## Mass Offerings

The Bishops of the Province of Missouri have determined that the new established Mass offering, as of July 1, 2019, shall be \$10. This decision was considered and arrived at due to the different procedures utilized in assisting the priests, throughout the State of Missouri, in their everyday expense.

### St. Martha - Monday, July 29

Today's saint, sister of Mary and Lazarus, received the Lord with hospitality into their home in Bethany, not far from Jerusalem. Martha diligently waited on the Lord and with her prayers beseeched the return of her brother from the dead.

### St. Ignatius of Loyola - Wednesday, July 31

Today's saint, founder of the Jesuits, has since the 16th century had a profound influence on Catholic history. Born in the Basque area of Spain, at Loyola, 1493, Ignatius after being wounded as a soldier found Christ. A strong and holy organizer, Ignatius founded the Society of Jesus along military lines at Paris in 1534. In a critical time the Jesuits were magnificent in resisting Protestantism, reforming the Church, laboring in mission lands and in the educational apostolate. His "Spiritual Exercises" helped many others to conversion. Ignatius, demonstrating manly love for Christ and unconditional loyalty to the Pope, died at Rome on July 31, 1556. He was canonized a saint in 1622.

### St. Alphonsus Liguori - Thursday, August 1

Today's notable saint, born near Naples in 1696, earned a degree in both civil and canon law. He gave up law to become a priest, and apostle to the poor, and untiring preacher and writer, a merciful confessor. Alphonsus founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, Redemptorists, to evangelize the poor. He was an outstanding moral theologian and then a bishop and through many trials worked unceasingly and patiently. Alphonsus died in 1787 at the age of 91. In 1950 he was named patron of moral theologians. The Redemptorists did much for the faith in the early years of the Church in the US. He is our parish **PATRON SAINT**.

### STEWARDSHIP AWARENESS

*"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you."* Luke 11:9

Jesus assures us that if we ask, God will take care of what we need. The problem is that our culture often confuses what we really need with what we simply want. Many people need very little. However, we usually want so much more. A good steward only asks God for what he needs.

## OUR FATHER

2759 Jesus "was praying at a certain place, and when he ceased, one of his disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.'" in response to this request the Lord entrusts to his disciples and to his Church the fundamental Christian prayer. St. Luke presents a brief text of five petitions, while St. Matthew gives a more developed version of seven petitions. The liturgical tradition of the Church has retained St. Matthew's text:

2760 Very early on, liturgical usage concluded the Lord's Prayer with a doxology. In the *Didache*, we find, "For you are the power and the glory for ever." The *Apostolic Constitutions* add to the beginning: "the kingdom," and this is the formula retained to our day in ecumenical prayer. The Byzantine tradition adds after "the glory" the words "Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." The *Roman Missal* develops the last petition in the explicit perspective of "awaiting our blessed hope" and of the Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Then comes the assembly's acclamation or the repetition of the doxology from the *Apostolic Constitutions*

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
