## MATRIMONY

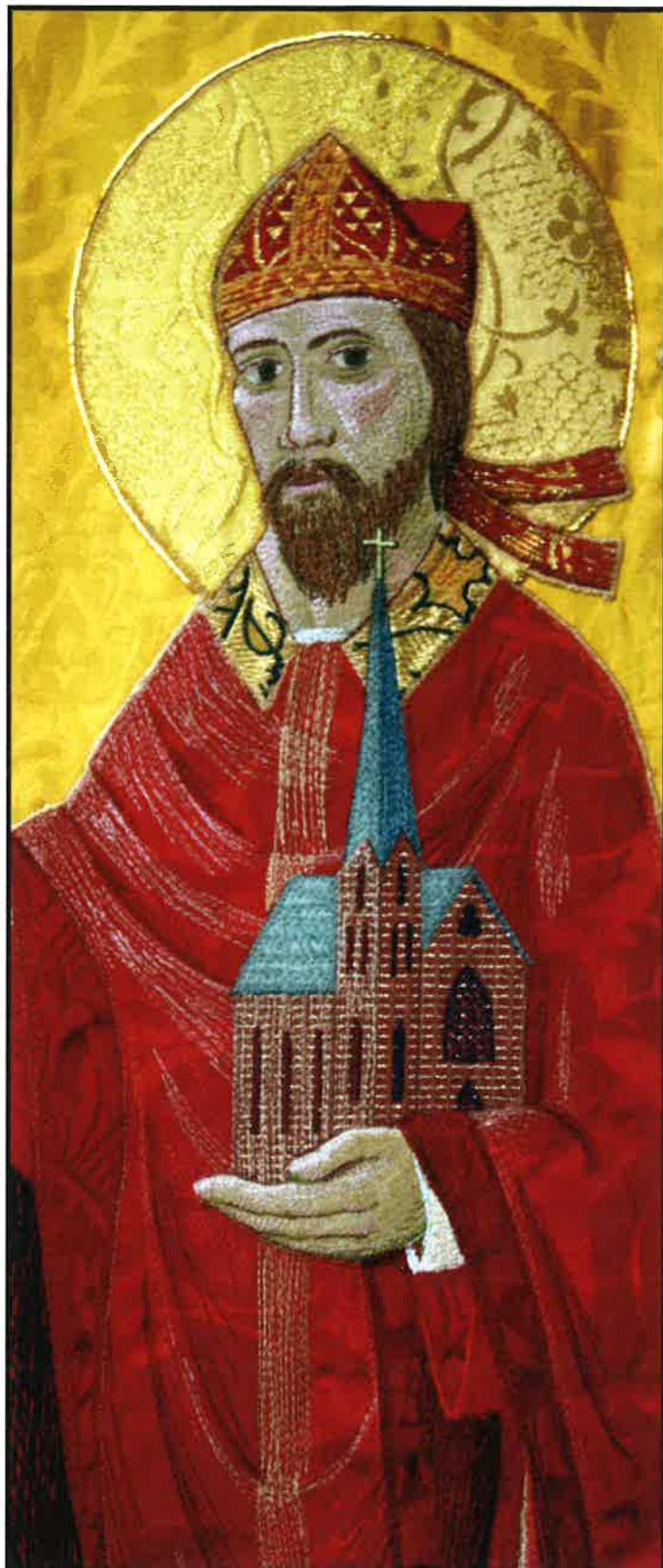
