Divine Mercy Minute:

“Jesus came to the main entrance today, under the guise of a poor young man. This young man, emaciated, barefoot and bareheaded, and with his clothes in tatters, was frozen because the day was cold and rainy. He asked for something hot to eat. So I went to the kitchen, but found nothing there for the poor. But, after searching around for some time, I succeeded in finding some soup, which I reheated and into which I crumbled some bread, and I gave it to the poor young man, who ate it. As I was taking the bowl from him, he gave me to know that He was the Lord of heaven and earth. When I saw Him as He was, He vanished from my sight. (1312)”

We may not get to physically see Jesus, but we can serve Christ in our everyday lives through our service to our families and to others. Each work of mercy is a natural expression of the Divine Mercy poured out in our lives, especially when we offer these acts with the intention of allowing his mercy to pass through our heart and souls to our neighbors.

There are fourteen works of mercy in all: seven corporal, based on bodily needs and seven spiritual, which attend to the needs of the soul. See Mathew 25:34-40. The 7 corporal works of mercy are; 1) Feed the hungry, 2) Give drink to the thirsty, 3) Clothe the naked, 4) Shelter the homeless, 5) Visit the sick, 6) Visit the imprisoned, 7) Bury the dead.

God will provide little opportunities every day through your interactions with others. Ask God to give you the wisdom and resolve, and pray that you are able to discern easily what He is asking you to do. Ask Jesus to allow you to be his hands and feet on earth as an instrument of mercy.
