There will be drop off baskets in the RE office, at the main entrance, and in the hall beginning on November 29th continuing to December 16th. Please note that WARC cannot accept any outdated food items so please be mindful of this when donating.

Tuesday, December 8, Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Two Masses will be offered: 7:00 am at St. Joseph and 5:00 pm at St. Martin. Advent Confessions will be heard at St. Martin following Mass that evening. Adoration will be held from 4:30 pm – 5:00 pm, and resume until 6:30 pm following Mass.

\*There will be no Advent penance services. Father Grafsgaard will be available to hear confessions beginning in December at Saint Martin’s on Tuesdays from 5:30 pm – 6:30 pm and Thursdays from 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm in the Bride’s Room in Parish Hall. Confessions at Saint Joseph’s will be held on Fridays from 6:00pm – 7:00 pm at St. Joseph. Confessions on Wednesdays are being held for RE students. This schedule is shown on the December monthly calendar. Confessions will still be heard before our weekday and weekend Masses, as usual.

CHRISTMAS POINSETTIAS for St. Joseph and St. Martin parishes: Donations (any amount) are being accepted ‘In Honor’ or ‘In Memory’ of loved ones.
