MATRIMONY

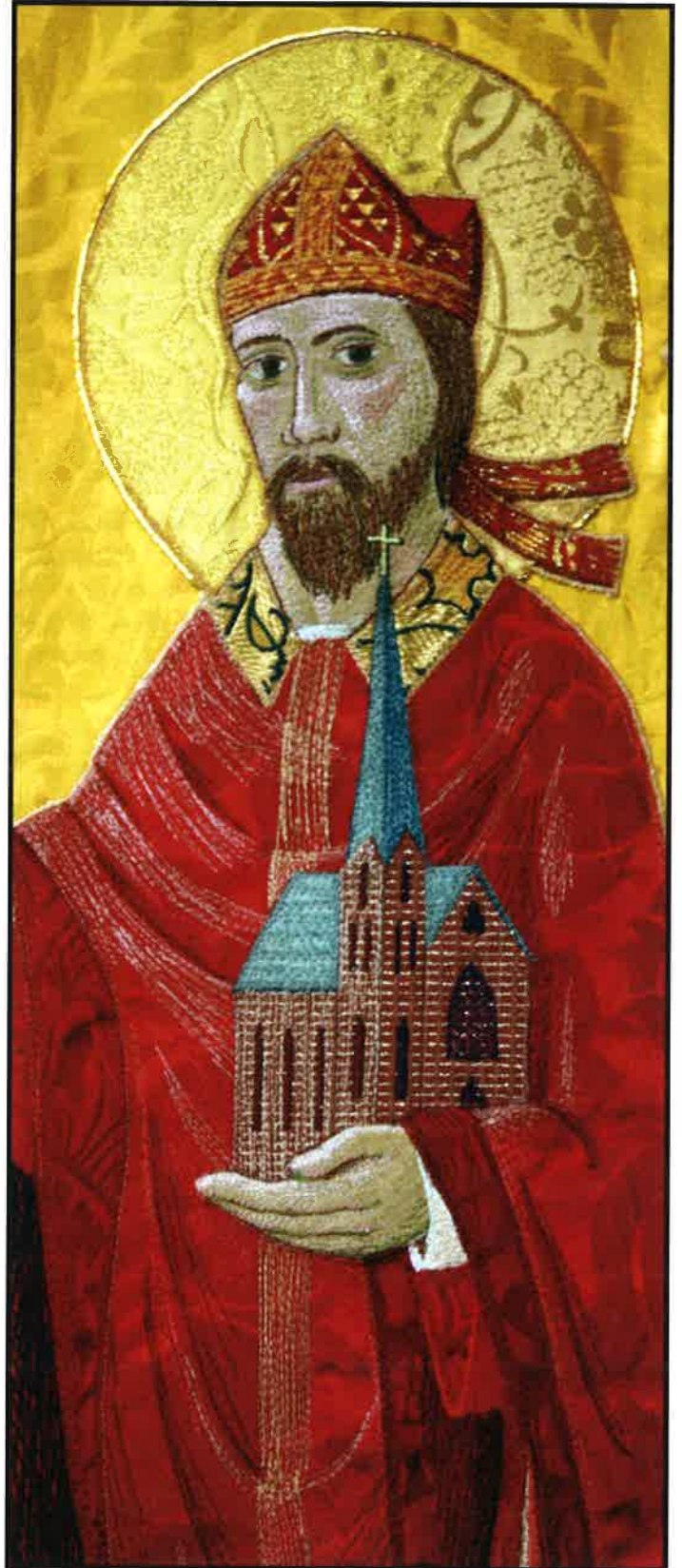
