### **GROUNDS MAINTENANCE GROUP Activities for August & September 2019**

1. Weeded West side of church a couple of times.
2. Removed plant debris from church's property
3. Turned gas off on stoves located in the Parish Hall
4. Sprayed weed killer on North, East and South sides of church building.
5. Installed water and electrical lines from church to the soccer field building.
6. Sprayed weed killer along side walk parallel to main entrance, in grotto area, east and north sides of Parish hall.
7. Trimmed plant located on the south side of the Rectory
8. Weeded landscape on the northeast side of Rectory
9. Trimmed low hanging limbs around church's property and removed from area
10. Removed two landscape plants located on the southeast side of Parish Hall
11. Sprayed weed killer in landscape east side of Rectory and on the south side of main parking lot
