Reminder of Changes in Our Parishes Effective February 20th-21st:

1. Spacing in Church is eliminated.
- 2) Funeral Vigils and Visitations before Mass may be in the Church.
- 3) One Extra-Ordinary Minister of the Eucharist (Precious Body) will be scheduled at every Mass.
- 4) Up to 3 Mass servers will be scheduled for weekend Masses beginning in April.
- 5) Choir for parish Masses will resume.
- 6) Holy Water is in the fonts in the Church.
- 7) Communal Penance Services are allowed but only with the use of screens.
- 8) Ushers will take up the collection using long-handled baskets. The collection will be then put into one individual basket and brought up to Deacon Dan.
- 9) A special section in the parish halls marked **RESERVED** will be reserved for individuals who would like to maintain social distancing, have underlying health conditions, and the elderly. Masks will be required in this section and are available for use.

Items that have not been changed are:

1. Holy Communion distributed under species of Precious Body only.
- 2)The Sign of Peace remains suspended.
- 3) No Offertory procession with the gifts.
- 4) Confessions will only be heard behind the screen.
