How To Make The Most Of Holy Week 5 Ways To Live It Well

- 1) Meditate on the Passion: Meditate on the Passion using passages in the Bible, the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, etc.
- 2) Try to be Silent: Avoid listening to music or attending parties or celebrations. Make sure to keep your conversations as sober as possible.
- 3) Make an Extra Sacrifice: In addition to fasting and abstinence on Friday, make another small sacrifice.
- 4) Attend the Liturgies: Try to attend all of the liturgies.
- 5) Keep All Distractions Away: Keep away from distractions like your cell phone, videos, etc.

Parishioners Who Are Not Able to Attend Palm Sunday or Easter Mass

Left over Palms from Palm Sunday will be available at the office door following the Palm Sunday Mass for those not able to attend.
