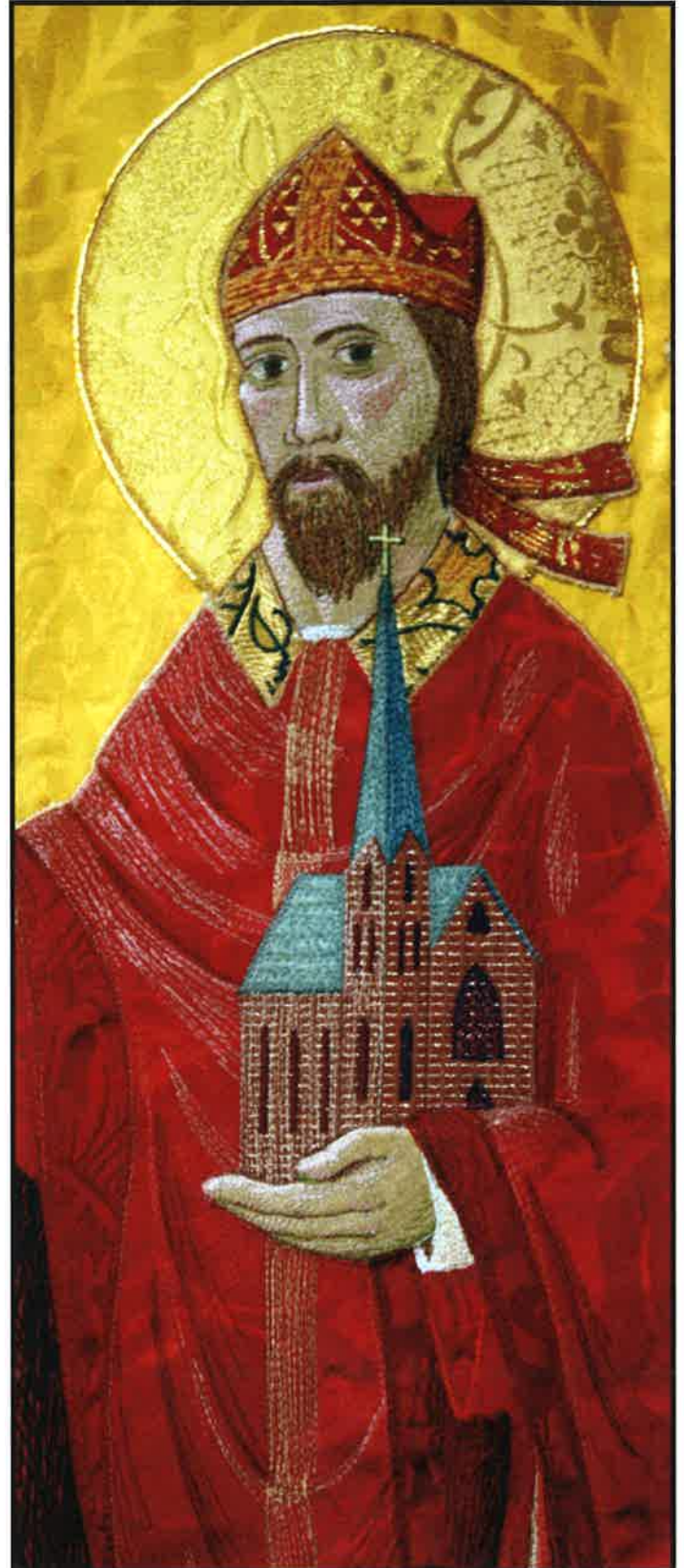

From the Pastor's Desk...

“The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians.” (CCC #966)



We will celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary next Sunday, August 15th. This is usually a Holy Day of Obligation, but since it occurs on a Sunday this year, it's a moot point. The place of the mystery of Our Lady's Assumption is unique among the various dogmas proposed by the Church Universal for belief. This is because it is the last to have been defined. The Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus* was issued on November 1st, 1950. The words of this document are quite profound and it is in the fortieth paragraph that the definition is made:

Hence the revered Mother of God, from all eternity joined in a hidden way with Jesus Christ in one and the same decree of predestination, immaculate in her conception, a most perfect virgin in her divine motherhood, the noble associate of the divine Redeemer who has won a complete triumph over sin and its consequences, finally obtained, as the supreme culmination of her privileges, that she should be preserved free from the corruption of the tomb and that, like her own Son, having overcome death, she might be taken up body and soul to the glory of heaven where, as Queen, she sits in splendor at the right hand of her Son, the immortal King of the Ages. (*Munificentissimus Deus*, 40.)

This great blessing lavished upon Our Lady in light of her Immaculate Conception and Divine Motherhood, is a great blessing to us as well. In fact, in defining of this dogma, we are meant to glorify the Blessed Trinity to Whom the Blessed Virgin is bound, as well as increase our devotion to Our Blessed Mother, and follow Our Lady's example by leading lives entirely devoted to God's will even as her life was. Finally, it was intended that in defining this dogma, we the members of the Body of Christ, the Church, as we are moved to a greater appreciation of Our Lady's Assumption, we would be moved to a greater hope in our own resurrection.

Let us Magnify the Lord and reflect on the gift of resurrection, when we consider the mystery of Our Lady's Assumption.
