A Statement on the Dignity and Destiny of Human Life

(PART 1)

Our Faith in Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, teaches us that while we live in this world, full of the Lord's bounty and entrusted to human hands, it is not our abiding home.



We look forward to living with Jesus, together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, and with all the angels and saints in the eternal blessedness of heaven. Death marks the time of our judgment, and then, according to our cooperation with God's *free* gift of grace, we hope to pass over into life eternal with Him. For this reason, St. Francis of Assisi was able to speak of "Sister Death" as a friend who carries us from this life to the Father's house. Christians are not immune from the anxiety which impending death brings, but we should not fear it, We can face death with serenity and courage, knowing that it is our time to go to the house of the Father.

Effective Ways to Evangelize as a Catholic

- 10) Forgive others, sincerely.
- 11) Be hospitable. Invite, welcome, and engage others as a Catholic lifestyle.
- 12) Mention your faith in public. Don't be afraid to tell your story. Your life is your experience of faith. Recognize where God has "broken in". Tell others. Feel free to speculate on a recent "God moment".
- 13) Say "thank God", "I believe", or "Amen" in public.
- 14) Go to confession regularly. Once a month is a good "rule of thumb". Make this a family practice, too.
- 15) Be bold enough to say, "That is against my faith", or "my faith teaches...."
- 16) Make it a regular habit to visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.
- 17) Invite somebody to church. This is especially effective during Advent, Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Lent, Easter, and Pentecost.
