**St. Rose Philippine Duchesne** - Monday, November 18  
St. Rose Philippine Duchesne was a French nun, educator and missionary in the USA. She established the first convent of the Society of the Sacred Heart in the USA at St. Charles, MO, founded schools for girls; did missionary work among the Native Americans; beatified 1940 and canonized in 1988.

**The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary** - Thursday, November 21

A pious tradition held that as a child Mary was presented and educated near the Temple in Jerusalem. The apocryphal story does remind us of how Mary conceived immaculately, was predestined by God to be mother of His son. Mary, honored God; is honored and called Blessed by us on this day.

**St. Cecilia** - Friday, November 22

Devotion to St. Cecilia to whom a basilica in Rome was built in the 5th century, grew because of a dramatic and popular narrative of her tortures and death. There seems to be some foundation for the narrative, though the details cannot be shown as factual. The story says that "Cecilia sang in her heart while the musical instruments sounded her wedding." Because of this, Cecilia is Patroness of Music.

673 Since the Ascension Christ's coming in glory has been imminent, even though "it is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has fixed by his own authority."
