

### Parishioners Who Are Not Able to Attend Palm Sunday or Easter Mass

Left over Palms from Palm Sunday will be available at the office door following the Palm Sunday Mass for those not able to attend.

For those who will not be able to attend the Easter Vigil or Easter Sunday Mass where we normally renew our Baptism Vows by using holy water and candles, the parish is supplying these two items for those who are homebound or not able to personally attend. They can be picked up at the office door at any time. Both of these Easter liturgies will be live-streamed at the time mentioned under the Holy Week Mass Schedule inside the bulletin. For those who watch on Shaw cable, only the previous Sunday Mass is shown each week.
