MATRIMONY

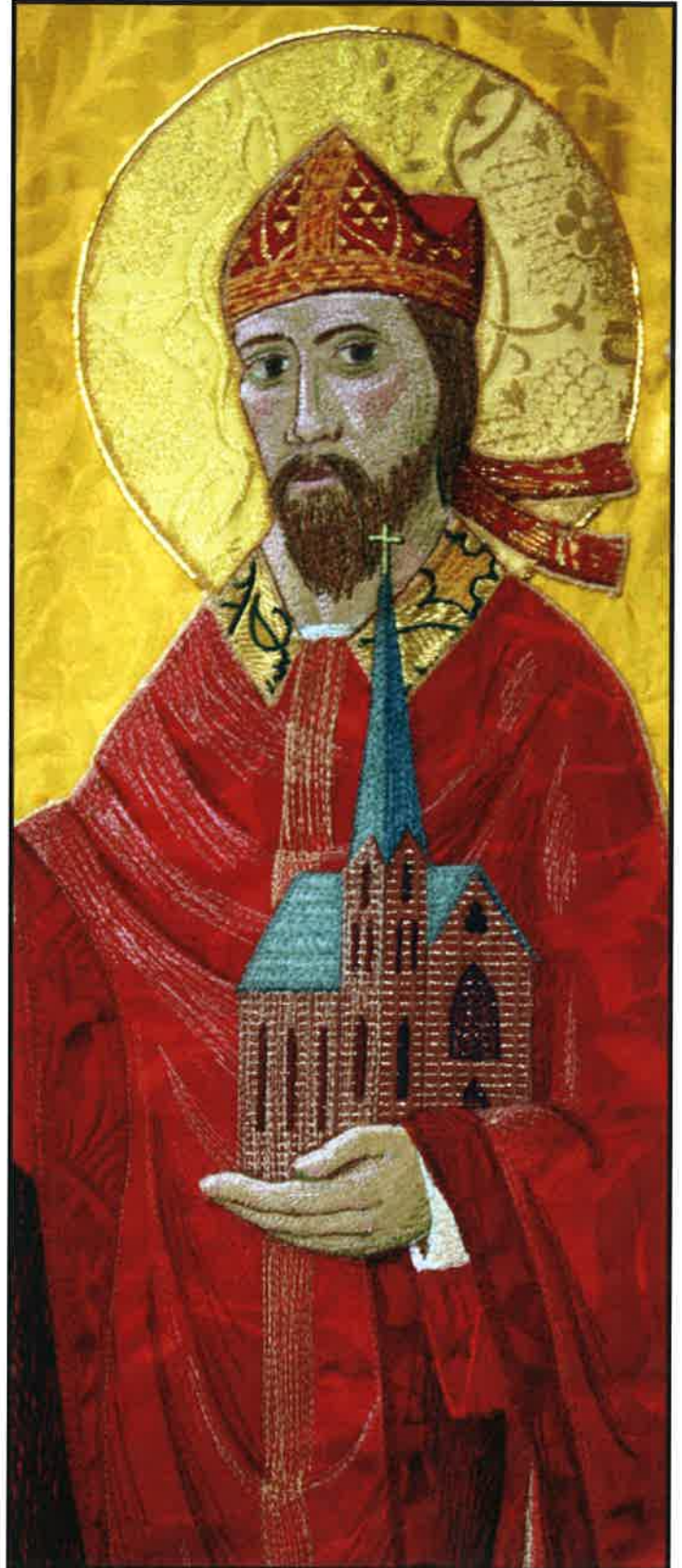

From the session, you will be able to better understand the current state of our parish and find out how you can provide important feedback in this initial step of shaping the future of the Diocese of Columbus.

Our parish consultation sessions will be held on **Tuesday, October 12 and Thursday, October 14 in the Parish Hall**. You only need to attend one of these two sessions. If you cannot attend these sessions in person, registering will enable you to receive a link to watch them after they have been held.

These are part of what Father Haddad discussed last week during Mass. It is the next step in learning about and securing the future of St. Colman Parish within the Diocese of Columbus.

Tuck-pointing Campaign Update...

September 19, 2021

Wow! THANK YOU to everyone who has already given to the tuck-pointing campaign! **We are off to a good start with \$6,200 collected this past week!**

I want to answer some questions that came into the Parish Office in case others of you are having the same thoughts:

Capital Improvement Collection vs. Tuck-pointing Collection? As reported earlier in the year, the Capital Improvement collections this year will be applied to the campaign. That is true unless we have other capital needs such as emergency building repairs (i.e., boilers and HVAC units). This collection doesn't come close to meeting the goal of the campaign, but we want to apply every possible dollar we can to the project. We typically collect \$4000 in the four Capital Improvement collections we have each year. So far we have collected \$5,795 in three collections since January. So, unless other major repair needs occur over the course of the next 9 months, the money you give in the Capital Improvement collection will be applied to the tuck-pointing project. Should another capital need arise, this is the account that will pay for the repairs, etc.

What about the Endowment collection? Are we still collecting for this? Yes, we are still collecting for the Endowment. Please continue to give to each as you are able. The tuck-pointing campaign is in the forefront at the moment, however, we will always have monetary needs running simultaneously with the Endowment collection. We will not be able to use the Endowment to fund the tuck-pointing project. The Endowment is held at The Catholic Foundation (not the diocese).

Are any other monies being applied to the campaign? Yes, you may recall when the Bishop's Annual Appeal began in May, we reported that any refunds from the BAA will be applied to the tuck-pointing project. We met our BAA goal, so now any monies collected from the BAA will come back to the parish tax-free. The BAA is open until February 1, so we may receive a significant amount in refunds if families continue to support the BAA.

I am also applying for a grant from The Catholic Foundation this month to help offset the cost to the parish. Notification as to whether we receive the grant will come in late November/early December. The Foundation has been very generous to us in the past, giving us grants for the tower doors, security systems and the church windows. Pray that they continue to support us in this project.

Will my donation to the campaign be assessed? Yes, it will be included in the assessment. The only contributions not taxed are memorials, religious education donations and BAA refunds.

You should have received Father's letter explaining the tuck-pointing project this past week. *(If you did not, please contact me in the Parish Office.)* Please continue to refer your questions to the Parish Office. With such an important and significant campaign such as this, we want to be as transparent as possible. I will include our collection results each week in the bulletin so everyone is informed as we move through these next few months. The project is tentatively scheduled to begin next summer, so we will be focused on this campaign for awhile. **Thank you for your continued support of our parish with past projects and most recently during the Covid shutdown.** Please continue to give as you are able so that we can repair and maintain our beautiful church.
